Last Game: The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (11-16) fell to the Tennessee Smokies (16-10) by a 2-1 score in the first game of the five-game series at Smokies Stadium on Wednesday night. Jacksonville starter Severino Gonzalez (0-1) took the loss, allowing two runs on four hits with a walk and three strikeouts. Tennessee reliever Daury Torrez (1-0) earned the win with a scoreless inning and a third of relief. Andury Acevedo picked up his first save of the year by working the final two innings in perfect fashion. Jacksonville took the lead with a two-out RBI single by Austin Nola in the top of the first to put the Shrimp in front 1-0. Tennessee tied the game in the bottom of the second with a solo homer by catcher Ian Rice to put the score at 1-1. Tennessee starter Trevor Clifton had a no decision, working five and two-third innings where he allowed a run on seven hits with two walks and five strikeouts. The game remained tied until the bottom of the sixth inning, when Jacob Hannemann hit a solo homer over the right field wall to put the Smokies ahead 2-1, which would be the final score. James Buckelew turned in a scoreless two outings out of Jacksonville's bullpen to keep the Smokies off the board in the seventh and eighth. Jacksonville did not have a baserunner in the final two innings against Acevedo as he preserved the one-run victory. The loss ends Jacksonville's four-game winning streak.

NEWS AND NOTES

Norwood Rolling: Jumbo Shrimp right fielder John Norwood is rolling right along for the Jumbo Shrimp at the plate. Not only has Norwood hit safely in the last five games for the Jumbo Shrimp, but he has collected three hits in each of the last three games. Norwood entered the series with Tennessee by having homered in the final three games of the Mobile series, and he leads Jacksonville with five home runs this season. Norwood is hitting .286 for the Jumbo Shrimp this season, with five homers and nine RBI in 26 games played, and he is listed by Baseball America as the Marlins No. 29 prospect entering this season. This series Norwood is also playing close to his college home of Nashville, where he starred for Vanderbilt.

Smokies for A Bit: This marks the only trip to Smokies Stadium in 2017 for Jacksonville, and last year the club was 4-1 in Tennessee, and 6-4 against the Smokies overall. Jacksonville has struggled on the road this season, going 4-11 with series losses at Mississippi, Pensacola, and Birmingham, compared to a 7-3 mark at home at the Baseball Grounds.

Roster Moves: The Miami Marlins announced a transaction that impacts their Double-A affiliate Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp roster prior to today's game against the Tennessee Smokies at the Smokies Stadium at noon. Left-handed relief pitcher Kyle Lobstein has been transferred from extended spring training to Jacksonville. Lobstein has not appeared in a game yet this season in the Marlins organization. Lobstein, 27, was signed by the Marlins as a minor league free agent on Nov. 10, 2016. Lobstein has pitched in parts of three seasons in the major leagues, first appearing with the Detroit Tigers in 2014 and 2015, before pitching last year as a reliever for the Pittsburgh Pirates. In parts of three big league campaigns, Lobstein is 6-10 with a 5.06 ERA in 34 appearances and 17 starts. Lobstein previously pitched in the Southern League in 2011 and 2012 with the Montgomery Biscuits when he was part of the Tampa Bay Rays organization.

Attendance Kings of Double-A Baseball: The Jumbo Shrimp have loved being at home, not only with a 7-3 record and series victories over Chattanooga and Mobile, but in terms of attendance as well. Through 10 games the Jumbo Shrimp not only lead the Southern League but also all of Double-A baseball with 70,180 total fans and an average of 7,018 fans. Also in Double-A, the Jumbo Shrimp were the only team to reach 70,000 fans through May 1. In April, Jacksonville ranked eighth in all of Minor League Baseball by bringing in an average of 7,534 fans, and Jacksonville was also 18th in total attendance. With 41,276 in attendance over five days, Jacksonville fans made the inaugural Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp home series the highest-attended series in the 15-year history of the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville.

LAST START: Tomshaw ended a three-game Jumbo Shrimp losing streak by earning the win on Friday April 27 against the Mobile BayBears at the Baseball Grounds. Tomshaw worked seven scoreless innings allowing five hits with a walk and four strikeouts as Jacksonville on 4-0.

BARONS WIN: Tomshaw earned the win in his start on Sunday April 23 against the Birmingham Barons at Regions Field. Tomshaw worked five and two-third innings where he allowed a run on six hits with four walks and five strikeouts as Jacksonville snapped an 8-game losing streak with a 6-1 win.

WAHOOS START: Tomshaw had a no decision in his last start on Tuesday April 18 against the Blue Wahoos at Blue Wahoos Stadium. Tomshaw turned in five innings where he allowed four runs (all earned) on eight hits with a walk and two strikeouts. The game was tied at four when Tomshaw left, then the Wahoos scored three runs in the bottom of the eighth to win 7-4.

