THE BLUE JAYS RAISE \$10,500 AT ANNUAL CHARITY BOWLING TOURNAMENT

The Sixth Annual event, held at Dunedin Lanes, was a massive success with more than 150 guests in attendance to support pediatric families staying at one of four Tampa Bay Ronald McDonald Houses.
