Last Game: The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (35-28, 65-68) fell to the Biloxi Shuckers (31-30, 67-63) by a 7-1 score in the third game of the five-game series at MGM Park on Monday night. Biloxi right-handed starter Freddy Peralta (2-4) earned the victory after working six scoreless innings where he allowed just two hits and struck out a career high 12 batters. Jacksonville right-handed starter Trevor Richards (5-6) took the loss, allowing five runs (two earned) on six hits with a walk and four strikeouts. Biloxi reliever Jorge Lopez worked the final three innings to pick up his sixth save of the year. Biloxi's scoring started with two outs in the bottom of the second. A ball hit by pitcher Peralta went past Jacksonville first baseman Taylor Ard who committed an error on the play to bring in Biloxi's first run, and then Johnny Davis and Troy Stokes, Jr. followed with RBI singles to give the Shuckers a 3-0 lead in the bottom of the second. The Shuckers then scored four runs in the bottom of the sixth. A three-run homer by Jacob Nottingham capped the rally, as Biloxi took a 7-0 lead into the top of the seventh. Jacksonville scored its lone run in the top of the seventh when David Vidal, who doubled to start the inning, scored from third on a groundout by Rodrigo Vigil to put the score at 7-1, which would be the final. The start of the game was delayed by an hour and nine minutes due to rain, and the clubs played through a steady rain during the final three innings. The Jumbo Shrimp maintain first place in the second half South Division standings, in front of both the Shuckers and Mobile BayBears by three games with seven left to play in the 2017 season.

NEWS AND NOTES

Magic Number: 5: The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp are getting closer and closer to tasting champagne. Coming into Wednesday August 30, the magic number for Jacksonville to clinch the second half South Division title is at five against the Biloxi Shuckers and four against the Mobile BayBears. That means that a combination of any Jumbo Shrimp wins and BayBears/Shuckers losses will shrink the magic number down to zero, and at that point the Jumbo Shrimp will have clinched the division title. Currently Jacksonville leads both Mobile and Biloxi by three games with only seven left to play in the second half. Jacksonville hasn't appeared in the Southern League playoffs since 2014 when the club won the second half crown and then league title.

Lee Watch: 316: Braxton Lee continues to lead the Southern League in hitting with his .316 batting average. Lee is also the Southern League hit king with 144 this season, second in runs scored with 78, is fourth in the league with a .400 on-base percentage, and is fourth in the league with 20 stolen bases. Lee was honored as a Southern League Midseason All-Star for his work with the Montgomery Biscuits in the first half of the season, and he joined the Jumbo Shrimp on June 27 after being traded from the Tampa Bay Rays to the Marlins in exchange for Adeiny Hechavarria. Lee was named a 2017 Southern League Postseason All-Star on Tuesday, as well as a participant in the 2017 Arizona Fall League.

Norwood SL Player of the Week: Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp right fielder John Norwood has been named the Southern League Player of the Week for August 21-27, announced by the league office Monday morning. Norwood hit safely in seven of the eight games over the week for the Jumbo Shrimp, hitting .462 (12-for-26) with a home run, six runs batted in, 10 runs scored, with five walks and a .548 on-base percentage. His slugging percentage for the week was .654, and his on-base plus slugging percentage was 1.202. His leadership was key to Jacksonville going 7-1 during the eight games played during the week, as the Jumbo Shrimp built a three game lead in the second half South Division standings, and Jacksonville's magic number to clinch a division title is now at five.

TONIGHT – JUMBO SHRIMP DEBUT: Tonight James Needy makes his Jumbo Shrimp debut. Needy was just transferred from High-A Jupiter to Jacksonville today. With the Hammerheads, Needy was 3-2 with a 1.98 ERA in seven starts. Needy signed a minor league free agent contract with the Miami Marlins on June 1 after beginning the season with the Sioux City Explorers in the independent Frontier League, where he was 1-0 with a 2.93 ERA in three starts.

