**Tonight's Game:** The Nashville Sounds and New Orleans Baby Cakes continue the final series of the season this afternoon at Shrine on Airline. The Sounds slipped past the Baby Cakes 3-2 in the series opener. This afternoon, right-hander Josh Smith starts for the Sounds in their against right-hander Scott Copeland for the Baby Cakes.

**Josh Smith:** 30-year-old Josh Smith makes his second start of the season for the Sounds in this afternoon's game. The right-hander is 4-1 with a 3.72 ERA in 18 games with Nashville. In his most recent outing on August 28 against the Omaha Storm Chasers he tossed five scoreless innings and struck out a season-high five batters. Opposing batters are hitting just .221 against him with 11 walks and 39 strikeouts in 36 1/3 innings. The Margate, Florida native has played in 26 games for Oakland this season and posted a 2-1 record with a 4.89 ERA in 35 innings. He was claimed off waivers by Oakland from Cincinnati on November 4, 2016. He was originally drafted by Cincinnati in the 21st round of the 2010 MLB Draft out of Lipscomb University.

**Scott Copeland:** 29-year-old Scott Copeland starts for New Orleans this afternoon. The right-hander is 9-11 with a 4.92 ERA in 25 starts with the Baby Cakes. Copeland last pitched on August 28 at Oklahoma City. He logged his fourth consecutive quality start as he allowed just one run, a solo home run to Rob Segedin, in seven innings. Copeland signed a minor-league contract with the Marlins on November 21, 2016. The Longview, Texas native was originally drafted by the Baltimore Orioles in the 21st round of the 2010 MLB Draft out of the University of Southern Mississippi.

**2017 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following amount of days in the American Southern Division standings in 2017: First: 1, Second: 128, Third: 8, Fourth: 10.

**Draft Day Buddies:** Both of today's starting pitchers were drafted in the 21st round of the 2010 MLB Draft. New Orleans' Scott Copeland was selected by Baltimore with the 628th overall selection while Josh Smith was taken by Cincinnati at number 637 overall. Albuquerque outfielder Noel Cuevas (Dodgers) and Memphis relief pitcher Josh Lucas (St. Louis) are the other two current PCL players who were selected in the 21st round of the 2010 draft. The Nationals selected Bryce Harper with the first overall pick in the 2010 draft.

**Gimme Ten:** The Sounds accumulated 10 hits last night. It was the 47th time this season they have tallied double-digit hits and are now 34-13 when doing so. They have won the last six games in which they have collected 10 or more hits.

**Get In Front, Stay In Front:** Nashville scored first last night for 65th time this season. The Sounds are 47-18 (.723) when doing so, which is the second best record in the PCL behind Colorado Springs' 49-18 (.731) mark.

**Shutout Sounds:** The Sounds are 8-5 against New Orleans on the season and all five losses have been shutouts. Overall, Nashville has been blanked 12 times this season.

**Making Moves:** September call-ups began yesterday and Oakland poached two players from the Sounds active roster. Infielder and top A's prospect Franklin Barreto was called up for his second stint with the big league club this season. LHP Sam Moll was also recalled for his MLB debut. In addition, Oakland reinstated catcher Josh Phegley and outfielder Jake Smolinski who were on rehab assignments with the Sounds.

**Ending in the Big Easy:** The Sounds wrapped up the 2016 season in New Orleans as well. Two of the four scheduled games were rained out while the Zephyrs won the two games that were played. On September 3, 2016 Matt Chapman blasted three home runs in the 6-5 loss.

**No Bombs for Nunie:** Renato Nuñez, has not hit a home run in nine games and is no longer MiLB's leader in for the first time since July 3 when he had 21 and Lehigh Valley's Scott Kingery had 22. His nine-game homerless streak is his second longest streak of the season without a blast. He went 10 straight without a bomb from April 12-23. The Sounds have never had a player lead MiLB in home runs.

**Muñoz Making Noise:** Yairo Muñoz continues to stay red-hot at the plate with another hit last night. During his current eight-game hitting streak, he's batting .514 (18-for-35) with 5 runs scored, 4 RBI, 1 triple, 2 doubles, and 1 stolen base. It's the first time this season Muñoz has put together six multi-hit games during the eight-game stretch. His season-long hitting streak is 11 games with Double-A Midland from June 7-17 and his career-long is 17 games with Short Season Vermont in 2014.

**If You Build It, They Will Come:** Thursday night's rainout meant that 593,679 fans came through the gates at First Tennessee Park this season, a single-season record. The franchise's single-season attendance mark of 605,122 was set at Greer Stadium in 1990. The Sounds lead the Pacific Coast League in average attendance at 8,861 per game and sit fourth in all of Minor League Baseball behind Triple-A Indianapolis (9,159), Triple-A Charlotte (9,109), and Triple-A Columbus (9,039).

**Renato's Race:** Despite not hitting a home run in his last 34 at-bats, Renato Nuñez's 32 homers is tied for the 5th-most in a single season in team history with Chad Hermansen (1999). Next up on the list is Dan Pasqua who hit 33 in 1984 and Craig Wilson who hit 33 in 2000. Steve Balboni (1980) and Brian Dayett (1982) hold the franchise record with 34 in a single season.

**Nuñez into 4th:** Renato Nuñez moved into sole possession of 4th on the Sounds all-time home run list. Nuñez has 32 this year and hit 23 last year to bring his total to 55 in a Sounds uniform. Mike Robertson is 3rd on the list with 57.

**Wendle Keeps Climbing:** Infielder Joey Wendle continues to climb the Sounds' all-time hitting charts. He's among the all-time leaders in doubles (1st, 102), triples (5th, 25), runs scored (5th, 227), at-bats (5th, 1,534), and hits (5th, 436). Wendle has played in 377 games with the Sounds, the 10th-most in franchise history.
