**Last Game:** The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (5-11) fell to the Birmingham Barons (5-11) by an 8-2 score in the first game of the five-game series at Regions Field on Saturday night. With the game tied at two in the bottom of the eighth with two outs, the Barons rallied for six runs to hand the Jumbo Shrimp their eighth straight loss, and Jacksonville is 0-6 so far on their 10-game road trip. Jacksonville reliever James Bucklew (0-1) took the loss, allowing the six runs (just one earned) in the bottom of the eighth. Barons reliever Colton Turner (3-1) worked the final two innings in scoreless fashion to pick up the win. The game was scoreless through the first three innings. Alex Glenn brought in the first run of the game for Jacksonville in the top of the fourth with an RBI double to give the Shrimp a 1-0 lead. Birmingham struck back in the bottom of the fifth with a two-run homer by Keon Barnum to put the Barons in front 2-1. Jacksonville quickly responded with an RBI double by David Vidal with two outs in the top of the sixth inning to tie the game at 2-2. Vidal went 2-for-4 for his team-best eighth multi-hit game of the year, and he also is the owner of an eight-game hitting streak, the longest streak for a Shrimp batter this season. Jacksonville starter Severino Gonzalez went five and two third innings where he allowed two runs on five hits with no walks and eight strikeouts. He gave way to Bucklew in the sixth inning, and the left-hander escaped a jam in that inning plus turned in a scoreless seventh. The bottom of the eighth began on a leadoff double for Cleuluis Rondan. A bunt single by Eddy Alvarez snuck by Bucklew on the third base side of the mound to put men on the corners with no outs. Bucklew forced Jake Peter to ground out to first, then struck out Courtney Hawkins for the second out of the inning. The Jumbo Shrimp intentionally walked Nick Basto to load the bases, and then Bucklew walked Trey Michalczewski on four pitches to break the tie and give the Barons a 3-2 lead. A fielding error by third baseman K.C. Serna on a grounder hit by Mason Robbins scored Alvarez to put the Barons lead at 4-2. The next batter Barnum hit a grand slam home run to centerfield to break the game open and give the Barons an 8-2 advantage.

## NEWS AND NOTES

**Vidal and Norwood Streaking:** Two Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp hitters have hit a hot stretch at the plate. David Vidal has the longest active and total hitting streak for the Jumbo Shrimp at eight games. Over his streak, which began on April 15 against Chattanooga, he is hitting .419 (13-for-31) with a home run and five runs batted in. Vidal also leads Jacksonville with eight multi-hit games in the 16 games he's played so far in 2017. Vidal is hitting .333 this season, which is the sixth best batting average in the Southern League, and he is tied for third in the league with six doubles. John Norwood is also streaking at the plate, as he has collected base hits in the last seven Jumbo Shrimp games. Over his streak, which began on April 16 against Chattanooga, he is hitting .370 (10-for-27) with a home run and two RBI.

**Galloway Returns to Jacksonville:** Outfielder Isaac Galloway has been transferred from Triple-A New Orleans to Jacksonville. Galloway has played in 13 games for the Baby Cakes, and he is hitting .172 with two home runs and six runs batted in to begin the season. Galloway has played in Jacksonville in parts of the 2013, 2014, and 2015 seasons, and was Jacksonville's starting center fielder when the club won the 2014 Southern League championship. Galloway had a solid first night back with the Jumbo Shrimp on Saturday, going 1-for-4 with a double in his first game back with the Double-A club since 2015.

**Record Attendance in Jacksonville:** With 41,276 in attendance over five days, Jacksonville fans made the inaugural Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp home series the highest-attended series in the 15-year history of the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Jacksonville's opening series attendance increased by 57 percent over last season, and has increased by 110 percent over the first two seasons of new ownership by Fast Forward Sports Group. After their game Sunday, the Jumbo Shrimp led all of the Southern League and Double-A baseball, while also ranking fifth in all of Minor League Baseball, in home attendance for the 2017 season. Wednesday's Opening Night sellout of 10,477 was the largest crowd at a Southern League game at the ballpark since July 3, 2012, and Jacksonville's largest opening crowd since a stadium record of 12,943 attended the ballpark's first-ever game on April 11, 2003.

# TONIGHT'S JUMBO SHRIMP STARTING PITCHER

**18 – MATT TOMSHAW, LHP**

**1-1, 3.60 ERA, 3 games and 3 starts**

**2017:** 1-1, 1.80 ERA (2 ER/10.0 IP) in 2 G and 2 GS.  
**CAREER:** 36-34, 3.72 ERA (256 ER/619.1 IP) in 148 G and 93 GS.

**2017 vs. BIR:** First Start  
**CAREER vs. BIR:** 0-1, 6.75 ERA (9 ER/12.0 IP) in 4 G and 3 GS.

**LAST START:** Tomshaw had a no decision in his last start on Tuesday April 18 against the Blue Wahoos at Blue Wahoos Stadium. Tomshaw turned in five innings where he allowed four runs (all earned) on eight hits with a walk and two strikeouts. The game was tied at four when Tomshaw left, then the Wahoos scored three runs in the bottom of the eighth to win 7-4.

**LOOKOUTS WIN:** Tomshaw earned his first win in 2017 on Thursday April 13 at the Baseball Grounds when he defeated Chattanooga. Tomshaw turned in five innings where he allowed one run (no earned runs) on three hits with two walks and four strikeouts as the Jumbo Shrimp won 5-3.

