SNAPPER SNIPPETS

FIRST INNING OUTCOMES: The Snappers have allowed more runs in the first inning than any other inning this year. They have been outscored 59-35 in the first frame while surrendering at least 1 run in the first 30 times this year. Beloit is 12-18 when they allow a first-inning run.

.500 DAYS OF SUMMER: After finishing both the month of April & May with an even .500 record, the Snappers completed June with a record of 12-14 after dropping the series opener to Wisconsin on Friday night. The Snappers have been to the .500 mark this year 14 times including the 20, 40, 50, & 60-game check points & are 2 games below .500 before the 80-game mark.

STRIKEOUT SURGE: Snappers pitchers have been locked in to start the new half. They have recorded 94 K's in the first 9 games of the Second Half by reaching double digits in 5 games including 23 strikeouts at Peoria on Monday. On the season, Beloit pitchers have recorded 36 games with double-digit strikeouts. They are 3rd in the league with 708 whiffs & are on track to snap the club record of 1186 punch outs in a single season.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Beloit converted 3 double plays on Friday night to boost their total to 84 twin killers this year, which leads all of A-ball. Their 84 DPs are 7th-most in all of Minor League Baseball.

MARINEZ KEEPS HITTING: Eric Marinez was scored a hit in his first at-bat on Friday to extend his career-best hitting streak to 11 games, which is also the longest active streak in the Midwest League. He is now one game shy of Edwin Diaz's 12-game hitting streak as the longest by a Snappers hitter this season.

TWO IS BETTER THAN ONE: With a pair of hits on Friday night, Luis Barrera now has 23 multi-hit games to lead the team in that category. JaVon Shelby racked up 2 hits on Friday with a double & RBI. He now has 9 hits with 6 going for extra bases along with 7 RBI in the first 9 games of the new half.

HELPFUL TO GET A HANDFUL: The Snappers offense has plated 7 runs or more in 5 of 8 games to start the Second Half. Beloit is 27-6 this season when they score 5 runs or more in a game. When both the Snappers & their opponent score 5 runs, Beloit is 9-6.

FACING THE TIMBER RATTTLERS: The Snappers & Timber Rattlers will meet for the 3rd time this season & the 2nd time at Pohlman Field leading up to the 4th of July. At least one game in each series between these 2 squads has been impacted by weather with a postponement on May 23 in Beloit & a suspended game on June 3 in Appleton. The Timber Rattlers carry 3 of the Milwaukee Brewers top-30 prospects according to MLB Pipeline in Gilbert Lara (#17), Mario Feliciano (#23), & Demi Orimoloye (#24).
