Last Game: Biloxi Shuckers second baseman Javier Betancourt homered and had three hits to lead his team to a 5-3 win over the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp in front of 4,642 at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville Thursday night. Jacksonville right-hander Chris Mazza (0-2) kept Biloxi (18-16) scoreless until the fifth inning, when second baseman Javier Betancourt hit a two-out solo home run to left field. Mazza finished five innings, allowing an earned run on three hits and one walk with three strikeouts. Biloxi added a sixth-inning run against left-hander Kyle Lobstein, as shortstop Mauricio Dubon singled, went to second base on a groundout, stole third base and scored on catcher Austin Nola's passed ball. Trailing 2-0 against Biloxi right-hander Luis Ortiz (2-3), Jacksonville (13-21) had a sixth-inning leadoff double by third baseman Brian Anderson. He advanced to third base on a flyout and scored on second baseman David Vidal's sacrifice fly. The 2-1 lead was preserved for 1 1/3 innings by left-hander Nick Ramirez, who was aided by catcher Jacob Nottingham throwing out center fielder Yefri Perez at second base to end the seventh inning. In the eighth inning, Nottingham began a double play when Anderson popped up a bunt in front of home plate against right-hander Bubba Derby. In the ninth inning against Jacksonville right-hander Tyler Higgins, Shuckers right fielder Clint Coulter homered to left field, pinch hitter Art Charles doubled, and Dubon and third baseman Angel Ortega each hit RBI singles for a 5-1 lead. Jacksonville scored ninth-inning runs on Vidal's RBI double and Perez's RBI groundout before right-hander Matt Ramsey got the final two outs with the tying runs on base for his third save of the series against his former club.

NEWS AND NOTES

Yarbrough's Streak Comes to an End: Jacksonville shortstop Alex Yarbrough saw his 10-game hitting streak come to an end on Thursday night by going 0-for-5 against the Biloxi Shuckers. In his streak, Yarbrough is hit .441 (15-for-34) with five runs batted in with four doubles and two triples during his hot stretch at the plate. Yarbrough is now hitting .295, which is the second highest average on the team behind David Vidal's .310 average. Yarbrough also leads Jacksonville with three triples. Yarbrough is in his first season in the Marlins organization after he was selected by Miami in the 2016 Rule 5 Draft, Triple-A Phase from the Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim.

Bencomo Looks to Continue Home Success: Tonight's Jacksonville starting pitcher Omar Bencomo has loved pitching at home at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville this season. Bencomo is 2-0 with a 0.82 ERA (1 ER/11.0 IP) in his two starts against Chattanooga and Mobile this season. Bencomo made five stats for the Jumbo Shrimp in April, going 4-0 with a 1.27 ERA, and for his strong work he was named the Marlins Minor League Pitcher of the Month for April. Bencomo is in his first season in the Marlins organization, after signing with the organization as a minor league free agent in February after previously pitching in the Minnesota Twins system.

Goodbye (For Now) Shuckers: Today marks the finale of the first series of the season between the Jumbo Shrimp and their South Division opponent the Biloxi Shuckers. The clubs will become very familiar with one another this season, with five series between the clubs scheduled. The Shrimp will visit Biloxi from June 9-13 to mark the last meeting in the first half of the season. In the second half there will be three series between the clubs, first with the Shuckers coming to Jacksonville from July 9-12. The Jumbo Shrimp will then face the Shuckers in Biloxi from July 30 to August 3 and from August 26-30. Last year Jacksonville was 11-9 against the Shuckers, with a 6-4 record at the Baseball Grounds opposed to 5-5 at MGM Park in Biloxi.

BayBears Next: Following the game the Jumbo Shrimp will load the Annett bus and head west to Mobile to face the Mobile BayBears from Saturday through Wednesday at Hank Aaron Stadium. The Jumbo Shrimp and BayBears recently met at the Baseball Grounds, with Jacksonville winning the series 4-1. The BayBears took the first game 8-3 before Jacksonville rallied off four straight victories to close out the series. Jacksonville's final two wins were in walk-off fashion, with John Norwood hitting a walk-off homer in the bottom of the eleventh inning on April 30, and then Brian Anderson hitting a walk-off RBI double on May 1 to complete the series.

