TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes begin a three-game road series at Banner Island Ballpark against the Stockton Ports (Oakland Athletics Affiliate). Tuesday is the first game of a short three-game road trip for the Quakes before they return to LoanMart Field to host the Lake Elsinore Storm.

VS STOCKTON: This is the seventh of 12 overall meetings between the two clubs and the fourth of six games at Banner Island Ballpark. The Quakes last played Stockton in a three-game series at LoanMart Field 4/24-4/26 and lost two of three against the North Division opponents. Parker Curry received the win out of the bullpen in the final game of the series in the only victory for the Quakes over Stockton this season. In the first road series of the year at Banner Island Ballpark, the Ports swept the Quakes in three straight games, 4/9-4/11. Stockton leads the 2018 season series over Rancho five-games-to-one.

LAST TIME OUT: Visalia starting pitcher Emilio Vargas held Rancho without a hit until the seventh inning on Monday afternoon, as the Quakes were shut out for the third time this season in a 5-0 loss to the Rawhide. Vargas set the early tone, striking out four consecutive hitters to begin the game and recorded three perfect innings before Gavin Lux walked in the fourth. The Quakes loaded the bases in the seventh inning vs. Visalia but Steve Berman popped out to end the inning. Vargas received the win and Quakes starter Dustin May suffered his second loss of the season.

TOURING THE MINORS: Quakes outfielder Logan Landon has been mobile throughout the Dodgers system in the early going. Landon was called up from Rancho Cucamonga to Double-A Tulsa on April 30th where he played in one game. Shortly after, Landon was promoted to Triple-A Oklahoma on 5/3 where he played in four games (2-for-8, 2 runs, RBI) before returning to the Quakes.

Against the Rawhide on 5/13, Landon hit the first walk-off home run of the season for the Quakes, a two-run homer on Mothers Day to give the Quakes a 3-2 win over Visalia.

RIGHT VS LEFT: The Quakes are hitting significantly better this season against right-handed pitchers compared to left-handers. Over 1,128 at-bats against righties, the Quakes have accumulated 307 total hits, good for a .272 batting average. Rancho has seen far less from south-paws this season totaling just 180 at-bats, scattering 42 hits for a .233 average.

STARTING STRONG: Quakes starting pitchers delivered three strong outings over the weekday series in Lake Elsinore, 5/8-5/10. Andrew Sopko helped set the early tone, allowing just one run over six innings in a win on Tuesday. Dustin May pitched five scoreless frames and struck out a season-high nine Storm hitters on Wednesday night, while Tony Gonsolin packaged a scoreless five innings on Thursday en route to his first win of the season. Prior to Dean Kremer allowing a run after 4.1 innings on Friday, Quakes starting pitchers combined to throw 19.2 consecutive scoreless innings, a season high stretch for the rotation.

CURRENT STREAKS: Gavin Lux saw a team-high 12-game hitting streak come to a close after striking out as a pinch-hitter in the ninth inning of Saturday's game. Despite the streak coming to an end, Lux has still reached base on a hit in 19 of his last 22 games. During his streak, Lux has five three-hit games with 23 total hits. Omar Estevez has reached on a hit in six of his last nine games and Cristian Santana has also found the hit column in six of his last nine games.

RECENT ROSTER MOVES: Sunday, RHP Sven Schueller was transferred from Rancho Cucamonga to Extd Spring Training. Zach Pop has been transferred from Low-A Great Lakes to Rancho Cucamonga. Sunday, Quakes RHP Jordan Sheffield was placed on the DL with right-forearm tightness. Michael Boyle was been activated from the DL to the active Rancho roster. Saturday, Los Angeles Dodgers third baseman Justin Turner was added to the Quakes roster as part of a MLB rehab assignment. Turner is expected to play for Rancho in Sunday's 2:05pm game. All rehabbing Dodgers are brought to you by San Manuel Casino. Friday, INF Logan Forsythe was added to the Quakes roster as part of a MLB rehab assignment.

GONSOLIN GOES: Tony Gonsolin (1-1) will make his eighth start of the season for the Quakes and second against the Stockton Ports. Gonsolin last pitched against Stockton on 4/24, and allowed four runs on eight hits in a loss. Most recently in a start at Lake Elsinore, Gonsolin threw five shutout innings and struck out six en route to his first win of the season. The Vacaville, CA native was drafted in the 9th round of the 2016 draft by the Dodgers out of the University of Saint Mary's in the West Coast Conference.

