Today's Game: The Nashville Sounds and San Antonio Missions play their final game of the 2019 season this afternoon at First Tennessee Park. Nashville has won two of the first three games of the series. Today, left-hander Wes Benjamin starts for the Sounds against right-hander Carlos Luna for the Missions.

Wes Benjamin: 26-year-old Wes Benjamin starts for the Sounds this afternoon. The left-hander is making his 27th appearance (25th start) of the season and is 7-6 with a 5.52 ERA while covering 130.1 innings. Benjamin has yielded 147 hits and 52 walks to go with 108 strikeouts. Benjamin last pitched on August 28 at Omaha and limited the Storm Chasers to one run in six innings. He walked one and struck out four the quality start. Benjamin spent the majority of his 2018 season with Double-A Frisco where he went 5-6 with a 3.62 ERA in 15 starts. The southpaw spent nearly two months on the disabled list from June 7-July 31 with a left elbow strain. Despite missing time, Benjamin led the Frisco staff in wins and ranked among team leaders in strikeouts (3rd), starts (T3rd) and innings (4th). In his minor league career, Benjamin is 28-24 with a 4.25 ERA while covering 88 games (83 starts). The Rangers drafted the Illinois native in the 5th round of the 2014 MLB Draft out of Kansas University.

Carlos Luna: 22-year-old Carlos Luna starts for the Missions today. The right-hander is making his Triple-A debut after being transferred from the Short-Season Rocky Mountain Vibes on August 31. With the Vibes, Luna was 3-4 with a 3.66 ERA in 13 starts. He covered 66.1 innings and allowed 67 hits and 10 walks to go along with 65 strikeouts. Luna's last outing was against the Orem Owlz on August 24. He limited Orem to one run on four hits in six innings. He didn't issue any walks and struck out 10 batters in the win. In his career, he's 10-10 with a 2.92 ERA in 45 games (25 starts). The Milwaukee Brewers signed him to a minor league free agent contract on July 11, 2013.

2019 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following amount of days in the American Northern Division standings in 2019: First: 1, Second: 1, Third: 51, Fourth: 91.

The Final Act: Today's game between Nashville and San Antonio is the finale of the 2019 season. Nashville has won five consecutive regular season finales with wins over Memphis in 2018, New Orleans in 2017, Omaha in 2015, Round Rock in 2014 and Iowa in 2013. The regular season finale in 2016 was cancelled due to rain in New Orleans. The last time the Sounds lost on the final day of the regular season was a 2-1 setback to Memphis in 2012.

From Start to Finish: Nashville has five players on today's roster who have been with the team from start to finish. Pitchers Wes Benjamin and Tim Dillard, catcher Jett Bandy and infielders Eli White and Matt Davidson were all on the Opening Day roster and have not gone up or down.

From Nashville to Texas for a Debut: Over the course of the 2019 season, there were 10 players who went from Nashville to Texas for their Major League debut. The list includes: Kyle Bird, Brett Martin, Taylor Hearn, Pete Fairbanks, Phillips Valdez, Locke St. John, Scott Heineman, Pedro Payano, Nick Solak and Brock Burke.

Wes Side Story: Today's starter Wes Benjamin has saved his best work for the latter part of the season. In the month of August, Benjamin is 3-1 with a 3.38 ERA (11 ER/29.1 IP) in 5 games (4 starts). Benjamin has limited Pacific Coast League opponents to a .233 batting average while issuing 8 walks and recording 22 strikeouts. In 17 games (16 starts) before the All-Star break, Benjamin was 4-5 with a 6.84 ERA (59 ER/77.2 IP). In 9 games (8 starts) since the break, the southpaw is 3-1 with a 3.59 ERA (21 ER/52.2 IP).

100-RBI Man: Matt Davidson knocked in four runs Saturday night to bring his season total to 100 RBI. He is the fourth player in team history to hit the 100-RBI mark in a season, joining Steve Balboni (122 in 1980), Drew Denson (103 in 1993) and Drew Denson (103 in 1994). Davidson drove in 30 runs in the month of August - the second-most by a Sounds player in a single month in the PCL era (1998-present). Only Chad Hermansen (33 in July of 1999) has knocked in more than Davidson in a single month.

Climbing the Home Run Board: Infielder Matt Davidson launched his 33rd home run of the season Saturday, moving into a three-way tie for third-most in Nashville Sounds single-season team history. He is tied with Dan Pasqua (1984) and Craig Wilson (2000). The home run record is 34, shared by Steve Balboni (1980) and Brian Dayett (1982). Davidson hit nine of his 33 home runs in the month of August. Davidson's 33 home runs are the sixth-most in the Pacific Coast League.

Bash Brothers: Matt Davidson (33) and Patrick Wisdom (30) are the first pair of Sounds teammates to hit at least 30 home runs in the same season. They join Fresno's Yadiel Hernandez (32) and Brandon Snyder (31), Las Vegas' Seth Brown (37) and Mark Payton (30), and Salt Lake's Jared Walsh (36) and Jose Rojas (31) as the only pair of teammates in the Pacific Coast League to eclipse the 30-homer mark.

Congrats to Carpenter: Nashville closer David Carpenter was named to the All-Pacific Coast League team on Monday. The team is selected through voting by the league's managers and media representatives. Carpenter leads all of Triple-A Baseball with 20 saves and is 2-0 with a 1.77 ERA (7 ER/35.2 IP) in 36 games. He is the first Sound to be recognized on the All-PCL Team since Renato Núñez in 2017, and he's the first Nashville pitcher to garner the honor since Jimmy Nelson in 2014. Carpenter is the first Sound to be named to the All-PCL team as a relief pitcher since all-time saves leader Mark Corey in 2003.

Last Outing: Benjamin last pitched on August 28 in a start against the Storm Chasers in Omaha. He logged his seventh quality start of the season, and fifth consecutive. He tossed 6.0 innings and allowed 1 run on 5 hits and 1 walk. Benjamin struck out four batters and threw 59 of his 93 pitches for strikes.

Against Opponent: Benjamin has faced San Antonio twice in 2019. His first outing was in a start on April 21 at First Tennessee Park. HE allowed 4 runs on 3 hits in 1.2 innings. He faced them in San Antonio on July 18 and allowed 2 runs on 7 hits in 5.1 innings. Overall in the two games, he's 0-1 with a 7.71 ERA (6 ER/7.0 IP). He has allowed 10 hits and 4 walks with 4 strikeouts.
