Last Game: Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp right-handers Kolton Mahoney and Brett Graves combined for a five-hit shutout of the Pensacola Blue Wahoos in a 4-0, seven-inning win in front of 5,592 before NAPA AutoCare Family Fireworks Friday night at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. The second game of the doubleheader was postponed until Saturday, when the teams will play a doubleheader of seven-inning games at 5:05 p.m., with gates opening at 4:30 p.m. The 121 Financial Baseball Bat Can Cooler Giveaway will be for the first 2,000 fans when gates open at 4:30 p.m. Saturday. On Friday, the Jumbo Shrimp (22-31) took a first-inning lead. Pensacola right-hander Vladimir Gutierrez (1-8) walked left fielder Kyle Barrett – who stole second base – and hit center fielder Monte Harrison with a pitch. After a double steal, second baseman Isan Diaz hit an RBI single to right field. Right fielder John Norwood grounded to third baseman Taylor Sparks, but Harrison beat the throw home. Third baseman Brian Schales hit an RBI single to right field for a 3-0 lead. With one out in the third inning, Gutierrez walked first baseman Eric Jagielo and Schales. Catcher Sharif Othman hit a fly ball to the left-center field warning track that scored Jagielo on an RBI single. Mahoney pitched four scoreless innings, allowing two hits and no walks with six strikeouts. On a rehab assignment from the Miami Marlins, Graves (1-1) scattered three hits and one walk with three strikeouts over the final three innings.

NEWS AND NOTES

We Just Want to Play Baseball: Is that too much to ask for, Mother Nature? Is it? The Jumbo Shrimp have only played seven innings of baseball that actually counts in the record books over the past 72 hours. After getting the first two games in despite battling rain Tuesday and Wednesday, the Jumbo Shrimp were postponed due to rain on Thursday night, setting up a Friday doubleheader. That night, the Jumbo Shrimp and Blue Wahoos waited three hours and 47 minutes to start that doubleheader, with Jacksonville beating Pensacola 4-0. Due to the late start (8:52 p.m.) of that first game, the second game was pushed back to Saturday for a doubleheader. The Saturday doubleheader began on time, but in the top of the fifth with Jacksonville an out away from making it an official game, heavy rains forced the cancellation of that game as well as game two of the twinbill.

Saturday's Roster Moves: Left-handed pitcher Mike Kickham has been transferred from Jacksonville to Triple-A New Orleans. Kickham pitched in two games for Jacksonville, working a scoreless three and a third innings where he did not allow a hit and struck out three batters with no walks. In a corresponding move, left-handed relief pitcher Miguel Del Pozo has been transferred from Marlins extended spring training to Jacksonville. Del Pozo, a member of the Marlins 40-man roster, began the season on Jacksonville's disabled list with a left pectoralis major strain. Del Pozo pitched in five games for Jacksonville last season, going 1-0 with a 2.25 ERA. Additionally, infielder Chris Diaz has been transferred from Triple-A New Orleans to Jacksonville. Diaz played in three games for the Baby Cakes, hitting .091 (1-for-11) with a run batted in. Diaz started the season with Jacksonville, playing in 37 games and hitting .206 with seven runs batted in. In a corresponding move, infielder Luis Pintor has been transferred from Jacksonville to extended spring training. Pintor played in five games for the Jumbo Shrimp, hitting .083 (1-for-12) with a run batted in. Additionally, outfielder Anfernee Seymour has been transferred from High-A Jupiter to Jacksonville. Seymour played in 16 games for the Hammerheads hitting .306 (19-for-62) with two home runs and six runs batted in. Seymour was signed by the Marlins as a minor league free agent on May 10 after he was released by the Atlanta Braves organization on May 6. Seymour started the season in the Braves organization with High-A Florida, and with the Fire Frogs he hit .195 with six runs batted in. In a corresponding move, outfielder Kyle Barrett has been released by the Marlins organization. Barrett played in 36 games for Jacksonville, hitting .228 with no home runs and 12 runs batted in to go along with five doubles and four triples.

It's Nice to Have You in Birmingham: Today the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp begin the first of two series between the Shrimp and Birmingham Barons, and this series marks Jacksonville's only trip to Regions Field in 2018. The Barons will make one appearance at the Baseball Grounds from August 19-23, so there will only be two series between the clubs this year as opposed to three last season. A year ago, the Shrimp lost their series in Birmingham, going 2-3 at Regions Field. The Jumbo Shrimp made up for it at the Baseball Grounds last August, going 9-1 against the Barons in Jacksonville, including a rare six-game sweep from August 21-25 that proved key to Jacksonville's run to a Second Half South Division Championship.