OPPOSING PITCHER: Matt Milburn (1-2) is scheduled to make his seventh start of the year for the Ports and second against the Quakes. Milburn pitched against the Quakes at LoanMart Field on 4/26, and was tagged for 11 hits and six earned-runs in his first loss of the season. Milburn was able to settle in his last time out, allowing two runs over six innings at Visalia in a no-decision. The Dallas, TX native was a 29th round pick by the A's in 2016 out of Wofford College.

REHABBERS: Last week, the Quakes had three separate Dodgers join the club as apart of major league rehab assignment. Dodgers INF Justin Turner joined the Quakes along with INF Logan Forsythe in the weekend series vs. Visalia. Turner was 0-for-6 at the plate while Forsythe finished 1-for-10 with a double during their time in Rancho. Yasiel Puig joined the club on rehab assignment Tuesday in Lake Elsinore. On Tuesday, Puig was 0-for-4 at the plate and was removed from the game in the seventh inning.

FAMILIAR FACES ON THE FARM: A total of 16 former Quakes returned to Rancho Cucamonga to start the 2018 campaign, including 12 of the 14 original pitchers on the roster. Jordan Sheffield and Tony Gonsolin, ranked 18th and 24th in the Dodgers' system, by MLB Pipeline.com, return to the Quakes to help anchor the rotation. Former Quakes Dean Kremer, Issac Anderson and Andrew Sopko will also pitch out of the rotation. The bullpen began the year made up entirely of former Quakes, with Stetson Allie, Chris Matthewson, Parker Curry, Andrew Istler, Nolan Long, Ryan Moseley and Jason Richman making up the relief core. California League 2017 All-Star Ibandel Isabel, who mashed 28 home runs for last year's club, returned to the Quakes for a second year but was traded to the Cincinnati Reds. He was joined by returning infielder Omar Estevez and outfielder Logan Landon.

SAME SKIPPER, NEW STAFF: The skipper of the Quakes for a third consecutive year is Manager Drew Saylor, who has led the team to the Cal League Playoffs in each of the last two seasons. Saylor, whose team went 76-64 last season, is now 169-142 during his tenure and will be just the third manager in team history to lead the team for three seasons (Mike Basso 1996-1998, Bobby Meacham 2002-2004). The hitting coach is Justin Viele, a Fullerton native who enters his second year with the Dodgers. In 2017, the former Santa Clara Bronco was the hitting coach for the Ogden Raptors of the Pioneer League. Taking over pitching coach duties is Connor McGuinness who also enters his second year in the Dodgers' system. Last season, the Arlington, Virginia native worked in the same role for the Great Lakes Loons of the Midwest League, after spending three of the four previous years working for his alma mater, Emory University. The final member of Saylor's staff is assistant coach Petie Montero, another second-year member of the Dodgers' system, who coached in the DSL last year.

NINE & ON TIME: The Quakes are the only team in the California League that have yet to play an extra-inning game under the new MiLB rules this season. As a result, Rancho has completed all games in under four hours with the longest contest clocking in at 3:49 vs. Inland Empire on April 14th. April 14th marked the closest the Quakes have come to playing extras, tied at 6-6 in the ninth inning, Rancho scored the game-winning run in the bottom half and secured their first walk-off win of the season.

BY THE NUMBERS

Gavin Lux's 12-game hitting streak was the longest by any Quake this season. Lux passed Rylan Bannon who held the previous season long streak of eleven games. Over the stretch (Apr 26-5/11), Lux was 23-for-51 at the plate with six-multi hit games during the streak. In addition, Lux has also reached safely in 18 of his last 20 games.

Out of the bullpen, Parker Curry has added stability to the Quakes in the middle and late innings, allowing only a run over his last six appearances. Curry threw 9.1 consecutive scoreless innings prior to allowing a run in the seventh inning of Friday's game vs. Visalia. Curry also has the most wins on the Quakes with a 4-0 record.

When the Quakes have runners on base this season, Omar Estevez is the hitter to come up big. Estevez has knocked a team high 20 hits with runners aboard this season (.286 average) which has led to 19 runs driven in over those situations. On Sunday 5/6 at Visalia, Estevez hit a game-winning three-run home run in the top of the ninth leading the Quakes to a 10-7 victory and a series win over the Rawhide.
