**Giants Conclude Series Against Modesto...** The San Jose Giants look for a series victory against the Modesto Nuts when the teams conclude their four-game set this afternoon at Municipal Stadium. Following a 13-6 Nuts victory in the series opener on Thursday, the Giants have staged dramatic ninth-inning rallies the last two nights to secure back-to-back wins. On Friday, San Jose scored five runs in the bottom of the ninth for a 9-8 win. Yesterday, the Giants scored twice in the ninth in a come-from-behind 6-5 victory.

**Walk-Offs...** San Jose's last four home victories have come in walk-off fashion: April 14 vs. Stockton (Jalen Miller 11th inning home run), April 15 vs. Stockton (Gio Brusa 10th inning home run), April 20 vs. Modesto (Bryce Johnson ninth inning hit by pitch) and last night (Jacob Heyward ninth inning double). The Giants trailed entering the bottom of the ninth inning in all four games.

**Inside The Series...** Over the first three games of the current series against Modesto, the Giants are batting .350 as a team with 21 runs scored (42 hits). Defensively, San Jose has committed eight errors in the series leading to 14 unearned runs.

**League Leaderboard...** Gio Brusa enters today's contest leading the California League in extra-base hits (11) while he's second in RBI's (14). Jalen Miller is tied for fifth in hits (21). Brusa, Miller and Frandy De La Rosa are also tied for sixth with three home runs each.

**Team Stats...** San Jose is third in the eight-team California League in batting average (.267), third in runs scored (5.2 per game) and tied for third in home runs (15). On the mound, the Giants' 3.14 team ERA is also third in the league.

**Tied For First...** The Giants (10-7) are in a three-way tie for first place with Stockton and Visalia in the first half North Division standings. San Jose has not held sole possession of the top spot in the division this year.

**w/RISP...** The Giants are batting .225 this season with runners in scoring position – seventh in the league. San Jose owns a league-worst .160 batting average as a team with runners in scoring position and two outs.

**On Deck...** The Giants continue their homestand tomorrow with a three-game series against the Lake Elsinore Storm. It will mark the first meeting of the season between the Giants and Storm (Padres affiliate).

**Cycle x2...** April 11 was an historic night for the San Jose Giants as both Gio Brusa and Jalen Miller hit for the cycle in an 18-6 victory at Lancaster. Brusa (4-for-6, 2B, 3B, HR, 6 RBI) completed his cycle with a triple in the top of the eighth. Miller (5-for-7, 2B, 3B, HR, 4 RBI, SB), who tied a Giants single-game team record with five hits, tripled in the ninth inning for San Jose's second cycle of the night. The duo became the fourth and fifth players in the 31-year history of the San Jose Giants to hit for the cycle. Prior to Brusa and Miller, the last SJ Giant to hit for the cycle was Thomas Neal on April 28, 2009 at Lancaster.

**San Francisco Affiliation...** This year marks San Jose's 31st season as an affiliate of the San Francisco Giants – the longest current partnership in the California League. Since their inception in 1988, the San Jose Giants have won six league championships (1998, 2001, 2005, 2007, 2009, 2010), 11 North Division titles and qualified for the playoffs 22 times (in 30 seasons).

\* Is in his third professional season ... Selected by the San Francisco Giants in the 14th round of the 2016 draft.

\* Today marks his third start of the season with the Giants ... Has pitched 10 scoreless innings over two starts for San Jose ... Has allowed only four hits, walked three and struck out 15 ... Owns a .125 opponents batting average.

\* Most recent start came on April 17 at Visalia ... Tossed five shutout innings with one hit allowed ... Only hit surrendered was a leadoff single in the bottom of the first (Camden Duzenack) ... Walked three and struck out eight ... Left the game with a 1-0 lead, but received a no-decision after Visalia rallied for a 4-1 win.

\* Picked-up the win in his 2018 debut on April 7 at Inland Empire ... Fired five scoreless innings with three hits allowed, no walks and seven strikeouts.

\* Made a spot-start for Sacramento (AAA) on April 12 against Reno ... Pitched four innings and allowed four runs (all earned) ... Surrendered five hits, walked four and struck out one during his 86-pitch outing ... Gave up three runs in the first inning and one run in the fourth ... Suffered the loss.

\* Spent the entire 2017 season in the San Jose starting rotation ... Was 7-7 with a 4.41 ERA in 23 games (22 starts) ... Was named to the midseason California League All-Star team.

\* Led last year's Giants staff in wins, starts, innings pitched (114 1/3) and was second in strikeouts (99) ... Won San Jose's Pitcher of the Year award.

\* Allowed two earned runs or fewer in 12 out of his 22 starts last season ... Month-by-month ERA's: April (2.78), May (3.62), June (3.99), July (7.56) and August (8.03) ... Had 10 starts of at least six innings, but pitched past the fifth inning only once in his last eight starts.

