**Last Game:** Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp right fielder John Norwood and first baseman Taylor Ard each hit their third home runs in the third inning to lead the home team to a 4-2 win over the Mobile BayBears in front of 7,912 before Boy Scouts filled the outfield for a Scout Night Sleepover at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville Saturday night. Jacksonville right-hander Omar Bencomo (4-0) became the team's first four-game winner, as he went five innings, allowing one earned run on six hits and a walk with six strikeouts. Mobile (11-12) managed a run in the second inning, when Bencomo hit two batters, allowed a double to right fielder Michael Herмосillo and left fielder Forrest Allday's RBI single. Trailing 1-0 in the third inning against right-hander Grayson Long (0-1), the Jumbo Shrimp (9-14) put shortstop K.C. Serna on base on BayBears second baseman Andrew Daniel's fielding error. A wild pitch and groundout preceded left fielder Jeremias Pineda's RBI single through the left side of the infield for a 1-1 tie. In the third inning, Norwood led off with a line-drive to the left-field berm to put Jacksonville ahead, 2-1. Second baseman David Vidal then singled to center field – extending his team-high 14-game hitting streak. Designated hitter Alex Glenn grounded into a fielder's choice, before Ard drove a fly ball off the Nimnicht left-field foul pole for a two-run home run and 4-1 Jumbo Shrimp lead. Norwood and Ard are tied for the team lead with three home runs this season. Given the lead, Bencomo did not allow a runner past second base through the fifth inning. Right-hander Hunter Adkins followed with three scoreless innings, allowing three hits and striking out three batters. Right-hander Tyler Kinley began the ninth inning by allowing two singles and BayBears shortstop Hutton Moyer's sacrifice fly, before a strikeout and popout to record his second save of the season.

## NEWS AND NOTES

**Oh Yes, They Call Him the Streak:** Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp second baseman David Vidal currently has a 14-game hitting streak for the Jumbo Shrimp, which is the longest active and overall streak in the Southern League this season. In his hitting streak, Vidal is hitting .375 (21-for-56) with two home runs and seven RBI. Vidal is also hitting .330, which is the fourth best batting average in the Southern League, his 29 hits also lead the league, and his 41 total bases are tied for third in the Southern League. Vidal was named the Southern League Player of the Week for the week of April 17-23, and could well be on his way to a second straight weekly honor.

**Gunkel Makes Marlins Organization Debut:** Today right-handed pitcher Joe Gunkel makes his Miami Marlins organization debut as he faces the Mobile BayBears at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Gunkel was acquired by the Marlins off waivers from the Los Angeles Dodgers and optioned to Double-A Jacksonville, and he is now a member of the Marlins 40-man roster. Gunkel was in spring training with the Orioles this season, however Baltimore designated him for assignment on April 7, then the club traded him to the Dodgers on April 10 for a player to be named later. Gunkel started the season with the Triple-A Oklahoma City Dodgers, where he had no wins or losses and a 4.00 ERA in his three appearances and one start. He was designated for assignment by the Dodgers on April 25, and the Marlins claimed him off waivers two days later on April 27.

**Homers at the Baseball Grounds:** While the Jumbo Shrimp have only played eight home games, seven of their 11 home runs in 2017 have been hit at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. In the past two games, Jacksonville has hit three homers, including a two-home run game yesterday with John Norwood and Taylor Ard both hitting home runs in the bottom of the fourth inning. Both of Biran Anderson's home runs have been hit at the Baseball Grounds this year. This has already been the most prolific home run series of the season for the Jumbo Shrimp, hitting four home runs over the past three games against the Mobile BayBears.

**Attendance Kings:** After playing 15 of the first 20 games of the season on the road, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp are thrilled to be back at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. The last two nights the Jumbo Shrimp have welcomed in over 7,000 fans, despite a hectic sports and entertainment schedule in downtown Jacksonville. Currently the Jumbo Shrimp lead the Southern League in attendance average, by welcoming in an average of 7,662 which is more than 1,000 fans more than the next closest team (Birmingham – 6,645). Saturday's crowd of 7,341 fans was also the only Saturday Southern League crowd over 5,000 fans. The first home series of the year was from April 12-16 against Chattanooga, and it saw record crowds as the Baseball Grounds. With 41,276 in attendance over five days, Jacksonville fans made the inaugural Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp home series the highest-attended series in the 15-year history of the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville.

Gunkel pitched in the Red Sox organization until 2015 when he was traded to the Baltimore Orioles in exchange for cash and left fielder Alejandro De Aza on June 3, 2015. Gunkel was in spring training with the Orioles this season, however Baltimore designated him for assignment on April 7, then the club traded him to the Dodgers on April 10 for a player to be named later.

**PROSPECT:** Gunkel entered the 2017 season as the Baltimore Orioles No. 20 prospect according to Baseball America.

Gunkel started the season with the Triple-A Oklahoma City Dodgers, where he had no wins or losses and a 4.00 ERA in his three appearances and one start. He was designated for assignment by the Dodgers on April 25, and the Marlins claimed him off waivers two days later on April 27.

**2016 Highlights:** Started the season with Double-A Bowie, making four starts for the Baysox. Promoted to Triple-A Norfolk on 5 1...Led the Tides in starts (24), innings pitched (141.1), and strikeouts (94), and finished second on the team in wins (eight). Earned his first win with Norfolk on 5 22 at Syracuse after throwing 7.0 shutout innings with two walks and three strikeouts. Tossed an 8.0-inning complete game on 6 9 at Durham, allowing three runs on five hits, two home runs, with four strikeouts and suffered the loss. Was the only Norfolk pitcher to have a complete game...Tossed a season-high 100 pitches in his complete game on 6/9. Had a streak of 25.2 innings in which he allowed only one run, 7/22-8/13. Left-handers hit .260 (57-for-219) with four home runs off of him, while right-handers hit .294 (99-for-337) with 10 home runs. Entered 2016 as the Orioles No. 23 prospect, according to MLB.com
