**Last Game:** Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp right-hander Joe Gunkel pitched seven innings, right fielder John Norwood hit a go-ahead home run, and new Shrimp outfielders Braxton Lee and Kyle Barrett combined for five hits in a 4-2 win over the Mobile BayBears in front of 2,906 at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville Wednesday night. In their Jumbo Shrimp debuts, Lee – a former Montgomery Biscuit acquired in the Miami Marlins' trade with the Tampa Bay Rays – and Barrett – promoted from Class-A Advanced Jupiter on Monday – started in the first two spots, respectively, in the batting order. Against BayBears right-hander Jake Jewell (4-5), Lee led off the game with an infield single along the third-base line, and Barrett bunted along the first-base line before beating Jewell's throw to first base for a single. A double play and strikeout ended the inning but kept Jacksonville (3-3 second half, 33-43 overall) quiet temporarily. Gunkel (2-4) kept Mobile (3-3, 33-42) scoreless until a third-inning, leadoff home run by first baseman Jared Walsh. Designated hitter Jordan Serena double to left-center field, went to third base on center fielder Bo Way's sacrifice and scored on a wild pitch. Gunkel proceeded to retire 15 of 16 batters to complete his outing, allowing two earned runs on four hits with no walks and two strikeouts while throwing 74 pitches, 52 for strikes. In a 2-0 deficit, Barrett ignited Jacksonville's sixth-inning rally. He singled to right field with one out, Jewell's balk put him at second base, and third baseman Brian Anderson's RBI single scored him. Norwood followed promptly with his 11th home run to the right-field bleachers for a 3-2 lead. Jewell allowed three earned runs on seven hits and one walk with four strikeouts in 5 2/3 innings. Lee added a seventh-inning RBI single to finish 2-for-4. Barrett followed with his second bunt single to finish 3-for-4 in his Double-A debut. Right-hander Esmerling De La Rosa pitched a scoreless eighth inning. Left-hander Daniel Schlereth got the first ninth-inning out, before right-hander Severino Gonzalez got two outs for his first save.

## NEWS AND NOTES

**Anderson, Guerrero to Futures Game:** Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp third baseman Brian Anderson and right-handed relief pitcher Tayron Guerrero have been selected to play in the 2017 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game on Sunday July 9 at 4 p.m. at Marlins Park in Miami, Florida. Anderson will be a member of the U.S. Team, while Guerrero, a native of Bocachica, Colombia, will be a member of the World Team, and the two are the only representatives for the Marlins at the game in their home ballpark. Anderson is hitting .259 with 11 home runs and 42 RBI in 75 games played for Jacksonville this season. Anderson leads the Southern League in games played (75), fourth in the league with 42 RBI, second in the league in runs scored (47), and his 11 home runs are tied with John Norwood for the Jacksonville club lead. Guerrero is 0-1 with a 4.76 ERA in 13 relief outings with the Jumbo Shrimp this season, and has a 3.86 ERA with 11 strikeouts in his seven June outings. Guerrero, 26, pitched on the world stage this spring while pitching for Colombia in the 2017 World Baseball Classic, and is a member of the Marlins 40-man roster.

**Rave Review of Debuts!** Braxton Lee and Kyle Barrett were quite welcome at the Baseball Grounds in their first game with the Jumbo Shrimp Wednesday. Both at the top of the order, they helped spark the Jacksonville offense. Barrett was 3-for-4 with two of his hits bunt singles, and Lee was 2-for-4 with an RBI. Lee previously played in the Southern League with the Biscuits, and was acquired by the Marlins in a trade from the Rays Monday.

**TONIGHT – DOUBLE-A DEBUT:** Richards won his Double-A and Southern League Debut on Friday June 23 at Jackson over the Generals. He worked five-and a third innings where he allowed three runs on seven hits with three walks and three strikeouts. Richards was also 1-for-2 at the plate, getting a single in his first professional at-bat. Jacksonville won 9-4 over the Generals.

**2017 FLORIDA STATE LEAGUE ALL-STAR:** Richards spent the first half of the season pitching for High-A Jupiter, where he was 7-4 with a 2.17 ERA in 13 appearances 11 starts. Richards was named a 2017 Florida State League Midseason All-Star, representing the South Division team on June 17 in Lakeland. Richards did not pitch in the game for the South Division, as the North Division won 5-2.

**FSL RANKINGS:** At the time of his promotion on June 21, Richards ranks fourth in the Florida State League with a 2.17 ERA Richards also is tied for second in the league with his seven wins, tied for second in strikeouts with 81, leads the league in WHIP at 0.93, and has the third-lowest batting average against at .204. He also has the fourth-highest strikeout per nine inning ratio at 10.11, and the third-lowest walk per nine inning ratio at 1.51.

**#1 TREVOR RICHARDS RHP | 6-2, 190 lbs | Born: Aviston, Ill. May 15, 1993. Age: 24**

Signed by the Marlins as a minor league free agent on July 7, 2016.

**2017 Highlights:** Richards spent the first half of the season pitching for High-A Jupiter, where he was 7-4 with a 2.17 ERA in 13 appearances 11 starts. Richards was named a 2017 Florida State League Midseason All-Star, representing the South Division team on June 17 in Lakeland. Richards did not pitch in the game for the South Division, as the North Division won 5-2. At the time of his promotion on June 21, Richards ranks fourth in the Florida State League with a 2.17 ERA Richards also is tied for second in the league with his seven wins, tied for second in strikeouts with 81, leads the league in WHIP at 0.93, and has the third-lowest batting average against at .204. He also has the fourth-highest strikeout per nine inning ratio at 10.11, and the third-lowest walk per nine inning ratio at 1.51.

**2016 Highlights:** Richards started the 2016 season in the independent Frontier League, pitching for the Gateway Grizzlies, where he was 3-3 with a 3.21 ERA. After he was signed by the Marlins on July 7, Richards first was 0-0 with a 1.69 ERA in his three appearances and one start for rookie level Batavia. With Single-A Greensboro, Richards went 2-3 with a 3.50 ERA in his eight starts for the Grasshoppers.

**2015 Highlights:** Richards spent his first season in professional baseball with the Gateway Grizzlies in the independent Frontier League. There he was 6-6 with a 3.36 ERA in his 14 starts for Gateway.

**College:** Richards left Drury as one of the program's best pitchers in their modern era. He ranks second at Drury in career strikeouts with 230 and his 2.96 career earned run average is the second lowest mark in team history. He posted a 24-12 record as a collegiate pitcher, was a three-time All-Great Lakes Valley Conference performer and was twice named to the All-Region team. In his senior season in 2015, he went 5-3 with a 3.61 ERA and recorded 72 strikeouts against just 19 walks in 72.1 innings.

**Personal:** Earned All-Area First Team honors, NCA All-Star Baseball Team honors and was once Co-MVP and once MVP for Mater Dei Catholic High School. . . Named Mater Dei's most valuable pitcher also with a 9-1 record helping Mater Dei Catholic to a 21-3 record. . . Was on Mater Dei team that set a school record for most wins in a season. . . Was named to the All-PNC St. Louis All-Star Team, a group of the St. Louis areas best players and played at Busch Stadium. . . Was a US Army Reserve National Scholar Athlete and a member of the Honor Roll.
