**Last Game:** Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp shortstop KC Serna and first baseman Taylor Ard each homered, and right-hander Chris Mazza pitched 5 2/3 innings for his first win of the season to defeat the Mississippi Braves, 5-2, and extend a four-game winning streak in front of 4,770 on Education Day Monday at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Serna, who returned to the roster Monday after 13 days with Triple-A New Orleans, led off the first inning against Braves left-hander Max Fried (2-6) with his first Southern League home run over the left field ribbon board. Jacksonville (19-26) added to the lead in the fourth inning. Right fielder Cal Towey hit a one-out single to center field, and Ard sent a high drive down the left-field line for his fifth home run of the season, extending the lead to 3-0. In the bottom of the fifth inning, Jacksonville center fielder Yefri Perez led off with a bunt single, and Mazza reached on his own sacrifice when Perez beat a throw to second base. Fried's errant pickoff throw toward second base allowed both runners to advance, so Fried intentionally walked second baseman David Vidal to load the bases. Third baseman Brian Anderson hit a sacrifice fly to make it 4-0. Fried lasted six innings, allowing four earned runs on six hits and three walks with six strikeouts. Mazza kept Mississippi (22-23) scoreless for the first five innings. In the top of the sixth inning, Fried hit a leadoff single, and second baseman Luis Valenzuela hit an RBI triple to right field. Center fielder Ronald Acuna hit a sacrifice fly to bring the Braves within 4-2. Mazza left with two outs, allowing two earned runs on four hits and one walk with five strikeouts. The Jumbo Shrimp added an eighth-inning run when left fielder Alex Glenn doubled, went to third base on a sacrifice by catcher Austin Nola and later scored on a wild pitch against right-hander Jason Hursh. Left-hander James Buckelew pitched 1 1/3 scoreless innings for the Jumbo Shrimp, before right-hander Hunter Adkins pitched the final two innings with two strikeouts and no hits or walks to earn his second save.cdd

## NEWS AND NOTES

**Locke Shines in Second Rehab Start:** Miami Marlins left-handed starting pitcher Jeff Locke made his second rehab appearance Thursday night with the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp against the Jackson Generals. Locke worked six innings, allowing no runs, on six hits, with five strikeouts and two walks. He earned the victory in Jacksonville's 5-0 win over the Generals. He spoke with Roger Hoover after his outing about how he settled in after the first inning. "I had a little shaky first inning there, but I always seem to be feel better as the game progresses. I had some guys make some great plays behind me. I threw some poor pitches at times, but you're not going to be perfect every time" Locke said. The Marlins left hander threw 78 pitches and 53 strikes on Thursday night against the Generals. After Wednesday's start there is no doubt that Jeff Locke believes he is ready to make his return to the big leagues. He said, "In my opinion I'm ready to go, if this is the last one I'm good to go. Knowing yourself, knowing your body, knowing your mentality, it's time to go."

**Let's Play Two:** Tonight the Jumbo Shrimp and Generals will honor Hall of Famer Ernie Banks by playing a doubleheader at the Baseball Grounds, starting at 5:05 p.m. The doubleheader is necessary because Wednesday night's game was postponed due to rain. So far the Jumbo Shrimp have only played one doubleheader this season, splitting a Sunday twinbill at Tennessee on May 7. There was also a scheduled doubleheader the day before only to see the game get postponed due to weather. The Jumbo Shrimp are 1-2 in seven inning games so far this season, and this is the first time that the Jumbo Shrimp have hosted a doubleheader at the Baseball Grounds in 2017.

**S.L. Leaders:** David Vidal is fifth in the league in hitting with a .313 average, and fourth in the league with 50 hits. Brian Anderson is also second in the league (and the active leader) with 31 RBI. Tonight's game two starting pitcher Matt Tomshaw also sports the sixth-best ERA in the Southern League at 2.24.

**Generals in Town:** This series marks the only trip of the season for the Jackson Generals to Jacksonville. The Jumbo Shrimp will only travel to Jackson once, from June 22-26 at the start of the second half of the season. The Baseball Grounds is separated from The Ballpark at Jackson by 713 miles, longest distance between any two Southern League cities.