Shrimp Have Prospects: On the roster, the Jumbo Shrimp have five players who were listed by *MLB.com* as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (1), Isan Diaz (7), RHP Nick Neidert (8), RHP Pablo Lopez (21), and John Norwood (30).

LAST START: Poteet suffered his second straight loss in his start on Saturday May 26 against the Mississippi Braves at Trustmark Park. Poteet worked two and two-thirds innings, allowing a season-high seven runs (all earned) on eight hits with a walk and six strikeouts as Jacksonville trailed 7-0 when he left, and lost 8-4.

BAYBEARS LOSS: Poteet suffered a loss pitching his first career complete game in Game One of Jacksonville's doubleheader on Monday May 21 against the Mobile BayBears at the Baseball Grounds. Poteet worked all seven innings, allowing a run on six hits with two walks and five strikeouts. The run he allowed came in the first on a Zach Houchins RBI double, and next six innings were scoreless, and Jacksonville lost 1-0.

BISCUITS START: Poteet had a no decision in his start on Tuesday May 15 against the Montgomery Biscuits at Riverwalk Stadium. Poteet worked five and a third innings where he allowed four runs (all earned) on seven hits with three walks and a strikeout. Poteet left the game in the sixth inning with Jacksonville trailing 4-1, only to see the Shrimp tie the game with three runs in the seventh, and win the game 5-4 thanks to an eighth inning home run by Cade Gotta.

FIRST WAHOOS START: Poteet earned his second straight victory in his start on Saturday April 28 against the Pensacola Blue Wahoos at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Poteet turned in a season-long seven innings, allowing a run on two hits with two walks and four strikeouts. The lone run he allowed was a top of the second inning solo homer to Aristides Aquino. The Shrimp won a tight contest 2-1 off homers by Brian Schales and John Norwood.

PROSPECT BUZZ: Poteet had been regarded as Baseball America's No. 14 Marlins prospect entering the 2017 season, but fell out of the Top 30 rankings in the Marlins farm system for the 2018 season. Poteet had been Miami's No. 19 prospect entering 2016.

#20 CODY POTEET RHP | 6-1, 180 lbs | Born: San Diego, Calif. Age: 23

Selected by the Miami Marlins in the fourth round of the 2015 draft out of UCLA.

2017 Highlights: Poteet had success in 2017 with the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads. With Jupiter Poteet was a 2017 League Midseason All-Star and Marlins Organizational All-Star. Poteet with the Hammerheads was 2-3 with a 2.53 ERA in seven starts in the first half of the season, eventually going 3-7 with a 4.16 ERA in his 14 starts. Poteet was selected by the Marlins in the fourth round of the 2015 draft out of UCLA. In home games at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium, Poteet was 2-4 with a 3.30 ERA in eight appearances and six starts, while on the road Poteet was 1-3 with a 5.20 ERA in his eight starts away from Jupiter.

2016 Highlights: Poteet spent all of 2016 with the Single-A Greensboro Grasshoppers. With Greensboro he was 3-7 with a 4.16 ERA in 16 appearances and 14 starts. He was 3-5 with a 2.43 ERA in 13 starts in the first half of the year, while going 1-4 with a 3.48 ERA in 11 starts in the second half of the season.

2015 Highlights: After he was selected by the Marlins in the fourth round of the draft out of UCLA, Poteet spent time at rookie level Batavia in the New York-Penn League. With the Muckdogs he was 0-1 with a 2.13 ERA in five appearances and four starts.

College: Poteet was part of a strong pitching staff at UCLA that included Yankees first rounder James Kaprielian and closer David Berg, a second round pick by the Cubs in 2015. In 2015 Poteet was 7-1 with a 2.45 ERA in 27 appearances and 13 starts as he transitioned to being a mid-week starter for the Bruins. Honorable Mention Pac-12 All-Academic selection in 2015. Sunday starter in 2014, going 3-5 with a 4.46 ERA in 17 appearances and 15 starts. In 2013 as a freshman was a midweek starter, going 4-6 with a 4.84 ERA in 29 appearances and 11 starts. In summer of 2014 pitched in the Cape Cod League for the Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox, going 4-0 with a 3.09 ERA in seven starts. In summer of 2013 pitched in the West Coast League for the Walla Walla Sweets, going 3-2 with a 3.78 ERA with 27 strikeouts in 38 innings pitched.

