**Giants Continue Series In Rancho Cucamonga...** The San Jose Giants play the second game of a three-game series against the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes this evening at LoanMart Field. Rancho Cucamonga posted a 15-6 victory over San Jose in the series opener yesterday. Logan Webb (1-2, 1.96 ERA) is slated to make the start on the mound for the Giants tonight.

**Last Night...** The 15 runs allowed by the Giants last night matched a season-high (July 10 at Stockton, 15-5 loss). Rancho Cucamonga's 19 hits yesterday was also the most given up in a game by San Jose this year (previous high: 18 hits). DJ Myers lasted just 2/3 of an inning last night to match the shortest outing by a Giants starting pitcher this season.

**Inside The Record...** The Giants are 10-17 in the second half: 1-9 versus Rancho Cucamonga and 9-8 against all other opponents.

**Offensive Surge...** Over their last nine games (5-4 record), the Giants are batting .293 as a team and averaging 5.3 runs per contest. San Jose has scored at least five runs in seven out of their last nine games.

**The Long Ball...** The Giants have hit 31 home runs in 27 second half games. San Jose's 22 homers in July are second in the California League (Rancho Cucamonga 26). Conversely, the Giants have allowed 26 home runs this month – tops in the league.

**Versus The Quakes...** The Giants are only 1-9 against Rancho Cucamonga this season. The Quakes have won the last nine meetings between the teams (San Jose's lone win: June 21). Against Rancho Cucamonga pitching, the Giants are batting just .197, averaging 3.5 runs per game and have struck out 111 times (11.1 per game). San Jose pitchers have surrendered 19 home runs over 10 games to the Quakes (6.83 ERA).

**Miller Named Offensive Player Of The Week...** Jalen Miller was named California League Offensive Player of the Week on Monday. In seven games last week, Miller hit .344 (11-for-32) with three doubles, three home runs and eight RBI's. It's the third weekly honor for the Giants this year (DJ Myers May 7-13 and Gio Brusa June 4-10).

**League Leaderboard...** Several Giants hitters rank among the California League leaders. Jalen Miller is tied for the league lead in hits (104), is fourth in doubles (26), tied for fourth in runs scored (54), tied for seventh in RBI's (51) and eighth in slugging (.466). Gio Brusa is fifth in the league in home runs (14), tied for seventh in RBI's (51) and sixth in slugging (.484). Wander Franco is third in doubles (27) and tied for third in hits (102) while Johneshwy Fargas is tied for second in stolen bases (27).

**On The Road...** At 21-28, the Giants own the second-worst road record in the league (Modesto 20-29). San Jose is 8-17 in their last 25 road games dating back to May 24 (after starting the year 13-11 on the road). The Giants' team ERA on the road is 4.88 compared to a 3.62 mark at home.

**Late Innings...** The Giants have won a league-high tying seven games this season when trailing after six innings (Modesto, Stockton). However, San Jose has also lost 10 games when leading after six – tops in the league (Modesto next-closest with eight losses). The Giants' 17 blown saves this year lead the California League.

**Below .500...** The Giants (44-53 overall) are looking to avoid a sub-.500 season for the third consecutive year. The San Jose Giants have never had three straight losing seasons in their team history (1988-2018). The Giants were a league-worst 62-78 last year following a 68-72 record in 2016 (did reach playoffs as a Wild Card team).

\* Scheduled to make his 18th start and 19th overall appearance of the season in this evening's game ... Has pitched 59 2/3 innings this year and allowed just 13 earned runs (1.96 ERA) ... Has pitched more than four innings only once in 17 starts.

\* Has not allowed an earned run in 12 out of his 17 starts.

\* Owns a 1.08 ERA over his last four starts ... Has pitched 16 2/3 innings with two runs and eight hits allowed ... Has struck out 24.

\* Most recent start came on July 13 against Visalia ... Pitched a season-high 4 2/3 innings with two runs (both earned) and three hits allowed ... Walked three and struck out five ... Began his start with three scoreless innings before giving up single runs in the fourth and fifth ... Was the first time he pitched more than four innings this season ... Threw a season-high 74 pitches ... Received a no-decision (Giants eventually won 8-6).

\* Has a perfect 0.00 ERA in two starts against Rancho Cucamonga (8 IP) ... Pitched four scoreless innings with two hits allowed and a career-high tying seven strikeouts on June 24 at LoanMart Field ... Also worked four scoreless innings versus the Quakes on July 4 at Municipal Stadium ... Did not give up a hit, walked two and struck out five.

\* Had a stretch of five consecutive starts spanning 17 innings from May 13 to June 3 with no runs allowed ... Is the longest scoreless inning streak by a Giants pitcher this season.

\* Has thrown 25 2/3 innings at home this season and allowed just 10 hits and two earned runs (seven starts) ... Has limited the opposition to a .125 batting average at home.

\* Owns a .210 opponents batting average overall (.210 vs. right, .209 vs. left) ... Has limited the opposition to a .189 batting average with runners in scoring position (.115 AVG w/RISP and two outs) ... Has given up just two home runs in 59 2/3 innings.

\* Prior to this season, hadn't made a start since May 31, 2016 (with Class-A Augusta).

\* Spent the entire 2017 season pitching out of the bullpen for Salem-Keizer (Short-Season) ... Made 15 relief appearances for the Volcanoes and was 2-0 with a 2.89 ERA ... Struck out 31 and walked seven over 28 innings ... Made his 2017 season debut on June 15 – over 12 months since his last game action.

\* Pitched for Augusta (A) in 2016 before undergoing season-ending Tommy John surgery on his right elbow in June ... Was 2-3 with a 6.21 ERA in nine starts for the GreenJackets ... Worked as a starting pitcher for Salem-Keizer in 2015 (14 GS, 3-6, 4.92 ERA) ... Began his professional career with the AZL Giants (Rookie) in 2014.

\* Drafted by the SF Giants out of Rocklin High School (Rocklin, CA) ... Posted a 0.49 ERA over 57 2/3 innings as a senior in 2014 to earn Sierra Foothill League MVP honors ... Was also a quarterback on the football team in three varsity seasons.

\* Had committed to play college baseball at Cal Poly prior to signing with the Giants.

- \* Infielder is in his fifth professional season ... Signed as an international free agent in 2013 at age 16.
- \* Currently ranked the #19 prospect in the San Francisco organization by *MLB.com* ... Third-highest infielder on list.
- \* Joined San Jose from Extended Spring Training on June 7 ... Suffered fractured leg from a foul ball during spring training.
- \* Spent the last two seasons with Augusta (A) ... Batted .253 with 6 HR, 37 RBI's and 15 SB in 118 games last year.
- \* Was a second baseman last year after playing primarily third base in 2016 ... Began pro career as a shortstop.
