Last Game: Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp right-hander Max Duval pitched a season-long seven innings, not allowing a hit in six of them, but the Mobile BayBears scored three runs on four hits in the second inning and shut out the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp until two outs in the ninth inning of a 3-1 win in the opener of a four-game series at Hank Aaron Stadium. Duval (2-8) allowed the BayBears (7-5 second half, 44-36 overall) to score all their runs and tally all four of their hits in the bottom of the second inning. First baseman Jared Walsh doubled to left field and went to third base on third baseman Zach Houchins' single to center field. After shortstop Roberto Baldoquin popped out, second baseman Jose Rojas hit a sacrifice fly to center field, scoring Walsh. Catcher Michael Barash then hit a two-run home run to left-center field. Mobile did not have another runner in scoring position after the second inning. At one point, Duval retired 10 batters in a row. He walked three batters and struck out three. After Duval, right-hander Reilly Hovis pitched a perfect eighth inning. BayBears right-hander Alex Klonowski (5-1) shut out Jacksonville (3-10, 31-50) for the first six innings, allowing a hit in each of his innings but stranding six runners on base. He did not walk a batter and struck out six. Following Klonowski, right-hander Tyler Stevens pitched a perfect seventh inning and worked around a pair of singles in the eighth inning, striking out three batters in two scoreless innings. With Jacksonville trailing 3-0 and two outs in the ninth inning against Mobile right-hander Zac Ryan, Jumbo Shrimp catcher Rodrigo Vigil singled to center field. Third baseman Brian Schales walked, and left fielder Brian Miller hit an RBI double to right field. With the tying runs at second and third base, Jacksonville center fielder Monte Harrison, already with a game-best three hits, grounded out to Baldoquin at shortstop to end the game.

NEWS AND NOTES

Miller Gets Hits: At the top of the order, Jacksonville is getting plenty of production from outfielder Brian Miller. Miller has hit safely in 12 of 13 games played for the Jumbo Shrimp since joining the club in the second half, and is currently riding a six-game hitting streak, reaching safely in the final five games of the Biscuits series and the first one against Mobile, plus he also drove in Jacksonville's lone run last night. Additionally, three of the games that he has hit safely he has had multi-hit games against the Biscuits. Miller was a 2018 Florida State League Midseason All-Star with Jupiter, where in 62 games hit .324 with 29 runs batted in along with 13 doubles, three triples, and 19 stolen bases. At time of promotion ranked first in the Florida State League in hits (83), third in FSL in average (.324), second in at-bats (256), third in stolen bases (19). Miller was selected by the Marlins just last year in the 2017 draft, picked in the first round.

Mahoney Gets the Start: With an odd schedule last series due to rain, Jumbo Shrimp right-hander Kolton Mahoney makes a spot start tonight for Jacksonville against the Mobile BayBears. Mahoney has pitched in 17 games and has made seven starts for the Jumbo Shrimp this season, going 3-3 with a 3.33 ERA. Mahoney has proven to be a valuable member of Dave LaRoche's pitching staff, swinging back and forth between the starting rotation and bullpen. As a reliever, Mahoney is 3-2 with a 2.14 ERA in 10 relief outings with a save. As a starting pitcher, Mahoney is 0-1 with a 4.09 ERA in his seven starts.

Hello BayBears: This is the third of four series this season between the Jumbo Shrimp and the Mobile BayBears, the Double-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Angels. Earlier this season the Jumbo Shrimp won three out of four games played in the first home series of the year from April 11-14. The game on Sunday April 15 was postponed due to rain, creating the need for a doubleheader on Friday May 18. During the second series, the BayBears won four out of six games against the Jumbo Shrimp from May 18 to May 21. The BayBears do not return to Jacksonville, and the Jumbo Shrimp will make a return trip to Mobile from July 28-August 1. Last year Jacksonville had a winning record against Mobile, going 14-7 overall. The clubs split the two series at Hank Aaron Stadium 5-5, while the Jumbo Shrimp were 9-2 against the BayBears at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville last season.

Mahoney worked five innings where he allowed six runs (all earned) on eight hits with four walks and five strikeouts as the Cakes lost 6-4.

LAST BAYBEARS START: In his last start against the BayBears in Game Two of Jacksonville's doubleheader with Mobile on Friday May 18, working five innings where he allowed two runs (one earned) on six hits with a walk and a strikeout as Jacksonville lost 3-1.

Signed by the Miami Marlins as a minor league free agent on May 30, 2017

2017 Highlights: Mahoney started the 2017 season still a member of the New York Yankees organization. After going 1-2 with a 1.85 ERA in 11 games, collecting one save, and striking out 26 batters in 24 and a third innings with Single-A Charleston, he was released by the Yankees on May 27. The Marlins signed him three days later on May 30, and he finished the season with Single-A Greensboro, also in the South Atlantic League. With the Grasshoppers, Mahoney went 5-5 with a 4.08 ERA in 18 games pitched and 13 starts, striking out 74 batters in 79 and a third innings of work.

2016 Highlights: With the New York-Penn League's Staten Island Yankees, Mahoney went 4-4 with a 2.92 ERA in 12 appearances and eight starts.

2015 Highlights: Selected by the New York Yankees in the 16th round of the 2015 draft out of Brigham Young University. With the New York-Penn League's Staten Island Yankees, Mahoney went 3-2 with a 2.29 ERA in 12 appearances and 10 starts, with 50 strikeouts in 55 innings of work.

College: Prior to being drafted in 2015, he went 4-8 in 13 starts this season for the Cougars, striking out 91 and earning a 5.27 ERA in 85 1/3 innings pitched. In summer 2014, pitched for Orleans (Massachusetts) Firebirds in the Cape Cod League. He finished his stint there with six starts, a 3-2 record, one save, a team-high 47 strikeouts and a 1.97 ERA in regular-season play. Three times, he had double-digit strikeouts for Orleans, including 13 in a playoff victory. After his junior season with BYU, Mahoney was selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 23rd round in 2014 but did not sign.

Personal: Served a mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Santa Rosa, Calif. Also was selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 23rd round of 2014 draft. Started for Northridge High ... honorable mention all-state in 2010 ... played in the 5A all-star game ... selected to Deseret News All-Area team ... recorded 77 strikeouts in nine starts ... threw a no hitter in 2009 against Clearfield.