LOOKOUTS WIN: Tomshaw earned his first win in 2017 on Thursday April 13 at the Baseball Grounds when he defeated Chattanooga. Tomshaw turned in five innings where he allowed one run (no earned runs) on three hits with two walks and four strikeouts as the Jumbo Shrimp won 5-3.

BRAVES LOSS: Tomshaw took the loss in his 2017 debut on Friday April 7 at Mississippi. Tomshaw allowed two runs (both in the first inning) on seven hits with no walks and six strikeouts in his five innings of work, his final four innings in scoreless fashion. Tomshaw did not receive any run support, as the Shrimp were blanked 2-0 by the M-Braves.

#18 MATT TOMSHAW LHP | 6-1, 205 lbs | Born: Kingston, NY. Age: 28

Acquired by the Marlins in the 2014 Rule 5 draft from the Minnesota Twins

Originally drafted by the Twins in the 42nd round of the 2011 June First-Year Player Draft out of Jacksonville University.

2016 Highlights: Tomshaw had three stints with Jacksonville from May 30-June 20, June 22-July 30, and August 5 through the end of the season. With Jacksonville he was 4-4 with a 3.63 ERA in 15 appearances and 14 starts. He struck out at least six batters in his last five starts for Jacksonville, beginning with a season-high of 10 on August 12 vs. Mississippi. Tomshaw was 0-1 with a 2.12 ERA in eight games in relief for the New Orleans Zephyrs, with his first five appearances coming in the month of May, and the final three in late July, early August. Tomshaw took his lone loss when he allowed a pair of runs in the 12th inning against the Colorado Springs Sky Sox on May 12. Tomshaw returned to the Zephyrs where he made an appearance June 21 allowing a hit with no walks with four strikeouts. Tomshaw in late July and August pitched for the Zephyrs in two relief outings on July 30 and August 3, turning in scoreless outings against the Nashville Sounds and Iowa Cubs. After some time in extended spring training, Tomshaw earned the win in his lone appearance with the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads on May 1. He worked three scoreless innings, allowing a hit with a strikeout.

2015 Highlights: Spent the majority of his first season in the Marlins system with Double-A Jacksonville. Tomshaw went 6-10 with a 4.33 ERA in 20 appearances and 18 starts. finished year s reliever: 1-1, 4.50 ERA in 11 G, started season as starter: 4-6, 5.35 ERA in 12 GS. Made two starts with Triple-A New Orleans in Mid-August, going 0-2 with a 17.18 ERA, allowing 15 runs (14 earned) in 7.1 IP.

2014 Highlights: He spent all of last year with advanced-A Fort Myers Miracle, going 11-6 with a 3.50 ERA in 25 games and 21 starts over 136.1 innings. On the campaign he set career highs for innings pitched (136.1) and tied his career high with 82 strikeouts. Tomshaw led the Miracle in wins (11), games started (21), and was second in total strikeouts (82).

2013 Highlights: He split 2013 with Fort Myers (A+) and Cedar Rapids (A-). With Fort Myers the southpaw posted a 4-4 mark to go along with a 3.94 ERA in 17 games and 14 starts over 96.0 innings. His 42 earned runs given up with FM were good for second-most he has allowed in a single stop. With CR, Tomshaw went 2-0 with a 5.10 ERA in nine games and four starts over 30.0 innings pitched. Batters hit .290 against Tomshaw at the low-A stop which was the worst of his career.

2012 Highlights: Tomshaw split 2012 between the GCL Twins and the Beloit Snappers (A). With GCL, he appeared in only two games and over his three innings pitched he allowed two hits. He spent the majority of the year with Beloit, going 4-6 attached to a 3.02 ERA in 20 games and 14 starts over 86.1 innings pitched. At the time that had been Tomshaw's first season with 20

2011 Highlights: After being drafted he had stops between the GCL Twins and Fort Myers. In his first year in rookie ball the southpaw mustered up a 3-0 record while pitching to a 2.16 ERA in 11 games over 16.2 innings. He would receive his first call up to Fort Myers and enter into the starting rotation setting a 2.13 ERA in seven games and four starts over 25.1 innings.

Personal: Tomshaw was drafted out of Jacksonville University, and in an interview with *twinsdaily.com* he highlighted some of his bright spots with JU. "One of my biggest wins was against University of Florida during the regular season at their stadium. They just came off taking two from Vanderbilt that weekend. At the time, Florida was ranked 4th in the nation, and we ended up beating them 11-2. After the College World Series was over and Florida finished 2nd only to South Carolina, did it hit me how big of a win that was. Also in my senior year in game 1 of the conference tournament against Eastern Tennessee State University, I threw a complete game allowing 5 hits, 1 unearned run and winning 2-1.
