PART THREE OF THE TRIP: The Portland Sea Dogs take the final turn of their nine-game roadtrip, opening up a three-game series with the Erie SeaWolves (Tigers affiliate) on Monday night at UPMC Park...Portland is 1-5 on the trip, dropping two of three in Altoona and swept in a three-game set in Akron...RHP **Teddy Stankiewicz** returns to the mound tonight - his last start was skipped for rest...Tonight's series opener is the lone contest in the Eastern League.

MEJIA WALKS THEM OFF: Pinch-hitter **Francisco Mejia** laced a two-out RBI double, scoring **Dorssys Paulino**, giving the Akron RubberDucks a 3-2 walk-off win on Sunday afternoon...Portland jumped on the board in the first, thanks to a two-out, two-run homer by **Nick Longhi**...Akron tied the game in the sixth inning on **Yu Chang's** two-out homer off **Bobby Poyner**...**Robbie Avilies** earned the win and **Luis Ysla** (1-4) suffered the loss.

HEATING UP: Longhi and Danny Mars each had three hits in Sunday's loss at Akron...Portland had seven hits overall, receiving a double from **Mike Olt** in the second inning...Mars is leading the team in hitting at .314 - tied for eighth in the Eastern League.

IN THE NICK OF TIME: Longhi hit his sixth homer on Sunday and his first with a runner-in-scoring position...This month, Longhi is hitting .309 (17-for-55), 2 HR, 12 RBI and 8 doubles.

THE MONTH OF MIKE: Olt is hitting .279 (12-for-43) with 2 homers and 6 RBI in June...Olt, **Henry Urrutia** and **Elih Villanueva** are the three Sea Dogs with Major League Experience.

FIRST NINE, VERY GOOD: Poyner yielded his first run in Double-A on Sunday after nine scoreless innings...The lefty had 14 strikeouts over the first 9 innings pitched.

AGAINST THE OPPONENT: Portland and Erie play their final series of the regular season...The Sea Dogs are 5-4-9 in 18 season series against Erie...Despite splitting four consecutive season series with Erie, the 'Dogs have won six of the last seven series from Erie in Maine.

FACING ERIE: 1-1, 3.72 ERA (8 ER/19.1 IP) in three career starts against Erie...Pitched the franchise's first 1-hit, 9-inning shutout on August 2, 2016 at Hadlock Field...Allowed a sixth-inning single to **Grayson Greiner** for the lone hit.

LOOK BACK AT 2016: Spent the entire season with Portland, going 5-9, 4.71 ERA (71 ER/135.2 IP), leading the team with 25 starts (7th in the Eastern League), quality starts (14) and innings pitched...Ranked among team leaders with 2 CG (3rd) and 97 SO (2nd)... Hurlled the first 9-inning complete game 1-hitter in franchise history on August 2nd vs. Erie (allowed 1 single and retired 27 of 28 batters faced).

CAREER/PERSONAL NOTES: Went 4-5 with a 2.52 ERA (17 ER/60.2 IP) at Seminole State College in 2013...Originally selected by the New York Mets in 2nd round of the 2012 June Draft out of Fort Worth Christian (TX) High School, but did not sign.
