Last Game: The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (2-3, 30-43) defeated the Mississippi Braves (3-2, 32-43) by a 7-2 score in the fifth game of the six-game series at Trustmark Park on Monday night. Jacksonville right-handed starting pitcher Nick Neidert (7-4) earned the victory, pitching seven innings where he allowed two runs on six hits with one walk and three strikeouts, and he also contributed an RBI double at the plate. Mississippi right-handed starting pitcher Enderson Franco (2-5) took the loss, working five innings where he allowed six runs (three earned) on eight hits with no walks and a season-high 10 strikeouts. The first two innings featured a pair of runs for the Jumbo Shrimp, both coming with two outs. Peter O'Brien gave Jacksonville a 1-0 lead in the first with an RBI single. Then in the bottom of the second, Neidert helped his own cause with an RBI double that scored Rodrigo Vigil from second base to put the lead at 2-0 Jacksonville. Monte Harrison continued the scoring in the top of the third with a home run blast to left field to grow the lead to 3-0 and extend his season-long hitting streak to eight games. After the Shrimp were held off the scoreboard in the fourth, Jacksonville scored three runs in the fifth. After a Brian Miller triple, Isan Diaz hit a fly ball to right that was dropped by Mississippi right fielder Tyler Neslony, and the error scored Miller to make it 4-0. Eric Jagielo added an RBI double to make it 5-0, then with two outs a balk by Franco scored O'Brien from third to put Jacksonville's lead at 6-0. After Neidert's first four innings were scoreless, the Braves struck for a pair of runs in the bottom of the fifth when pinch-hitter Luis Valenzuela hit a two-out two-run double to cut Jacksonville's lead to 6-2. The Jumbo Shrimp got a run back in the top of the sixth, as Harrison had a two-out infield RBI single to grow the lead to 7-2, which would be the final. In the top of the eighth, Neidert at the plate was hit by a fastball directly on his batting helmet and had to leave the game. Jose Pena turned in a scoreless bottom of the eighth, and Kyle Keller delivered a scoreless top of the ninth to preserve the 7-2 win.

NEWS AND NOTES

Miller Shining at Double-A: Marlins No. 10 prospect and 2017 first rounder Brian Miller has enjoyed an easy transition to Double-A so far. He's hit safely in the first six games of the last series against Mississippi, and Tuesday had his second multi-hit game for Jacksonville. Miller was a 2018 Florida State League Midseason All-Star with Jupiter, where in 62 games hit .324 with 29 runs batted in along with 13 doubles, three triples, and 19 stolen bases. At time of promotion ranked first in the Florida State League in hits (83), third in FSL in average (.324), second in at-bats (256), third in stolen bases (19). Miller was selected by the Marlins just last year in the 2017 draft, picked in the first round.

Harrison Striking: Monte Harrison carries a season-long nine-game hitting streak into tonight's game. Over his last nine games he is 12-for-35 (.343) with a home run and four runs batted in with three walks and eight runs scored. Harrison has hit safely in each of the six games against Mississippi, and Tuesday extended his streak to nine games with an RBI triple in the first inning. Harrison is in his first year at the Double-A level, and was honored by the Southern League as a Midseason All-Star for his strong first half. Harrison is regarded by MLB.com as Miami's No. 1 prospect for the 2018 season.

Bring on the Biscuits: Yeah Bring on the Biscuits. This is the second of three series between the clubs, with Jacksonville winning three of five games in its only trip to Montgomery in early May. The Biscuits will return to the Baseball Grounds from July 23-27. Last season the Jumbo Shrimp struggled against the Biscuits, going 2-8 against Montgomery overall, going 1-4 in series both in Montgomery and in Duval.

Shrimp Have Prospects: On the roster, the Jumbo Shrimp have seven players who were listed by *MLB.com* as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (1), Isan Diaz (7), RHP Nick Neidert (8), OF Brian Miller (10), Merandy Gonzalez (13), Joe Dunand (16) and John Norwood (30).

TONIGHT'S JUMBO SHRIMP STARTING PITCHER

LAST START: Brigham had a no decision in his return from the disabled list on Saturday June 23 at Mississippi against the Braves. Brigham turned in six scoreless innings where he allowed three hits with a walk and nine strikeouts. He left with the game scoreless, only to see the Braves win late 4-3.

DISABLED LIST TIME: After his start on April 20 against Chattanooga, Brigham was placed on the disabled list with a right oblique strain. Brigham stayed on the disabled list until a minor league rehab start with the GCL Marlins on Monday June 18, where he pitched five scoreless innings with two hits no walks and five strikeouts. Brigham before his injury was 3-0 with a 0.60 ERA (one earned run in 15 innings) with 20 strikeouts.

