Last Night's Game: What turned out to be a close game for all nine innings, the River Cats came out on the wrong side of a 2-0 shutout by the Iowa Cubs. River Cats starter **RHP Jordan Johnson** was stellar in his five innings pitched, holding the Cubs scoreless for the first three innings. Johnson's only run allowed came off a bases-loaded walk in the fourth inning to give Iowa a 1-0 lead, but Johnson finished with just two hits allowed with five strikeouts on the evening. **C Trevor Brown** recorded his fifth multi-hit game of the season, but Sacramento left nine men on base and would eventually fall by the final score of 2-0.

Tonight's Starter: **RHP Casey Kelly (9-8, 4.76)** makes his 22nd start of 2018, which leads the Pacific Coast League. The River Cats opening day starter also leads the PCL in innings pitched (119.0), is tied for third in wins (9), and is seventh in strikeouts (96). Kelly has been excellent in his last two starts (at Fresno and versus Omaha), allowing just two earned runs in 13.1 total innings, with four walks and 13 strikeouts. At home this season Kelly is 4-5 with a 3.32 ERA - compared to 5-3 with a 6.35 ERA on the road. The former first rounder (BOS - 2008) signed with the San Francisco Giants as a minor league free agent in July of 2017.

Beede Progress: **RHP Tyler Beede** continues to show strides of progression since being moved to the bullpen. Beede was effective again last night with two strikeouts in 1.2 innings pitched with 22 pitches and 15 strikes. He has recorded 14 strikeouts in his last twelve innings pitched.

Shaw HR Rate: With 21 homers this season, **OF Chris Shaw** is now hitting one home run per every 15.1 at-bats. Shaw's career high in home runs is 24 that he hit in 2017 between Double-A Richmond and Sacramento.

Rogers Tough As Ever: **RHP Tyler Rogers** now boasts an impressive .188 opposing batting average after his scoreless inning of relief in last night's contest. He has allowed just six hits in his last ten appearances, totalling 15.2 innings pitched.

River Cats in the Bigs: There are currently eight former 2018 River Cats on the San Francisco Giants 25-man roster. **RHP Derek Rodriguez** has been stellar in the starting rotation, and is making his case for National League Rookie of the Year (5-1, 2.75 ERA). In a small sample size, **RHP Ray Black** has been as dominant as ever, allowing opposing hitters to hit just .048 against him in 7.0 innings. The outfield duo of **OF Austin Slater** and **OF Steven Duggar** look to be up to stay, hitting .294 and .286 respectively and playing solid defense. **INF Chase d'Arnaud** has been a super utility player that has been useful in a number of spots, hitting .286 in 35 at bats.

*ADVANCED HITTING STATS GLOSSARY

PA: Plate Appearances

Plate Appearances are the total number of times a hitter completes a turn batting.

OPS: On-Base Plus Slugging

On-base Plus Slugging (OPS) is the sum of a player's on-base percentage (how often a player reaches base safely) and their slugging percentage (how many bases a player reaches per at bat).

ISO: Isolated Power

Isolated Power (ISO) is a measure of a hitter's raw power. Or, to look at it another way, it measures how good a player is at hitting for extra bases. The simplest way to calculate ISO is to subtract a player's Batting Average from their Slugging Percentage, which leaves us with a measure of just a player's extra bases per at bat.

BABIP: Batting Average on Balls In Play

Batting Average on Balls In Play (BABIP) measures how many of a batter's balls in play go for hits. Affected greatly by defense and luck, BABIP can dramatically affect a hitter's batting average. If a large number of a batter's balls in play go for hits, that can boost their batting average quite high. Similarly, if a large number of balls in play get caught, it can reduce a player's total offensive value.

wRC+: Weighted Runs Created Plus

Weighted Runs Created Plus measures the total number of runs a player contributes to their team. The formula accounts for a player's ability to get on base, their total number of bases, and their baserunning. The Plus version of the stat is park and league adjusted.

wOBA: Weighted On-Base Average

Weighted On-Base Average combines all the different aspects of hitting into one metric, weighting each of them in proportion to their actual run value. While batting average, on-base percentage, and slugging percentage fall short in accuracy and scope, wOBA measures and captures offensive value more accurately and comprehensively. (Due to no constant in minor league baseball, the wOBA statistic is approximate).

K% & BB%: Strikeout Rate and Walk Rate

Strikeout rate (K%) and walk rate (BB%) measure how often a position player walks or strikes out per plate appearance. They're measured in percentage form, so it's easy to compare between players and years.

ADVANCED PITCHING STATS GLOSSARY*

TBF: Total Batters Faced

Total Batters Faced measures the total number of plate appearances hitters have made against him.

AVG: Batting Average

Batting average is the rate of hits per at bat, calculated as hits/at bats.

BABIP: Batting Average on Balls In Play

Batting Average on Balls In Play (BABIP) measures how often a ball in play goes for a hit. Typically around 30% of all balls in play fall for hits, but there are several variables that can affect BABIP rates for individual players, such as defense, luck, and talent level. Hitters have more control over their BABIP than pitchers do.

LOB%: Left On Base Percentage

Left on Base Percentage (LOB%) measures the percentage of base runners that a pitcher strands on base over the course of a season. This stat does not use the left on base numbers reported in box scores, but instead is calculated using a pitcher's actual hits, walks, and runs allowed results.

FIP: Fielding Independent Pitching

Fielding Independent Pitching (FIP) measures what a player's ERA should have looked like over a given time period, assuming that performance on balls in play and timing were league average. (Due to no constant in minor league baseball, the FIP statistic is approximate).

K% & BB%: Strikeout Rate and Walk Rate

Strikeout rate (K%) and walk rate (BB%) measure how often a pitcher walks or strikes out a player per plate appearance. They're measured in percentage form, so it's easy to compare between players and years.

xFIP: Expected Fielding Independent Pitching

Same as FIP, but it normalizes a pitcher's home runs allowed based on their fly ball rate rather than simply using the raw number of home runs allowed.
