SNAPPER SNIPPETS

HELPFUL TO GET A HANDFUL: Beloit's offense has played their last 5 games without reaching the 5-run mark. The Snappers are 27-6 this season when they score at least 5 runs in a game. Their longest stretch this season without getting a handful was 9 games at the end of the First Half & the first game of the new half. When both the Snappers & their opponent score 5 runs, Beloit is 9-6.

LUIS WITH THE LUMBER: Luis Barrera hit his 7th triple of the year & matched the 2016 Snappers team-best set by Trace Loehr. He also stole his 11th bag of the year to put him in the 2nd position among all Athletics farmhands in that category. His 2 hits on Tuesday accounted for his 24th multi-hit game of the year, the most by a Snappers hitter this season.

SWING IT SHELBY: JaVon Shelby continues to hit against the Peoria Chiefs. After 2 more hits on the 4th of July at Dozer Park, Shelby is hitting a team-best .349 against Peoria with a 1.045 OPS. Both Shelby & Luis Barrera have 15 hits against the Chiefs. He has started his last 11 games batting in the 9-hole & is hitting .308 with a .964 OPS & 7 RBI during this half.

PERSICO KEEPS PRODUCING: After driving in his 9th RBI of the Second Half on Tuesday, Luke Persico's team-leading 44 RBI are 10th in the Midwest League. Persico has had at least one RBI in his last 4 games at Dozer Park.

GETTING ON BASE: Kyle Nowlin has delivered 2 crucial hits in his last 2 games with a game-tying home run on Sunday & the go-ahead RBI double on Monday. He has also walked in 6 of his last 7 games to boost him up to 3rd in the Midwest League in walks. His 18 walks in June were 2nd-most in the league behind 19 by Clinton's Joe Rizzo.

CLEAN DEFENSE: For the first time this season, the Snappers have now played 3 consecutive games without committing an error. They previously had gone back-to-back games just 4 times this year. Tuesday's contest was the 7th game of the Second Half that the Snappers have played without an error.

CLOSE GAMES: The Snappers have played 53 games this year decided by 3 runs or fewer & they are 26-27 in those contests. Beloit has also played in 28 one-run games, the 2nd-most in the MWL Kane County.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: The Snappers hand the baseball over to Zack Erwin & is set to make his 8th start for the Snappers this year. He made 5 starts for Beloit a year ago as well & has yet to face the Peoria Chiefs. Erwin has never faced a Cardinals affiliate in his career. The Snappers were 6-0 in games started by the southpaw until a 7-4 loss against Wisconsin in his last outing.

FACING THE CHIEFS: Beloit & Peoria have had 8 of their 12 meetings this season separated by 3 runs or fewer. These 2 squads will wrap up 11 consecutive games at Dozer Park on Thursday before returning the series to the Stateline next month. Each team has hit 10 homers in the season series after a pair for Peoria on Tuesday. 8 different Chiefs have homered against Beloit while 4 different Snappers batters have homers vs. Peoria. Peoria carries 4 of the Cardinals top-30 prospects with pitchers Jordan Hicks (#18) & Ronnie Williams (#24) in addition to hitters Dylan Carlson (#16) & Nick Plummer (#22).
