TODAY'S GAME: Your Rancho Cucamonga Quakes take on the Lancaster JetHawks (Colorado Rockies affiliate) of the South Division today in the final game of the first half. Before today's game, special needs kids were invited to participate in a FREE clinic with Quakes' players and coaches, all thanks to U.S. Bank! (Free with purchase of a ticket to the game). In addition, it's a Kids-Eat-Free Sunrun Sunday, where kids 12 and under will get a voucher for a free hot dog, soda and bag of chips! The Quakes enter this series after taking two-of-three from the Inland Empire 66ers. With this being the final game of the first half, the All-Star break starts tomorrow. The players who were not invited to the game will have three days off before the first series of the second half starts on Thursday, June 22nd, in Lancaster.

VS LANCASTER: After a Quakes' loss last night, the JetHawks now lead the season series 7-3. The Quakes have lost five out of seven games this season at The Hangar in Lancaster. This is the 11th meeting of 29 in the season series.

OFFENSE CANNOT TAKE ADVANTAGE OF OPPORTUNITIES IN ELIMINATING LOSS: Rancho was eliminated from post-season contention last night and watched Lancaster celebrate the first half South Division crown on their home field following the Quakes' 12-2 loss. Devin Smeltzer (1-1) was handed the loss after he just lasted three and a third innings, giving up seven runs (five earned) on seven hits while striking out three and not walking a batter. On the offensive side, Victor Roache, DJ Peters, Ibandel Isabel and Errol Robinson all had multi-hit games, but the Quakes stranded 10 runners and just went 2-for-10 with runners in scoring position.

QUAKES UNABLE TO CLINCH FIRST HALF IN THE SOUTH: With the loss last night, the Quakes were eliminated from first half contention with just one game left in the half. In order to make the post-season in the second half, the Quakes either need to win the division, or finish second to Lancaster, but have the best overall record in the south. Lake Elsinore is one game back of the Quakes now and they will play Stockton tonight.

RECENT ROSTER MOVES: On Friday, LHP Chris Cotton (signed as FA after being released by Houston; DNP this season) and RHP Andrew Thurman (signed as FA after being released by Atlanta; DNP this season) were added to the Quakes' roster. RHP Adam Bray and RHP Ivan Vitez were both placed on the Temporarily Inactive List.

WHAT A TABLE-SETTER: In his first eight games with the Quakes, Errol Robinson has been the lead-off hitter in the order. In those seven games, he is 11-for-20 (.550 average) when leading off an inning. He is 3-for-16 (.188 average) when he is not leading off an inning. Overall, Robinson is batting .389 with four doubles, five runs and four stolen bases.

QUAKES WILL SEND SIX PLAYERS TO VISALIA FOR ALL-STAR GAME: Luke Raley (outfield: .281, eight home runs) and Will Smith (catcher: .234, seven home runs) will represent the Quakes as starters in the All-Star Game in Visalia on Tuesday, June 20th and four other players will join them in reserve. Dennis Santana (RHP: 4-4, 2.70 ERA), Caleb Ferguson (LHP: 1-4, 3.31 ERA), DJ Peters (outfielder: .262, 11 home runs) and Ibandel Isabel (first baseman: .243, 15 home runs) were all selected to play for the South Division. Tickets are available at rawhidebaseball.com for the All-Star Game, which is scheduled to begin at 5:00 PM.

FERGUSON TO TAKE THE HILL FOR THE QUAKES: Caleb Ferguson will make the start in game four for the Quakes. In his last start, Ferguson threw four and two-thirds innings against Inland Empire on June 13th, giving up two runs on five hits while striking out three and walking five in a no-decision. Ferguson, who was Rancho's opening day starter, is making his 12th start on the year. Ferguson, a 38th-round draft pick of the Dodgers in 2014 out of high school in West Jefferson, OH, spent most of last season with Great Lakes. He made 10 out of his 12 starts in 2016 there, going 1-4 with a 2.68 ERA in 50 and a third innings for the Loons. He showed off his precise command in Great Lakes by just walking three batters those 50-plus innings compared to 41 strikeouts. Ferguson was brilliant for the Loons in the postseason on their way to a Midwest League Championship. Between two starts, one in the semi-finals and one in the championship series, he threw nine and two-thirds innings, just giving up one run on seven hits. He continued his excellent control with 11 strikeouts to just one walk.

OPPOSING PITCHER: Helmis Rodriguez, the native of Colon, Venezuela, will start today's series finale. Rodriguez spent all of last season in Modesto and ended the year with a 5-9 record and a respectable 3.36 ERA, but remained in the Cal League for this season. He has pitched out of the bullpen this year and will make his first start of the season today. His last outing tied a season-high with four shutout innings out of the bullpen against Lake Elsinore on June 14th. He struck out three and walked three while picking up the win.
