SNAPPER SNIPPETS

STATE OF THE SNAPPERS: The Snappers have won 14 of their last 19 games & have not lost a series over their last 6 sets. Beloit has not lost back-to-back games since their July 17 & July 19 games coming off the road & opening their previous homestand. They have not lost consecutive games at home since July 7-9 against Kane County.

MARTIN ON THE MOVE: Mike Martin has put his speed on display during the current homestand. He has beat out 2 infield singles & out-ran the Burlington defense trying to turn a double play on Monday for a walk-off victory. He has also stolen 5 bases through the first 4 games of the Snappers stay at home. Martin's 19 total stolen bases this season lead the Athletics minor league system.

NOW WE'RE TALKING: Kyle Nowlin got on base with his 52nd walk of the season & sits 3rd in the Midwest League in that category. He has knocked in 17 RBIs over his last 18 games & finished July with a career-best slash line of .338/.446/.610 along with 5 homers & 6 doubles.

GETTING DEFENSIVE: Luke Persico leads the Midwest League with 14 outfield assist as the Snappers league the league as a team with 40. Beloit has turned 106 double plays to lead the Low-A level.

VARSITY VIDALES: Josh Vidales has raked a hit in his last 3 games while driving home at least one each of those games. His triple on Tuesday broke the Burlington shutout attempt & was his first extra-base hit as a Snapper since his first game with the club on July 12 in Lansing.

MR. MERCEDES: After Vidales broke the shutout on Tuesday, Miguel Mercedes swatted his 20th double of the season to bring him home. Mercedes leads the team with 33 extra-base hits & is 5 RBI shy of being the 3rd Snapper to reach 50 RBI this season.

SHELBY'S GOT THEIR NUMBER: JaVon Shelby leads all Beloit batters against the Chiefs with a .313 average, 3 homers, 10 RBI, & 8 walks.

CLOSE GAMES: The Snappers have played a total of 67 games decided by 3 runs or fewer & Beloit has a record of 33-34 in those contests. Additionally, Beloit's 37 one-run games are 2nd-most in the league.

HELPFUL TO GET A HANDFUL: The Snappers are 37-7 this season when they score at least 5 runs. Beloit is 12-7 in ballgames.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: The Snappers give the baseball to Zack Erwin for his 13th start of the year. The southpaw has not allowed a run in his last 2 starts at Pohlman Field spanning 10 innings to go with 12 strikeouts. Winning 3 of his last 4 starts, he turned in the 3rd-best ERA in the Midwest League during the month of July at 0.69. His 1.85 ERA & 59 strikeouts are 3rd in the league since he joined the Snappers at the end of May.

FACING THE CHIEFS: Beloit & Peoria have played 11 straight meetings at Dozer Park before finishing the season series at Pohlman Field. These 2 pitching staffs have exchanged 5 shutouts this season & 5 one-run games. Peoria has 2 of the Cardinals top-30 prospects in the outfield with Dylan Carlson (#18) & Nick Plummer (#29).

- Two-time Midwest League Pitcher of the Week in 2017; June 12-18 with 11.0 IP, 6 H, 1 ER, 11 K's over 2 starts vs. Quad Cities & July 10-16 with 2 scoreless starts reaching 11 IP, 6 H, & 15 K's
- First Snappers player since Tyler Marincov in 2014 to earn weekly league honors multiple times in the same season & first pitcher to win multiple Pitcher of the Week awards since Daniel Osterbrock was Midwest League Pitcher of the Week in back-to-back weeks in 2010
- Set new career-high in strikeouts with 8 over 6 scoreless innings vs. Kane County on July 10
- 15 straight scoreless innings over 3 consecutive starts from July 10-23; 0.69 ERA in July, 3rd-lowest in the Midwest League

2016:

- Made his Athletics organization debut with High-A Stockton on April 12 vs. Lancaster; made 18 outings for the Ports including 16 starts
- Reassigned to Beloit on July 20 & made 5 appearances with the Snappers before going on the DL on August 19
- Struck out a career-high 7 hitters at Pohlman Field on August 12 vs. Wisconsin over 5.0 IP to get his lone winning decision for Beloit

- Tossed 8.0 IP & struck out 11 to get the win vs. No. 3 Louisville on May 21, 2015 in the ACC Tournament; Tigers lost in NCAA regionals all 3 of his seasons
