Last Game: The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (7-11) defeated the Birmingham Barons (5-13) by a 4-1 score in the third game of the five-game series at Regions Field on Monday afternoon. Jacksonville starting pitcher Omar Bencomo (3-0) earned the win with his seven and a third innings where he allowed one run on four hits with one walk and a Shrimp-season high 10 strikeouts. Birmingham starter Spencer Adams (0-4) took the loss, allowing three runs (two earned) on six hits with two walks and 10 strikeouts. Jacksonville reliever Tyler Kinley turned in a perfect ninth to get his first save of the season. Brian Anderson started Jacksonville's scoring in the top of the third with a two-run double to put the Shrimp ahead 2-0. Anderson later scored when David Vidal had a base hit, and an error from the Barons shortstop Cleuluis Rondon scored Anderson to put Jacksonville's lead at 3-0. With his hit Vidal, who earlier today was named the Southern League Player of the Week, has hit safely in his last 10 games played. Anderson added his third RBI of the game in the top of the seventh when his sacrifice fly scored Isaac Galloway to put the lead at 4-0. Bencomo worked the first seven innings in scoreless fashion with 10 strikeouts, however Mason Robbins led off the bottom of the eighth with a solo homer to right field to put the score at 4-1, which would be the final. Greg Nappo got the final two outs of the eighth inning out of the Jacksonville bullpen, and then Kinley's perfect ninth preserved the win.

NEWS AND NOTES

Vidal Southern League Player of the Week: Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp second baseman David Vidal has been named the Southern League Player of the Week for the week of April 17-23, announced by the league office Monday morning. Vidal is the first Jumbo Shrimp player to earn a weekly honor from the Southern League in 2017. "Day in and day out I've been working hard and trying to get better every day," said Vidal. "I've had the same approach but a different mentality at the plate, knowing the situations and knowing the pitchers and how they're going to work me and I'm trying not to overthink at the plate. Just do my best and be productive for my team." Over the past week, Vidal has hit safely in each game he has played for the Jumbo Shrimp. Since April 17 he has hit .407 (11-for-27) with three doubles, a home run, five runs batted in, and has scored three runs. Vidal currently has a 10-game hitting streak for the Jumbo Shrimp, which is tied for the longest active streak in the Southern League right now with Montgomery's Granden Goetzman. In his hitting streak, Vidal is hitting .400 (14-for-35) with a home run and five RBI.

Galloway Returns to Jacksonville: Outfielder Isaac Galloway has been transferred from Triple-A New Orleans to Jacksonville. Galloway has played in 13 games for the Baby Cakes, and he is hitting .172 with two home runs and six runs batted in to begin the season. Galloway has played in Jacksonville in parts of the 2013, 2014, and 2015 seasons, and was Jacksonville's starting center fielder when the club won the 2014 Southern League championship. Galloway had a solid first night back with the Jumbo Shrimp on Saturday, going 1-for-4 with a double in his first game back with the Double-A club since 2015. He continued his strong play on Sunday afternoon, going 2-for-5 with a pair of doubles, and he has hit three doubles in his return to the Double-A level. Galloway has hit safely in now three straight games for Jacksonville, going 1-for-4 with a walk and a run scored on Monday afternoon.

Record Attendance in Jacksonville: With 41,276 in attendance over five days, Jacksonville fans made the inaugural Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp home series the highest-attended series in the 15-year history of the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Jacksonville's opening series attendance increased by 57 percent over last season, and has increased by 110 percent over the first two seasons of new ownership by Fast Forward Sports Group. After their game Sunday, the Jumbo Shrimp led all of the Southern League and Double-A baseball, while also ranking fifth in all of Minor League Baseball, in home attendance for the 2017 season. Wednesday's Opening Night sellout of 10,477 was the largest crowd at a Southern League game at the ballpark since July 3, 2012, and Jacksonville's largest opening crowd since a stadium record of 12,943 attended the ballpark's first-ever game on April 11, 2003.

LAST START: Kickham took his second straight loss at Pensacola on Thursday April 20. Kickham worked five innings where he allowed seven runs on eight hits with no walks and four strikeouts. Most of the damage by the Blue Wahoos was done with a five-run bottom of the second, then the Wahoos also scored a pair of runs against him in the sixth inning where he did not record an out. Jacksonville lost the game 8-5.

LOOKOUTS LOSS: Kickham took fist first loss of the year on Saturday April 15 against the Chattanooga Lookouts at the Baseball Grounds. Kickham worked five innings where he allowed two runs (both earned) on four hits with a walk and six strikeouts, in a game that Jacksonville would lose 10-1.

BRAVES START: Kickham had a no decision in his 2017 and Marlins organization debut on Sunday April 9 at Mississippi. Kickham worked five innings where he allowed two runs (both earned) on four hits with no walks and four strikeouts. He left the game with Jacksonville trailing 2-0, only to tie the game with a pair of runs in the top of the sixth. The game went 13 innings, where Mississippi won 4-3.

2016 with RICHMOND: Kickham's time in affiliated baseball last season was spent with the Double-A Richmond Flying Squirrels in the Eastern League. There he went 0-1 with a 6.75 ERA in six relief appearances before he was released by the Giants on May 20, 2016.

2016 with KANSAS CITY T-BONES: Kickham spent time in independent baseball last year with the Kansas City T-Bones in the American Association. There he went 3-5 with a 2.83 ERA in 14 starts to close out the season.

BIG LEAGUE TIME: Kickham pitched in the major leagues with the San Francisco Giants in 2013 and 2014. He made his big league debut on May 28, 2013 in Oakland against the Athletics, where he allowed four runs on four hits in his two and a third innings of work, taking the loss in the game. He had more call-ups to the big leagues in June, July, August, and then finished September in a Giants uniform. All together, in 2013 he was 0-3 with a 10.16 ERA in his 12 appearances and three starts. In 2014 he was a September call-up to the Giants, and had no wins or losses and a 22.50 ERA in two relief appearances for a club that went on to win the World Series. In parts of two big league seasons, Kickham is 0-3 with a 10.98 ERA in 14 games and three starts.

2016 Highlights: Kickham's time in affiliated baseball last season was spent with the Double-A Richmond Flying Squirrels in the Eastern League. There he went 0-1 with a 6.75 ERA in six relief appearances before he was released by the Giants on May 20, 2016. Kickham spent time in independent baseball last year with the Kansas City T-Bones in the American Association. There he went 3-5 with a 2.83 ERA in 14 starts to close out the season.

2015 Highlights: Kickham split the 2015 season between the Seattle Mariners and Texas Rangers organizations, pitching exclusively in the Triple-A Pacific Coast League. He started the year with Triple-A Tacoma, where he was 0-2 with a 7.29 ERA in five starts before he was designated for assignment by the Mariners on May 4. He then was claimed off waivers by the Texas Rangers a day later, and then pitched for Triple-A Round Rock where he was 1-0 with a 6.00 ERA in seven relief appearances before he was released on June 11.

2014 Highlights: Kickham spent most of 2014 with Triple-A Fresno where he was 8-8 with a 4.43 ERA in 27 starts in the Pacific Coast League. In 2014 he was a September call-up to the Giants, and had no wins or losses and a 22.50 ERA in two relief appearances for a club that went on to win the World Series