LAST START: Bencomo took his first loss of the season on Sunday May 7 in the first game of the doubleheader against the Tennessee Smokies at Smokies Stadium. Bencomo worked four and a third innings where he allowed nine runs (eight earned) on eight hits with a walk and four strikeouts as the Smokies won 9-2.

BAYBEARS START: Bencomo earned his second straight victory by defeating the Mobile BayBears on Saturday April 29 at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Bencomo worked five innings where he allowed a run on six hits with two walks and six strikeouts as the Shrimp won 4-2.

MARLINS MiLB PITCHER OF THE MONTH FOR APRIL: Bencomo has been named the Miami Marlins Minor League Pitcher of the Month for April, announced by the Marlins front office on Friday May 5. Bencomo made five stats for the Jumbo Shrimp in April, going 4-0 with a 1.27 ERA. Over his 28 and one-third innings pitched, Bencomo held opponents to a .236 batting average, while striking out 33 batters compared to just five walks. The Jumbo Shrimp have also gone 4-1 in Bencomo's starts, and he hasn't allowed more than two earned runs in any outing this season.

BARONS WIN: Bencomo earned his third win of the year on Monday April 24 against the Birmingham Barons at Regions Field. Bencomo worked seven and a third innings where he allowed a run on four hits with a walk and a season-high 10 strikeouts. Bencomo's first seven innings were scoreless until he gave up a solo homer to Mason Robbins in the bottom of the eighth. Jacksonville won the game 4-1.

WAHOOS START: Bencomo had a no decision in his start on Wednesday April 19 at Pensacola. He worked five innings where he allowed a two runs on eight hits with a walk and seven strikeouts. He left the game with Jacksonville trailing 2-1, and the Wahoos went onto win 7-5 thanks to a four-run bottom of the eighth inning.

VENEZUELAN WINTER LEAGUE: Following the 2016 season, Bencomo pitched in the Venezuelan Winter League for Bravos de Margarita from October to November. There he was 4-3 with a 4.21 ERA in his 14 starts, with 48 strikeouts in his 68 and a third innings of work.

2016 Highlights: Bencomo began the 2017 season in the Southern League with the Chattanooga Lookouts, the Double-A affiliate of the Minnesota Twins. Bencomo went 406 with a 3.86 ERA in 19 appearances and seven starts. That included time against Jacksonville last year, where he earned a save with two scoreless innings on June 7, and a win in a start on August 8 where he pitched five scoreless innings at the Baseball Grounds. Bencomo closed out 2016 with the Rochester Red Wings in the Triple-A International League. With the Red Wings he was 3-1 with a 3.49 ERA in five appearances and four starts.

2015 Highlights: Following time in the Tampa Bay Rays system from 2007-2011, Bencomo did not pitch professionally in the United States from 2012-14. In 2015 he pitched for the Wichita Wignuts and the Laredo Lemurs in the independent American Association. With Laredo he went 2-0 with a 1.93 ERA in four starts while with Wichita he was 4-1 with a 3.81 ERA in his nine starts for the Wignuts. He was later signed that season by the Minnesota Twins and closed out the year at High-A Fort Myers. With the Miracle, he was 1-1 with a 1.50 ERA in three starts in the Florida State League.

2011 Highlights: 2011 was Bencomo's last year in the Tampa Bay organization. With Single-A Bowling Green, he was 4-5 with a 3.97 ERA in 38 games in relief.

2010 Highlights: Bencomo spent the 2010 season with Hudson Valley in the New York-Penn League. With the Renegades he was 1-3 with a 4.60 ERA in 15 appearances and three starts.

2009 Highlights: Bencomo spent his first season in the United States with the Princeton Rays in the Appalachian League. With Princeton he was 2-1 with a 3.47 ERA in nine starts.

2008 Highlights: With the Venezuelan Summer League Rays he was 1-6 with a 4.45 ERA in 15 appearances and eight starts.

2007 Highlights: With the Venezuelan Summer League Devil Rays/Reds, Bencomo was 2-3 with a 2.89 ERA in 12 appearances and eight starts.
