BIG LEAGUE WEEKEND: The Portland Sea Dogs return home after a nine-game (1-8) road trip and host the Altoona Curve (Pirates affiliate) in a four-game series over the Memorial Day weekend...Portland has dropped four consecutive series, with their last series win on May 7-9 against New Hampshire at Hadlock Field...Red Sox infielders **Brock Holt** and **Dustin Pedroia** are scheduled to play in tonight's game... Lefty **Brian Johnson** is slated to start on Sunday.

3-2 AGAIN: Trenton beat Portland, 3-2 for the consecutive day, and took four of five from the 'Dogs...Portland grabbed a 1-0 lead in the first inning on a solo homer by **Cody Asche**...**Matt Lipka** tied the game with a lead-off homer against **Kyle Hart** in the third...The Sea Dogs took advantage of two errors in the sixth inning to grab a 2-1 lead, but Trenton responded with two runs in their half of the sixth...**Daniel Alvarez** stranded a runner in the ninth to earn his fifth save.

CODY CONNECTING: Asche's homer was his first in the Red Sox system, and finished the trip 5-for-20 (.250), HR, 2 RBI, and five walks...In just 14 games with Portland, Asche is tied for second on the club with 12 walks...**Bobby Dalbec** leads the team with 27.

SEVEN AGAIN: Hart worked seven innings on Thursday for the third consecutive start...The lefty gave up three runs, four hits, two walks, and fanned six...Yesterday was the sixth time a starter has pitched seven innings this season.

JOSH IS RAKING: INF **Josh Tobias** returned to Portland during the road trip and went 8-for-19 (.421), 2 RBI and three doubles...Tobias has batted fourth the last three games.

REHAB HISTORY: The Sea Dogs have had 54 players on an MLB Rehab Assignment...Holt rehabbed with Portland back in 2017...Pedroia is 4-for-16 (.250), RBI in 5 games with the 'Dogs this season.

AGAINST THE OPPONENT: Portland dropped four of seven to the Curve in 2018, and are 9-8-3 All-Time in season series...The 'Dogs travel to Altoona for a three-game series from June 11-13.
