CLOSING UP SHOP: The Portland Sea Dogs wrap-up their 25th season in the Eastern League, taking on the Binghamton Rumble Ponies (Mets affiliate) on Monday afternoon at NYSEG Stadium...With a win today, the 'Dogs would take three of four in the series...Lefty **Matt Kent** seeks his team-leading 12th win of the season...Kent was named the Sea Dogs Pitcher of the Year earlier last week...Individual Tickets for 2019 go on sale November 3.

YES, THAT TREY: Trey Ball made his first professional start as a hitter on Sunday night and snapped a 4-4 tie with an RBI double in the seventh, leading the Sea Dogs to a 7-4 win...**Teddy Stankiewicz** (8-13) snapped a four-game losing streak, earning the win with seven strong inning innings...**Algenis Martinez** pitched two scoreless to notch his first Double-A save...**Esteban Quiroz** hit a two-run homer in the first and **Chad De La Guerra** added a two-run single.

STARTERS IN A GROOVE: Since July 17th, Portland's starters have allowed 85 earned runs over their last 265.2 innings pitched (2.88 ERA)...Stankiewicz will finish as the league leader in innings pitched at 148.1.

CONGRATS TO ALL: The Sea Dogs named their team awards previous to Thursday night's game...Team MVP: **Josh Ockimey**, Pitcher of the Year: **Matt Kent**, 10th Player Award: **Jordan Weems**, Citizen of the Year: **Nick Lovullo**...The team awards were voted on by the fans.

LUKE HAS THE FORCE: Luke Tandler hit .333 (29-for-87), 5 HR and 17 RBI in 25 games in August...Since June 1st, Tandler is hitting .303 (69-for-228), 10 HR, 39 RBI, 11 2B, and 16 BB.

WELCOME TO 100: Bobby Dalbec's 32 homers are the fourth most in the minors and his 108 RBI are tied for second...In 125 games between two levels, Dalbec is hitting .256, 32 HR, 108 RBI, 35 2B, 3 3B, 66 BB and 173 SO.

AGAINST THE OPPONENT: Portland is 9-14-1 All-Time in season series against Binghamton, going 105-130 in 25 season series in New York...Portland has dropped five of seven at NYSEG Stadium this season.