\* Struck out a career-high 10 batters over six innings on April 27, 2017 at Rancho Cucamonga.

\* Also pitched for San Jose in 2016 ... Was 2-0 with a 4.94 ERA in six games (five starts) ... Was the first player from the 2016 San Francisco Giants draft class to reach the Class-A Advanced level.

\* Attended The Master's University (NAIA school in Santa Clarita, CA).

\* Had a 2.47 ERA in 102 innings during his final season at The Master's in 2016 ... Pitched in the 2016 NAIA World Series in Lewiston, Idaho.

\* Was rated the top prospect in the Alaska Baseball League (collegiate summer league) in 2015.

\* Attended San Benito High School in Hollister, CA (one hour south of San Jose) ... Pitched at Municipal Stadium while in high school during the Central Coast Section playoffs.

\* Grandfather, Bill Plummer, played 10 years in the major leagues with the Cincinnati Reds, Chicago Cubs and Seattle Mariners ... Was a catcher with Cincinnati from 1970-77 ... Plummer previously managed the California League's San Jose Missions in 1980 and is currently the minor league catching coordinator for the Arizona Diamondbacks.

### #26 Gio Brusa (.273, 3 HR, 14 RBI, 0 SB)

Current Hit Streak: 4 games

- \* First baseman is in his third professional season ... Selected in the 6th round of the 2016 draft.
- \* Hit for the cycle on April 11 at Lancaster joining teammate Jalen Miller in accomplishing the feat that night.
- \* Spent the 2017 season with San Jose ... Hit .237 with 17 home runs and 55 RBI's in 113 games.
- \* Tied for the team lead in home runs last year ... Was also second on the club in doubles and fifth in RBI's.
- \* Was an outfielder in his first two seasons before transitioning to first base this year.
- \* Earned Northwest League All-Star honors with Salem-Keizer (Short-Season) in 2016.
- \* Led the Northwest League with 10 home runs in '16 ... Hit .264 with 42 RBI's in 53 games ... Won All-Star home run derby.
- \* Attended the University of the Pacific ... Finished career second in school history in doubles, fourth in HR and fifth in RBI's.

### #43 Frandy De La Rosa (.214, 3 HR, 8 RBI, 0 SB)

Current Hit Streak: 2 games

- \* Infielder is in his sixth professional season and second year in the San Francisco organization.
- \* Previously played in the Cubs (2013-15) and Rangers (2016-17) organizations ... Has been traded twice.
- \* Was traded from the Rangers to the Giants in exchange for minor league pitcher Clayton Blackburn on 4/16/17.
- \* Spent the majority of the 2017 season with Augusta (A) ... Hit .231 with five home runs and 19 RBI's in 56 games.
- \* Has seen action at all four infield positions throughout his career ... Originally signed by the Cubs in 2012.

### #54 Sandro Fabian (.250, 1 HR, 4 RBI, 0 SB)

Current Hit Streak: 4 games

- \* Outfielder is in his fourth professional season ... Signed as an international free agent in 2014.
- \* Currently ranked the #6 prospect in the San Francisco organization by *MLB.com*. Rated the #9 prospect by *Baseball America*.
- \* Is the youngest player on San Jose's roster (20).
- \* Spent the 2017 season with Augusta (A) ... Batted .277 with 11 home runs and 61 RBI's in 122 games.
- \* Led the GreenJackets in hits (133), doubles (30) and RBI's ... Was also second on the club in home runs.
- \* Ranked third in the South Atlantic League with 15 outfield assists last year.
- \* Hit .340 for the AZL Giants (Rookie) in 2016 (42 games).

### #49 Johneshwy Fargas (.278, 0 HR, 1 RBI, 2 SB)

Current Hit Streak: 3 games

- \* Outfielder is in his sixth professional season ... Selected in the 11th round of the 2013 draft.
- \* Played for both San Jose and Augusta (A) in 2017 ... Hit .194 with two home runs and 11 RBI's in 31 games with S.J.
- \* Finished last season with Augusta ... Batted .205 with one home run, 10 RBI's and 10 stolen bases in 37 games.
- \* Has led the SF Giants minor league system in stolen bases twice (59 SB in 2015, 41 SB in 2016).

- \* Was a South Atlantic League All-Star in 2015 while playing for Augusta (.278 AVG, 2 HR, 35 RBI, 59 SB).

### #12 Wander Franco (.250, 0 HR, 8 RBI, 1 SB)

Current Hit Streak: 6 games

- \* Infielder is in his seventh professional season and first year in the San Francisco organization.
- \* Spent the first six years of his pro career (2012-17) in the Kansas City Royals farm system.
- \* Was acquired by the SF Giants in the minor league phase of the Rule 5 draft last December.
- \* Spent the last two seasons playing for the Wilmington Blue Rocks (High-A) of the Carolina League.
