**Giants, Nuts Meet Again...** The San Jose Giants open a three-game series against the Modesto Nuts this evening at John Thurman Field. Raffi Vizcaino (3-2, 3.72 ERA) is slated to make the start on the mound for San Jose tonight. This series marks the Giants' third trip to Modesto already this season. San Jose is 7-6 against the Nuts overall in 2018 (4-3 at Municipal Stadium, 3-3 at John Thurman Field). The Giants will play 22 games versus Modesto in the first half (all in a 49-game span from April 19-June 10).

**Road Warriors...** The Giants are in the midst of a season-high nine-game road trip. San Jose opened the trip last weekend by taking two out of three games in Stockton – the Giants' third consecutive road series win. It's the first time since August 2015 that San Jose has won three straight road series'. The Giants are 7-3 in their last 10 road games overall. Following the current series against the Nuts, San Jose will conclude their road trip with a three-game set at Lake Elsinore.

**Pitching Shines...** The Giants allowed a total of just five runs during their three-game series in Stockton. Only two of those runs were earned as San Jose boasted a 0.65 team ERA (2 ER/27.2 IP) during the series.

**First Half Race...** The Giants (25-19) are one game behind first-place Stockton (26-18) in the first half North Division race. Visalia (24-20) is also two games out of the top spot. Including tonight, 26 games remain in the first half. San Jose still has seven games left against both the Ports and Rawhide this half. The Giants last won a first half title in 2013.

**In Search Of Three Straight...** A victory tonight would give the Giants their second three-game winning streak this month (May 9-11). San Jose's longest win streak this season is four games (April 13-16, 20-23).

**Team Stats...** The Giants are third in the California League in team batting average (.264) and second in ERA (3.39). San Jose is third in the league in runs scored (5.0 runs per game) and third in home runs (34). On the mound, the Giants have allowed the fewest home runs in the league (17), but have issued the most walks (178, 4.0 per game). San Jose's 57 errors this year are tied for the league lead.

**Jalen Miller...** Jalen Miller brings a seven-game hitting streak into tonight's action. Miller is batting at a .379 clip (11-for-29) during the hit streak with five doubles and four RBI's. The former third round draft pick is hitting .302 overall this season after batting just .227 in 117 games with the Giants last season.

**Close Calls...** Six out of San Jose's last ten games have been decided by one run. The Giants are 10-7 in one-run games overall this season. Only Inland Empire (11-7) has played more one-run games than San Jose this year.

**Ruotolo Promoted...** Pitcher Patrick Ruotolo was promoted to Double-A Richmond yesterday. Ruotolo fashioned a 1.47 ERA in 14 relief appearances (3 ER/18.1 IP) with the Giants while he ranks third in the California League with six saves. The right-hander owns a career 1.49 ERA over three professional seasons.

**Holding Leads / Late Comebacks...** The Giants are a perfect 18-0 this season when leading after seven innings. Only San Jose and Lake Elsinore are unbeaten this year when holding a lead after the seventh. Conversely, the Giants have won a league-high four games this season when trailing after seven innings.

\* Is in his sixth professional season ... Originally signed with the San Francisco Giants in 2013 out of the Dominican Republic at age 17.

\* Scheduled to make his eighth start and ninth appearance of the season in tonight's game ... Has struck out 45 batters in 36 1/3 innings this year (3.72 ERA) ... 22 walks are fourth-most in the California League.

\* Is 1-0 with a 0.82 ERA over his last two starts surrendering just one run and five hits over 11 innings pitched ... Has walked five and struck out 17.

\* Faced Modesto in his most recent start on May 16 at Municipal Stadium ... Tossed five innings with one run and three hits allowed ... Walked one and struck out eight ... Threw 86 pitches ... Received a no-decision (left game with score tied 1-1, Giants eventually won 3-2) ... Also made a start against the Nuts on April 19 at Municipal Stadium ... Tagged for a season-high eight runs (four earned) on six hits over two innings – his shortest start of the season.

\* Fired six scoreless innings with a season-high nine strikeouts in his May 11 start versus Lancaster ... Allowed just two hits, walked four and picked-up the win.

\* Is 3-0 with a 2.12 ERA (4 ER/17.0 IP) in three starts against Lancaster and 0-2 with a 5.12 ERA (11 ER/19.1 IP) in five games (four starts) against the rest of the league.

\* Has fared slightly better against left-handed hitters (.231 AVG, 0 HR) compared to versus right-handed batters (.246 AVG, 3 HR) this season.

\* Has a 7.71 ERA over the first two innings of his starts and a 1.21 ERA after the second inning.

\* Opponents are batting .278 against him with runners in scoring position (.176 AVG with the bases empty).

\* Pitched for Augusta (A) in 2017 ... Was 5-7 with a 4.98 ERA in 16 games (12 starts) ... Struck out 74 and walked 28 over 77 2/3 innings ... Allowed three earned runs or fewer in 10 out of his 12 starts ... Began the year at Extended Spring Training before joining Augusta in mid-May.

\* Was named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week after tossing six no-hit innings in his June 10, 2017 start against Greenville (9 SO) ... Struck out a career-high 11 batters over six innings on August 25, 2017 versus Greenville.

\* Spent the majority of the 2016 season with Salem-Keizer (Short-Season) ... Was 0-4 with a 4.60 ERA in 11 games (10 starts) ... Also made two starts with Augusta during the final week of the 2016 season.

\* Pitched for the Giants' Dominican Summer League affiliate in his first three professional seasons from 2013-15 ... Fashioned an 8-0 record and a 2.50 ERA in 14 starts during the 2015 season ... Tied for the league lead in wins.

Current Hit Streak: 1 game

- \* First baseman in his third professional season ... Selected in the 6th round of the 2016 draft.
- \* Hit for the cycle on April 11 at Lancaster joining teammate Jalen Miller in accomplishing the feat that night.
- \* Spent the 2017 season with San Jose ... Hit .237 with 17 home runs and 55 RBI's in 113 games.
- \* Tied for the team lead in home runs last year ... Was also second on the club in doubles and fifth in RBI's.
- \* Was an outfielder in his first two seasons before transitioning to first base this year.
- \* Earned Northwest League All-Star honors with Salem-Keizer (Short-Season) in 2016.
- \* Led the Northwest League with 10 home runs in '16 ... Hit .264 with 42 RBI's in 53 G ... Won All-Star home run derby.
- \* Attended the University of the Pacific ... Finished career second in school history in doubles, fourth in HR & fifth in RBI's.