**LAST START:** Gunkel had a no decision in his start on Thursday May 18 against Mississippi at the Baseball Grounds. Gunkel worked four and two-thirds innings where he allowed four runs (none earned) on four hits with two walks and four strikeouts. Gunkel left the game in the top of the fifth with the score 4-1, only to see James Buckelew allow a grand slam to Carlos Franco to allow runners left by Gunkel to score. Mississippi won the game by a final score of 6-4.

**SMOKIES START:** Gunkel took the loss in his start on Saturday May 6 at Tennessee in game one of a scheduled doubleheader (second game eventually postponed). Gunkel worked four innings where he allowed four runs on six hits with a homer surrendered and two walks with a strikeout, as Tennessee won 7-4. After he returned to the Jacksonville roster he also worked a 1-2-3 inning in relief at Mobile on May 15.

**BAYBEARS START.** Gunkel turned in four scoreless innings in his Marlins organization debut for the Jumbo Shrimp on Sunday April 30 against the Mobile BayBears at the Baseball Grounds. Gunkel worked four scoreless innings, allowing only two hits with no walks and a strikeout. Jacksonville eventually won the 3-2 with John Norwood hitting a walk-off home run in the bottom of the 11<sup>th</sup>.

**2017 SO FAR:** Gunkel was in spring training with the Orioles this season, however Baltimore designated him for assignment on April 7, then the club traded him to the Dodgers on April 10 for a player to be named later. Gunkel started the season with the Triple-A Oklahoma City Dodgers, where he had no wins or losses and a 4.00 ERA in his three appearances and one start. He was designated for assignment by the Dodgers on April 25, and the Marlins claimed him off waivers two days later on April 27.

**2017 Highlights:** Gunkel was in spring training with the Orioles this season, however Baltimore designated him for assignment on April 7, then the club traded him to the Dodgers on April 10 for a player to be named later. Gunkel started the season with the Triple-A Oklahoma City Dodgers, where he had no wins or losses and a 4.00 ERA in his three appearances and one start. He was designated for assignment by the Dodgers on April 25, and the Marlins claimed him off waivers two days later on April 27.

**2016 Highlights:** Started the season with Double-A Bowie, making four starts for the Baysox. Promoted to Triple-A Norfolk on 5/1...Led the Tides in starts (24), innings pitched (141.1), and strikeouts (94), and finished second on the team in wins (eight). Earned his first win with Norfolk on 5/22 at Syracuse after throwing 7.0 shutout innings with two walks and three strikeouts. Tossed an 8.0-inning complete game on 6/9 at Durham, allowing three runs on five hits, two home runs, with four strikeouts and suffered the loss. Was the only Norfolk pitcher to have a complete game...Tossed a season-high 100 pitches in his complete game on 6/9. Had a streak of 25.2 innings in which he allowed only one run, 7/22-8/13. **LAST START:** Tomshaw had a no decision in his start against Mississippi on Saturday May 20 at the Baseball Grounds. Tomshaw worked six innings where he allowed a pair of runs on seven hits with a walk and six strikeouts. Tomshaw left the game with Jacksonville up 3-2, only to see the M-Braves tie the game with a solo homer by Connor Lien in the top of the ninth, then John Norwood hit a walk-off homer in the bottom of the ninth to win the game 4-3.

**BAYBEARS WIN:** Tomshaw earned the win in his start on Mother's Day Sunday May 14. Tomshaw worked six and two-third innings where he allowed a run on six hits with three walks and two strikeouts as the Jumbo Shrimp ended a six-game losing streak with a 3-1 win.

**SHUCKERS START:** Tomshaw had a no decision in his start on Tuesday May 9 against the Biloxi Shuckers at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Tomshaw worked five innings where he allowed three runs on six hits with a walk and five strikeouts. Tomshaw left with the game tied 3-3, only to see the Shuckers win 6-4.

**SMOKIES START:** Tomshaw had a no decision in his start on Thursday May 4 at Tennessee. Tomshaw worked seven scoreless innings where he allowed six hits, walked none and struck out two. Tomshaw left the game with the score 0-0, only to see Jacksonville score a run in the eighth to put him in line for the win. Tennessee had a two-run homer by David Bote in the bottom of the eighth to go in front 2-1, however Jacksonville scored five runs in the ninth to win the game 6-2.

