LANCASTER JETHAWKS (33-36) vs. LAKE ELSINORE STORM (33-36)

RHP RICO GARCIA (6-7, 3.66 ERA) vs. RHP MICHEL BAEZ (2-5, 2.91 ERA)

SETTING THE SCENE: The JetHawks take on Lake Elsinore (San Diego) in the final game of a 3-game series and 7-game road trip...RHP Rico Garcia (6-7) looks to jump into a tie for the league lead with 7 wins opposite Storm RHP Michael Baez (2-5).

FIRST THINGS FIRST: The JetHawks win over Lake Elsinore helped Rancho Cucamonga clinch first-place in the South Division's 1st Half race...if the JetHawks claim the South's other playoff spot in the 2nd half, they would match up with the Quakes in the playoffs for the 3rd-straight year.

SERIES BUSINESS: Lancaster's win last night assured them a series victory...marked club's 1st series win since a 3-game sweep of Visalia in Lancaster, May 15-17...Lancaster's last series sweep on the road came last season at Inland Empire, Aug. 18-20.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The JetHawks jumped ahead with 4 runs in the 1st inning and went to a 15-5 win...a Lake Elsinore error in the 1st led to 3 unearned runs...overall the Storm committed 3 errors and allowed 6 unearned runs total...the JetHawks also committed 3 errors leading to 4 unearned runs...Manny Melendez had 3 hits and 3 RBI...Brian Serven extended his hitting streak to 9 games with a 2-run single.

'HAWK STARS: The Cal League announced the rosters for next Tuesday's All-Star Game in Lancaster...9 JetHawks, the most of any South Division team, were selected...OF Vince Fernandez and IF Roberto Ramos were voted into the starting lineup...the club's pitching and reserve selections include RHP Rico Garcia,

RHP Alexander Guillen, RHP Heath Holder, RHP Reid Humphreys, RHP Justin Lawrence, IF Alan Trejo and IF Colton Welker...the South club will be managed by JetHawks skipper Fred Ocasio.

MARIACHI MASHER: IF Roberto Ramos leads the league with 17 HR, 137 total bases and a 1.042 OPS...also ranks 2nd with 42 RBI...was named the Cal League Player of the Month for May...led league with 9 HR and hit .345 with a 1.201 OPS.

HUMP DAY: RHP Reid Humphreys has not allowed an earned run since April 21 at IE...current 16.0 scoreless-IP streak is longest on the club this season...holding hitters to 4 hits and an .071 avg with 25 strikeouts and 5 walks during streak.

RICO SUAVE: RHP Rico Garcia earned his team-leading 6th win with his team-best 8th quality start Tuesday...leads the league with 86.0 IP.

STORM CHASERS: The JetHawks are 6-6 in the season series against Lake Elsinore and 5-4 in games played at The Diamond...today's game is the 13th of 28 in the season series and the 10th of 14 in Lake Elsinore.

SEEING STARS: The Hangar is set to host the Cal League All-Star Game in 2018...the festivities begin with a 38 *Special* concert Monday, June 18...the All-Star Game & Home Run Derby will take place on Tuesday, June 19...it will mark the 3rd All-Star Game in Lancaster.

LAST START (6/12 at IE): Snapped a 4-game losing streak in 8-1 win...allowed 1 run on 6 hits over 6.2 IP...struck out 4 and walked 3...did not allow a home run...recorded team-leading 8th quality start...allowed just 1 earned run for 3rd time in last 5 starts.

ALOHA, 2018: Was club's Opening Night starter (4/5) and allowed 5 earned runs on 9 hits over 5.0 frames vs. Modesto.

LAST SEASON: Began season with Short-Season Boise...went 0-4 with a 3.95 ERA over 8 starts...was promoted to Low-A Asheville and made full-season debut out of the bullpen on July 30...made 8 appearances overall with Tourists and went 2-2 with a 2.57 ERA...started his final 4 appearances...struck out 30 batters and walked 7 over 28.0 IP in South Atlantic League.
