TODAY'S GAME: Your Rancho Cucamonga Quakes take on the Inland Empire 66ers (Los Angeles Angels affiliate) tonight in the second game of a three-game series. The Quakes began this six-game road trip by losing two-of-three in Modesto. After this three-game set with the 66ers, Rancho will return home for four games with the Stockton Ports, starting Monday, August 14th.

VS INLAND EMPIRE: Even after a loss last night, Rancho still leads the overall season series, 13-9, head-to-head with Inland Empire. This is the 23rd meeting out of 27 between the two teams this year. The Quakes will see the 66ers one final time at home from August 25th through the 27th for a three-game series.

RANCHO DROPS THIRD STRAIGHT AFTER OFFENSE, CURRY FALTER: Two solo home runs were not enough offensively for the Quakes in a 5-2 loss to Inland Empire last night. Zach Reks went deep on the first pitch of the game and Omar Estevez added a solo blast in the ninth inning, but the two combined for all four hits on the night for Rancho. Parker Curry (1-5) took the loss in his first start as a Quake, only lasting three and a third innings while allowing five runs on five hits. Daniel Corcino was a bright spot in the bullpen for the Quakes, tossing three and two-thirds scoreless innings while striking out five.

RECENT ROSTER MOVES: INF Adrian Gonzalez and OF Andre Ethier have been added to the Quakes' roster from the Los Angeles Dodgers for rehab assignments.

WELCOME BACK, ADRIAN AND ANDRE: Adrian Gonzalez and Andrew Ethier will join the Quakes today for rehab assignments. Gonzalez is making his second rehab appearance with the Quakes this season, but Ethier marks the 13th Dodger rehabber this year, all brought to you by San Manuel Casino. Gonzalez, who has been on the DL since June 12th with lower-back discomfort, played in two games with the Quakes on May 16th and May 17th, going 3-for-6 with two doubles and two RBIs. Gonzalez has played in five games with Triple-A Oklahoma City and is scheduled to finish up his rehab assignment with the Quakes. The five-time All-Star is hitting .255 over 49 games in his sixth season with the Dodgers this year. Ethier has been sidelined since Spring Training when he suffered a herniated disk in his lower-back. The 35-year-old is making his third rehab stint with the Quakes since 2012. In 2016, Ethier spent nine games with Rancho, hitting .290 (9-for-31). Ethier has spent all 11 of his professional seasons with the Dodgers and was an All-Star in 2010 and 2011.

CRUCIAL SERIES WITH 66ERS: With 22 games remaining in the second half of play, the Quakes have a four-game lead over Inland Empire and a nine-game lead over Lake Elsinore. The winner of the South Division in the second half will play Lancaster in the first round of the playoffs. If Lancaster wins the second half, the team with the best overall record in the South Division will meet up with the JetHawks in the first round of the postseason. Rancho has a 10-game lead over both the 66ers and the Storm overall.

REKS WRECKING AT THE DISH: The newest piece of the Quakes' offense has been a key one. Zach Reks has only hit in 10 games, but he has six multi-hit games during that stretch. After going 2-for-4 last night, Reks is hitting .486 (18-for-37) with two home runs, eight runs and three RBIs.

ONE-RUN GAMES OR BLOWOUTS?: The Quakes are second in the league in winning percentage in one-run games this season, 19-12 (.613). Rancho has won six-straight one-run contests. The Quakes are also a league-best 25-16 (.610) in games that are decided by four runs or more over the course of the season.

I'LL HAVE THE LAST LAUGH: When scoring last in a game, the Quakes are first in the league at 39-13 (.750), but they are second-to-last in the league when scoring first in games: 39-22 (.639).

FERGUSON TO TAKE THE HILL FOR THE QUAKES: All-Star Caleb Ferguson will make the start in game two for the Quakes. In his last start, Ferguson took a no-decision, giving up three runs over six innings while striking out 10 and walking one. Ferguson has found his groove this season, winning seven straight decisions and seven out of his last 10 games. During that span, he owns a 2.37 ERA and has thrown six quality starts. Ferguson, who was Rancho's opening day starter, is making his 22nd start on the year. The left-hander, who was a 38th-round draft pick of the Dodgers in 2014 out of high school in West Jefferson, OH, spent most of last season with Great Lakes. He made 10 out of his 12 starts in 2016 there, going 1-4 with a 2.68 ERA in 50 and a third innings for the Loons.

OPPOSING PITCHER: Nate Bertness will start game two of the series tonight. Bertness, who will start his second game with the 66ers this season tonight, was drafted by the Angels in the 16th round in 2015 out of McLennan Community College. He began this season with the Single-A Burlington Bees, going 5-9 with a 5.15 ERA in 19 starts (21 games) and he was promoted to Inland Empire on August 3rd. In his first start for the 66ers, he threw five innings against the San Jose Giants on August 6th, allowing two runs on four hits while striking out eight and walking one in a no-decision.