## #18 MATT TOMSHAW LHP | 6-1, 205 lbs | Born: Kingston, NY. Age: 28

Acquired by the Marlins in the 2014 Rule 5 draft from the Minnesota Twins

Originally drafted by the Twins in the 42<sup>nd</sup> round of the 2011 June First-Year Player Draft out of Jacksonville University.

**2016 Highlights:** Tomshaw had three stints with Jacksonville from May 30-June 20, June 22-July 30, and August 5 through the end of the season. With Jacksonville he was 4-4 with a 3.63 ERA in 15 appearances and 14 starts. He struck out at least six batters in his last five starts for Jacksonville, beginning with a season-high of 10 on August 12 vs. Mississippi. Tomshaw was 0-1 with a 2.12 ERA in eight games in relief for the New Orleans Zephyrs, with his first five appearances coming in the month of May, and the final three in late July, early August. Tomshaw took his lone loss when he allowed a pair of runs in the 12<sup>th</sup> inning against the Colorado Springs Sky Sox on May 12. Tomshaw returned to the Zephyrs where he made an appearance June 21 allowing a hit with no walks with four strikeouts. Tomshaw in late July and August pitched for the Zephyrs in two relief outings on July 30 and August 3, turning in scoreless outings against the Nashville Sounds and Iowa Cubs. After some time in extended spring training, Tomshaw earned the win in his lone appearance with the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads on May 1. He worked three scoreless innings, allowing a hit with a strikeout.

**2015 Highlights:** Spent the majority of his first season in the Marlins system with Double-A Jacksonville. Tomshaw went 6-10 with a 4.33 ERA in 20 appearances and 18 starts. finished year s reliever: 1-1, 4.50 ERA in 11 G, started season as starter: 4-6, 5.35 ERA in 12 GS. Made two starts with Triple-A New Orleans in Mid-August, going 0-2 with a 17.18 ERA, allowing 15 runs (14 earned) in 7.1 IP.

**2014 Highlights:** He spent all of last year with advanced-A Fort Myers Miracle, going 11-6 with a 3.50 ERA in 25 games and 21 starts over 136.1 innings. On the campaign he set career highs for innings pitched (136.1) and tied his career high with 82 strikeouts. Tomshaw led the Miracle in wins (11), games started (21), and was second in total strikeouts (82).

**2013 Highlights:** He split 2013 with Fort Myers (A+) and Cedar Rapids (A-). With Fort Myers the southpaw posted a 4-4 mark to go along with a 3.94 ERA in 17 games and 14 starts over 96.0 innings. His 42 earned runs given up with FM were good for second-most he has allowed in a single stop. With CR, Tomshaw went 2-0 with a 5.10 ERA in nine games and four starts over 30.0 innings pitched. Batters hit .290 against Tomshaw at the low-A stop which was the worst of his career.

**2012 Highlights:** Tomshaw split 2012 between the GCL Twins and the Beloit Snappers (A). With GCL, he appeared in only two games and over his three innings pitched he allowed two hits. He spent the majority of the year with Beloit, going 4-6 attached to a 3.02 ERA in 20 games and 14 starts over 86.1 innings pitched. At the time that had been Tomshaw's first season with 20

**2011 Highlights:** After being drafted he had stops between the GCL Twins and Fort Myers. In his first year in rookie ball the southpaw mustered up a 3-0 record while pitching to a 2.16 ERA in 11 games over 16.2 innings. He would receive his first call up to Fort Myers and enter into the starting rotation setting a 2.13 ERA in seven games and four starts over 25.1 innings.

**Personal:** Tomshaw was drafted out of Jacksonville University, and in an interview with *twinsdaily.com* he highlighted some of his bright spots with JU. "One of my biggest wins was against University of Florida during the regular season at their stadium. They just came off taking two from Vanderbilt that weekend. At the time, Florida was ranked 4th in the nation, and we ended up beating them 11-2. After the College World Series was over and Florida finished 2nd only to South Carolina, did it hit me how big of a win that was. Also in my senior year in game 1 of the conference tournament against Eastern Tennessee State University, I threw a complete game allowing 5 hits, 1 unearned run and winning 2-1.