Personal: Three-year varsity baseball letterwinner at Christian High School (El Cajon, Calif.) under head coach Michael Mitchell...selected in the 27th round of the 2012 MLB Draft by the Washington Nationals. Batted .509 with 55 hits, 13 doubles, 20 stolen bases, 23 RBI and 45 runs as a junior in 2011, pitching 17.2 innings that season...broke school records with 55 hits and a .509 batting average in 2011...did not play for Christian in 2012, instead competing for club team ABD Bulldogs ... went 10-1 with a 2.10 ERA and 112 strikeouts in 66.2 innings pitched for the Bulldogs in 2012.

He came on in relief for Marlins pitcher Brett Graves after his first rehab start, and Jacksonville lost the rubber match of the series 10-2.

BAYBEARS START: Duval had a no decision in his start in Game Two of Jacksonville's doubleheader against the Mobile BayBears at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville on Monday May 21. After a 34 minute delay to the game, Duval worked five innings where he allowed four runs (two earned) on seven hits with a walk and four strikeouts. Duval left the game with Jacksonville trailing 4-2, only to see the Jumbo Shrimp rally for six runs in the final two innings to win 8-4.

WAHOOS WIN: Duval earned his first Double-A victory in his "Duval County" debut on Monday April 30 against the Pensacola Blue Wahoos at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Duval turned in five innings where he allowed two runs (one earned) on three hits with three walks and six strikeouts as Jacksonville won the final game of the series 5-3.

#43 MAX DUVAL RHP | 6-5, 235 lbs | Born: April. 15, 1991 in San Luis Obispo, California. 27 years old.

Signed by the Marlins as a minor league free agent on July 28, 2017.

2017 Highlights: Started the season pitching for the Evansville Otters in the independent Frontier League. With Evansville, Duval went 8-2 with a 2.28 ERA in 14 starts, striking out 113 batters in 87 innings of work and he won the 2017 Frontier League Brian Tollberg Award for Most Valuable Pitcher, and he was also a Frontier League All-Star. After he signed with the Marlins on July 28, he went 4-0 with a 2.09 ERA in six starts for the Single-A Greensboro Grasshoppers. Came within two outs of a seven inning perfect game on August 9, 2017. He retired the first 19 batters he faced before ultimately allowing a run on two hits with seven strikeouts in a complete game win.

2016 Highlights: Started the season pitching for the Evansville Otters in the independent Frontier League, where he was 4-1 with a 4.40 ERA in seven starts. Signed with the Arizona Diamondbacks as a minor league free agent on June 23, 2016. Pitched at four different levels of the Diamondbacks organization, making one relief outing with High-A Visalia where he was 1-0 with a 9.64 ERA, going 2-6 with a 3.02 ERA in 10 starts for the Single-A Kane County Cougars, then with Short Season Class A Hillsboro had no wins or losses and a 7.36 ERA in two appearances and one start, then also two appearances and a start for the AZL Diamondbacks, going 1-1 with a 1.13 ERA in two appearances and one start. All of his moving around different affiliates mainly happened in a 14-day span in late June and early July.

2015 Highlights: Split the season pitching in the Frontier League, making four appearances with the Schaumburg Boomers where he had no wins or losses and a 13.50 ERA. He also pitched for the Frontier Greys, where he was 1-3 with a 3.51 ERA in 15 appearances and eight starts. The Greys were a team that played strictly road games in the Frontier League, hence the name Greys after the traditional road jersey color.

2014 Highlights: Duval made his professional baseball debut pitching for the Schaumburg Boomers in the independent Frontier League, with no wins or losses and a 6.75 ERA in three relief outings.

College: Started college career at Cuesta College before transferring to Hawaii for his junior season. At Hawaii in 2012 he hit .186 with one home run and 18 RBI as an infielder. At the plate in 2013, Duval hit .192 with no homers and 3 RBI. He also pitched that season, with no wins or losses and a 6.48 ERA in six games in relief. After college considered quitting baseball but mom encouraged him to keep playing, which landed him in independent baseball to give pitching a real chance.
