Homestand Opener... The San Jose Giants begin a six-game homestand tonight with the first of three straight contests against the Lake Elsinore Storm (Padres affiliate). DJ Myers (3-3, 5.98 ERA) is slated to make the start on the mound for the Giants this evening. Following the weekend series versus the Storm, San Jose continues their homestand with a three-game set against Rancho Cucamonga.

The Giants... San Jose dropped two out of three games at Visalia in their most recent series. It marked the Giants' 20th consecutive winless series at Visalia's Recreation Park dating back to April 2013 (16 series losses, four series splits). San Jose is 4-12 in their last 16 games overall. Following last night's loss, the Giants (48-63) fell to a season-high tying 15 games below .500. San Jose has won only one series in the second half (3-1 vs. Visalia, July 13-16). The Giants have lost their last five series' overall.

One Month To Go... Exactly one month remains in the California League regular season (season finale: September 3). The Giants (14-27 second half record) are five games out of a playoff spot in the North Division with 29 to play.

Inside The Season Series... The Giants are only 2-7 against Lake Elsinore this season. San Jose won two of three games versus the Storm at Municipal Stadium from April 23-25. The Giants then lost all six of their games at The Diamond this year suffering a pair of series sweeps May 25-27 and July 21-23. This series marks the final meeting of the season between San Jose and Lake Elsinore. The Giants are batting only .200 as a team while averaging 2.7 runs per game against the Storm this year.

Brusa Bash... Gio Brusa hit his team-leading 17th home run of the season in Wednesday's victory over Visalia. 15 of his 17 homers have come on the road. Brusa has equaled his 2017 home run total with San Jose. He hit 17 homers in 113 games with the Giants last year and has clubbed 17 home runs in just 84 games this season. With 34 career homers, Brusa is just two home runs away from cracking the San Jose Giants career top five list (Travis Ishikawa and Angel Villalona are tied for fourth in club history with 36 HR each).

The Long Ball... San Jose leads all North Division clubs and ranks third in the California League with 93 home runs this season. The Giants have hit 42 home runs in 41 second half games. Conversely, San Jose has already allowed 51 home runs in the second half after giving up just 36 homers throughout the entire first half.

Month-By-Month... The Giants' month-by-month records: April 15-10, May 14-15, June 10-16, July 8-21, August 1-1. San Jose had the worst record in the league in both June and July. The Giants were last in the league in team batting average (.233) and team ERA (6.22) in July while owning a -78 run differential (197-118).

Stealing Bases... Johneshwy Fargas currently leads the California League with 35 stolen bases this season (in only 70 games played). Fargas is also tops in the San Francisco Giants minor league system in steals. Bryce Johnson's 24 stolen bases this year rank tied for fourth in the league. Johnson has been successful in his last 20 stolen base attempts (last caught stealing: May 4).

At Muni... The Giants are 25-29 at home this season, including a 7-12 mark in the second half. San Jose has won only one home series since the beginning of June (3-1 vs. Visalia, July 13-16). The Giants own a 3.90 team ERA at home this season compared to a 4.98 ERA on the road.

Late Innings... The Giants lead the league with seven victories this season when trailing after seven innings. However, San Jose has lost a league-high 12 games when leading after six innings and seven games when ahead after seven.

Has allowed only four home runs (1 HR last 53 IP) ... Owns a .302 opponents batting average (.328 AVG in second half).
- * Is 0-1 with a 12.60 ERA as a starter (3 GS) ... Has allowed 14 runs on 18 hits over 10 innings pitched ... Has compiled a 4.70 ERA as a reliever (15 G).
- * Most recent start came on July 18 at Rancho Cucamonga ... Surrendered five runs (all earned) in just 2/3 of an inning ... Matched the shortest start by a Giants pitcher this season.
- * Has pitched at least four innings in nine out of his 15 relief appearances this season.
- * Has fared considerably better against left-handed hitters (.242 AVG) compared to versus right-handed batters (.337 AVG) this season.
- * Won the California League Pitcher of the Week award May 7-13 ... Tossed 11 scoreless innings over two relief appearances during the week ... Allowed just two hits, walked one and struck out 14 (1-0 record) ... Struck out a career-high 10 batters over five shutout innings on May 8 at Modesto ... Pitched a season-high six innings with no runs and one hit allowed on May 13 versus Lancaster (four strikeouts).
- * Was placed on the disabled list (elbow) after leaving his May 18 outing in Stockton ... Was on the DL from May 19-June 15 ... Returned to the mound on June 16.
- * Has a 4.91 ERA and .252 opponents batting average at home compared to a 6.75 ERA and .335 average on the road.
- * Spent the entire 2017 season with Augusta working as both a starter and a reliever ... Was 3-8 with a 4.37 ERA in 22 games (12 starts) ... Pitched for the AZL Giants (Rookie) in 2016 ...
