DRILLERS DROP CHAMPIONSHIP OPENER – The Drillers found themselves in a 6-3 deficit late in Game 1 of the TLCS in downtown Amarillo. In the top of the eighth, Connor Wong delivered a clutch three-run homer to even things up. But the euphoria for the Drillers did not last long. Five hits, two walks and a costly error led to seven Amarillo runs in the home half of the eighth, and it was enough for the Sod Poodles to claim a 13-6 victory.

After hitting just one home run in the Division Series, the Drillers pounded four long balls in the series opener. In addition to Wong, Cody Thomas, Omar Estevez and Donovan Casey each went deep at HODGETOWN to account for four of the Drillers seven hits on Tuesday night.

The Drillers pitching surrendered 17 hits on the night, matching the most that Tulsa pitching has given up in a game this season. Two costly Tulsa errors led to six unearned runs in the game.

Tulsa Starting Pitcher #22 LHP Leo Crawford (1-0, 1.46 ERA)

- The 22-year-old was signed by the Los Angeles Dodgers as a non-drafted free agent in 2014 out of Nicaragua
- Picked up the win in Game 1 of the division series against Arkansas on September 5 (6.1 IP, 1 ER, 4 H, 7 K, 0 BB)
- Was 13-4 with a 2.87 ERA in 32 games (27 starts) with Single-A Rancho Cucamonga from 2018-19
- Struck out a career-high 11 batters in his Double-A debut at ONEOK Field on August 6
- Crawford is 1-0 with a 4.50 ERA in 2 games (1 start) this season against Amarillo (8 IP, 14 H, 4 ER, 2 K, 3 BB)

ONEOK THREE-PEAT – Sunday (9/8) marked the third straight season that Tulsa won Game 5 of the North Division Playoff Series at ONEOK Field. In 2017, the Drillers beat Northwest Arkansas, and in 2018-19 defeated the Arkansas Travelers.

WINNING WHEN IT MATTERS – The Drillers have now won three straight postseason series. In the last three years, they have won a total of 14 playoff games and 4 of 5 series. Prior to this run, in the 17-season period from 2000-2016, the Drillers won a total of only two playoff series.

CHAMPIONSHIP EXPERIENCE – Pitchers Michael Boyle, Nolan Long, Shea Spitzbarth and infielder Eric Peterson are the only four remaining Drillers on the active roster who were members of last season’s championship winning team.

NEXT LEVEL – The Drillers have 13 players who were on Rancho Cucamonga’s active roster last season when the Quakes won the California League Championship (Casey, Crawford, Curry, Estevez, Moseley, Rincon, Salow, Santana, Sheffield, Thomas, Uceta, Walker, Wong).

LOTS OF WINNING – The Drillers 78 regular season wins were tied for the most in franchise history (78 wins in 1998).

SIX AND COUNTING? – Connor Wong and Donovan Casey are the only two Tulsa players to hit safely in all six playoff games. Wong is 8-22 (.367) with 2 HR and 7 RBI, while Casey is 8-22 (.367) with 1 HR and 2 RBI so far in the postseason. Dating back to the regular season, Wong is riding a 9-game hitting streak (15-33, 4 HR, 6 RBI) while Casey has hit in 8 straight games (10-31, 2 HR, 5 RBI).

SPITZ CAUSING FITS – Shea Spitzbarth tossed two scoreless relief innings to finish Game 3 on Friday. Since returning from Triple-A OKC on August 6, Spitzbarth has allowed only 1 earned run over 17 innings pitched (0.53 ERA).

TOUGH TO HIT – Since returning to Tulsa on 8/29 from Triple-A Oklahoma City, Luis Vasquez has yet to allow an earned run in three appearances (two in postseason). Vasquez has struck out 13 over his last 8.2 innings, and picked up two saves in the division series against Arkansas.

GAME 1 LOSER TO SERIES WINNER – Of the four playoff series’ that Scott Hennessey’s Drillers have won over the last three seasons, Tulsa has been the Game 1 loser in three of them. The Drillers lost Game 1 of the TL North Division Series in 2017, ’18, ’19 and won all three series.