WITH JUPITER: With the Hammerheads, Needy was 3-2 with a 1.98 ERA in seven starts. Needy made four starts with Jupiter before he was placed on the disabled list on July 10, retroactive to July 8, with a right sprained finger. In his three August starts, Needy was 1-0 with a 2.13 ERA.

LAST HAMMERHEADS START: Needy earned the win in his last start for the Hammerheads on Thursday August 24 against the Palm Beach Cardinals at Roger Dean Stadium. Needy worked five scoreless innings where he only allowed a hit with a walk and six strikeouts as Jupiter won 11-0.

WITH SIOUX FALLS: Needy started the season in independent baseball with the Sioux Falls Explorers in the Frontier League. Needy had good results, going 1-0 with a 2.93 ERA in three starts before he was signed by the Marlins to a minor league free agent contract on June 1. Over 15.1 innings, Needy struck out 20 and walked five. The Santee, Calif., native made his Sioux City debut on opening night, May 18, facing the rival Sioux Falls Canaries and picking up the win. Over 5.1 innings, he allowed one run on just five hits and two walks, while striking out an impressive nine hitters. Sioux City won the game 2-1. He returned to the hill on May 24 to face the Lincoln Saltdogs. Over five innings, Needy allowed just two runs while striking out seven and not walking a batter in a 3-2 Explorers win. His final start came on May 29 at Fargo-Moorhead, when he struck out four over five innings as Sioux City won 5-3.

PADRES ORGANIZATION TIME: Prior to pitching for Sioux City, Needy spent six seasons pitching for his hometown San Diego Padres system, reaching as high as Class AAA from 2009-2015.

Signed by the Marlins as a minor league free agent on June 1, 2017.

2017 Highlights: Needy was just transferred from High-A Jupiter to Jacksonville on August 29. With the Hammerheads, Needy was 3-2 with a 1.98 ERA in seven starts. Needy signed a minor league free agent contract with the Miami Marlins on June 1 after beginning the season with the Sioux City Explorers in the independent Frontier League, where he was 1-0 with a 2.93 ERA in three starts.

2016 Highlights: Missed all of the season due to Tommy John surgery.

2015 Highlights: Needy's final season in the Padres system was in 2015, when he made 24 starts across San Antonio and the Class AAA El Paso Chihuahuas and compiled an 11-6 record.

2014 Highlights: Needy advanced a level for 2014, pitching for San Antonio and making 24 starts. He would earn an identical 10-5 record but lower his ERA to 2.91. Additionally, Needy established a career high in strikeouts with 113 in 145.1 innings

2013 Highlights: 2013 brought a return to a starting role for Needy, as all 27 of his appearances for the Class A Advanced Lake Elsinore (Calif.) Storm came as a starter. He finished the season 10-5 with a 3.76 ERA, and struck out 98 in 134 innings.

2012 Highlights: 2012 saw Needy enjoy a dominant season as a reliever. Making 37 appearances between the Class A Fort Wayne (Ind.) TinCaps, Class AA San Antonio Missions and Class AAA Tucson Padres, Needy compiled a 6-3 record and 1.79 ERA. He struck out 74 hitters in 95.2 innings.

2011 Highlights: Needy returned in 2011 to split the year between the AZL Padres and the Short Season Class A Eugene (Ore.) Emeralds, making 13 starts in 14 appearances. Also battled a back injury.

He was designated for assignment by the Dodgers on April 25, and the Marlins claimed him off waivers two days later on April 27.

2016 Highlights: Started the season with Double-A Bowie, making four starts for the Baysox. Promoted to Triple-A Norfolk on 5/1...Led the Tides in starts (24), innings pitched (141.1), and strikeouts (94), and finished second on the team in wins (eight). Earned his first win with Norfolk on 5/22 at Syracuse after throwing 7.0 shutout innings with two walks and three strikeouts.