**BRAVES LOSS:** Tomshaw took the loss in his 2017 debut on Friday April 7 at Mississippi. Tomshaw allowed two runs (both in the first inning) on seven hits with no walks and six strikeouts in his five innings of work, his final four innings in scoreless fashion. Tomshaw did not receive any run support, as the Shrimp were blanked 2-0 by the M-Braves.

**2016 with JACKSONVILLE:** Tomshaw had three stints with Jacksonville from May 30-June 20, June 22-July 30, and August 5 through the end of the season. With Jacksonville he was 4-4 with a 3.63 ERA in 15 appearances and 14 starts. He struck out at least six batters in his last five starts for Jacksonville, beginning with a season-high of 10 on August 12 vs. Mississippi.

**2016 with NEW ORLEANS:** Tomshaw was 0-1 with a 2.12 ERA in eight games in relief for the New Orleans Zephyrs, with his first five appearances coming in the month of May, and the final three in late July, early August. Tomshaw took his lone loss when he allowed a pair of runs in the 12<sup>th</sup> inning against the Colorado Springs Sky Sox on May 12. Tomshaw returned to the Zephyrs where he made an appearance June 21 allowing a hit with no walks with four strikeouts. Tomshaw in late July and August pitched for the Zephyrs in two relief outings on July 30 and August 3, turning in scoreless outings against the Nashville Sounds and Iowa Cubs.

## #18 MATT TOMSHAW LHP | 6-1, 205 lbs | Born: Kingston, NY. Age: 28

Acquired by the Marlins in the 2014 Rule 5 draft from the Minnesota Twins

Originally drafted by the Twins in the 42<sup>nd</sup> round of the 2011 June First-Year Player Draft out of Jacksonville University.

**2016 Highlights:** Tomshaw had three stints with Jacksonville from May 30-June 20, June 22-July 30, and August 5 through the end of the season. With Jacksonville he was 4-4 with a 3.63 ERA in 15 appearances and 14 starts. He struck out at least six batters in his last five starts for Jacksonville, beginning with a season-high of 10 on August 12 vs. Mississippi. Tomshaw was 0-1 with a 2.12 ERA in eight games in relief for the New Orleans Zephyrs, with his first five appearances coming in the month of May, and the final three in late July, early August. Tomshaw took his lone loss when he allowed a pair of runs in the 12<sup>th</sup> inning against the Colorado Springs Sky Sox on May 12. Tomshaw returned to the Zephyrs where he made an appearance June 21 allowing a hit with no walks with four strikeouts. Tomshaw in late July and August pitched for the Zephyrs in two relief outings on July 30 and August 3, turning in scoreless outings against the Nashville Sounds and Iowa Cubs. After some time in extended spring training, Tomshaw earned the win in his lone appearance with the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads on May 1. He worked three scoreless innings, allowing a hit with a strikeout.

**2015 Highlights:** Spent the majority of his first season in the Marlins system with Double-A Jacksonville. Tomshaw went 6-10 with a 4.33 ERA in 20 appearances and 18 starts. finished year s reliever: 1-1, 4.50 ERA in 11 G, started season as starter: 4-6, 5.35 ERA in 12 GS. Made two starts with Triple-A New Orleans in Mid-August, going 0-2 with a 17.18 ERA, allowing 15 runs (14 earned) in 7.1 IP.

**2014 Highlights:** He spent all of last year with advanced-A Fort Myers Miracle, going 11-6 with a 3.50 ERA in 25 games and 21 starts over 136.1 innings. On the campaign he set career highs for innings pitched (136.1) and tied his career high with 82 strikeouts. Tomshaw led the Miracle in wins (11), games started (21), and was second in total strikeouts (82).

**2013 Highlights:** He split 2013 with Fort Myers (A+) and Cedar Rapids (A-). With Fort Myers the southpaw posted a 4-4 mark to go along with a 3.94 ERA in 17 games and 14 starts over 96.0 innings. His 42 earned runs given up with FM were good for second-most he has allowed in a single stop. With CR, Tomshaw went 2-0 with a 5.10 ERA in nine games and four starts over 30.0 innings pitched. Batters hit .290 against Tomshaw at the low-A stop which was the worst of his career.

**2012 Highlights:** Tomshaw split 2012 between the GCL Twins and the Beloit Snappers (A). With GCL, he appeared in only two games and over his three innings pitched he allowed two hits. He spent the majority of the year with Beloit, going 4-6 attached to a 3.02 ERA in 20 games and 14 starts over 86.1 innings pitched. At the time that had been Tomshaw's first season with 20

**2011 Highlights:** After being drafted he had stops between the GCL Twins and Fort Myers. In his first year in rookie ball the southpaw mustered up a 3-0 record while pitching to a 2.16 ERA in 11 games over 16.2 innings. He would receive his first call up to Fort Myers and enter into the starting rotation setting a 2.13 ERA in seven games and four starts over 25.1 innings.

**Personal:** Tomshaw was drafted out of Jacksonville University, and in an interview with *twinsdaily.com* he highlighted some of his bright spots with JU. "One of my biggest wins was against University of Florida during the regular season at their stadium. They just came off taking two from Vanderbilt that weekend. At the time, Florida was ranked 4th in the nation, and we ended up beating them 11-2. After the College World Series was over and Florida finished 2nd only to South Carolina, did it hit me how big of a win that was. Also in my senior year in game 1 of the conference tournament against Eastern Tennessee State University, I threw a complete game allowing 5 hits, 1 unearned run and winning 2-1.