SOUTHERN LEAGUE PITCHER OF THE WEEK: For his strong work in his starts against Jackson (April 7), and Mobile (April 13), Brigham was named the Southern League Pitcher of the Week for April 5-15, announced by the Southern League on April 16. In his first two starts, Brigham was 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA, striking out 18 batters compared to two walks in 10 scoreless innings.

HOW HE GOT HERE: Brigham has had a long journey to the Double- A level in the Marlins organization. He was originally selected in the fourth round (129th overall) by the Los Angeles Dodgers in 2014, and made it as high as High-A in the Dodgers system in 2015. Acquired by the Miami Marlins in a trade with the Los Angeles Dodgers on July 30, 2015 with RHP Victor Araujo and RHP Kevin Guzman in exchange for RHP Mat Latos, 1B Michael Morse, and cash. After finishing 2015 with High-A Jupiter, he spent all of the 2016 campaign with the Hammerheads, then injuries cut his 2017 season short, with only 11 starts for Jupiter.

#27 JEFF BRIGHAM RHP | 6-0, 200 lbs | Born: Feb. 16, 1992 in Federal Way, Wash. 26 Years Old.

Acquired by the Miami Marlins in a trade with the Los Angeles Dodgers on July 30, 2015 with RHP Victor Araujo and RHP Kevin Guzman in exchange for RHP Mat Latos, 1B Michael Morse, and cash.

2017 Highlights: After missing time from April to early June of last year on the disabled list with a right shoulder impingement, Brigham made 11 starts for High-A Jupiter, going 4-2 with a 2.90 ERA, striking out 53 batters in 59 innings of work. On June 18, 2017 he was named the Florida State League Pitcher of the Week after a start on June 12 where he worked six scoreless innings against the St. Lucie Mets, allowing only one hit, walking two and striking out four. His year came to an early end on July 27 when he was placed on the disabled list with a right oblique strain and missed the rest of the season.

2016 Highlights: Brigham spent his first full season in the Marlins organization pitching for High-A Jupiter in the Florida State League. With the Hammerheads he was 7-8 with a 4.04 ERA in 27 games and 23 starts, striking out 112 batters in 122 and two-thirds innings of work. As a starter he was 7-8 with a 3.94 ERA in 23 starts, compared to no record with a 4.85 ERA in four relief outings with one save.

2015 Highlights: Brigham started the 2015 campaign with Single-A Great Lakes Loons in the Midwest League, where he was 2-0 with a 1.29 ERA in two relief outings in mid-April. Joined High-A Rancho Cucamonga on April 23, and was 4-5 with a 5.96 ERA in 17 appearances and 14 starts, striking out 64 batters in 68 innings of work. He was acquired by the Miami Marlins in a trade with the Los Angeles Dodgers on July 30, 2015 with RHP Victor Araujo and RHP Kevin Guzman in exchange for RHP Mat Latos, 1B Michael Morse, and cash. He finished the season with High-A Jupiter, going 2-2 with a 1.87 ERA in six outings and five starts.

2014 Highlights: With rookie level Ogden, Brigham was 0-3 with a 3.58 ERA in 11 outings and 10 starts, striking out 33 batters in 32 and a third innings of work.

College: Attended the University of Washington just like both of his parents. Selected in the fourth round (129th overall) by the Los Angeles Dodgers. In 2014 was honorable mention All-Pac-12 and First Team All-Academic ... tied for the team high with 16 starts ... was 7-4 with 2.90 ERA, giving up 79 hits, 33 runs (29 earned) in 90.0 innings pitched ... gave up 1 run or less in each of his first 6 starts, 9 of 16 total ... eight quality starts. In 2013 granted a medical redshirt after undergoing arm surgery. 2012: Appeared in 11 games, starting seven, during his sophomore season ... earned Academic All-Pac-12 honorable mention ... was limited by injury early in the year, but ended up as a regular in the starting rotation down the stretch as all seven starts came in Pac-12 play. 2011: Appeared in 23 games (tied for second-most on the team) and started five as a true freshman. Also played for the Bend (Ore.) Elks during the summer ... earned second-team All-West Coast League honors for the Elks ... over 22 innings, posted a 0.82 ERA with six saves, a 2-1 record and 17 strikeouts.

Personal: Earned two varsity letters under coach Mike Church ... captain as a senior ... Jefferson High School athlete of the year as a senior ... also the Federal Way Mirror's athlete of the year for 2009-10 ... hit .447 with 18 RBI and 24 runs while posting a 0.76 ERA as a senior ... second-team All-South Puget Sound League (North) as both a pitcher and second baseman as a senior ... first-team All-SPSL 4A North as a junior ... pitched a no-hitter in a win over Kentwood as a junior ... also an honorable mention all-league basketball player as a senior ... once made eight three-pointers in a game, scoring 30 points in a win over Beamer ... also played golf and ran cross country in high school ... second-team All-SPSL North in golf in 2010 and offensive team MVP in basketball in 2010 ... graduated from Jefferson with a 3.98 grade point average.
