TONIGHT: Following yesterday's league wide off-day and after going $0-6$ in their recent road trip, the Mudcats begin a brief three game home stand tonight with game one of a three game series versus the Down East Wood Ducks at Grainger Stadium in Kinston, NC. Down East recently swept the Mudcats just one week ago during a three game series in Kinston at Grainger Stadium and lead the overall season series between the two teams 11-3. The Wood Ducks have additionally won nine straight game against Carolina dating back to late May when Down East won three of four game versus the Mudcats at Five County Stadium ( $5 / 24-5 / 27$ ). Tonight's game is the first of three in the series, the seventh of 13 second half meetings and the 15th of 20 overall games between the two teams.

ICYMI: The Mudcats were off yesterday and last played on Sunday in Fayetteville where Zach Clark and Eddie Silva both had run scoring hits in the second and eighth innings, but Carolina was done in by a five run Fayetteville fifth while losing their season high sixth straight game 7-2 to the Woodpeckers on at Segra Stadium. Carolina led first in Sunday's series and road trip finale in Fayetteville as they scored a run in the second to take an early 1-0 lead. That lead held through the fourth, but the Woodpeckers went on to rally for five runs in the fifth while take a 5-1 lead. The two teams then traded runs in the eighth with the Mudcats scoring once and Fayetteville scoring twice to go up $7-2$ in the game.

OF LATE: The Mudcats are currently mired in a season high six-game losing streak and have gone $4-14$ since $7 / 10$ and since starting the second half 12-8 over the first 20 games of the second half (6/20-7/9)... The Mudcats have combined to hit just . 179 with 2.33 runs/game since $7 / 10$, but have pitched to a 2.85 ERA in that same span... The Mudcats have been shut out thee times over their last six games and four times over their 13 while falling to $6-8$ in shutouts this season. Carolina was $5-3$ in shutouts before the All-Star break.

ROAD WOES: The Mudcats are just 1-13 over their last 14 road games and just 4-14 away from home since the All-Star break... Carolina started the season 16-11 over their first eight road series, but have gone $7-18$ since. Overall Carolina is $23-29$ on the road this season.

WHERE THEY RANK: Mario Feliciano is currently tied for 1st in the CL in home runs (15), 2nd in RBI (69), 3rd in slugging (.455), 9th in hits (98), tied for 2nd in extra-base hits (37) and 2nd in total bases (168)... Ryan Aguilar is currently 4th in the CL in OPS (.798), 3rd in OBP (.401), 10th in hits (94), tied for 6th in doubles (21), 1st in walks (69) and 1st in runs (70)... Payton Henry is tied for 7th in the CL in home runs (10) and tied for 6th in RBI (58)... Matt Hardy is currently tied for 6th in the CL in wins (7) and tied for 7th in games (31)... Rodrigo Benoit is currently tied for 10th in the CL in wins (6), 2nd in games (33) and 3rd in saves (13)... J.T. Hintzen is tied for 4th in the CL in games (32)... Cody Beckman is tied for 4th in the CL in games (32)... Noah Zavolas is currently 2nd in the CL in ERA (3.07), 1st in innings pitched (123.0) and 2nd in WHIP (1.13). Zavolas is also 2nd in the CL in FIP (3.20), 2nd in xFIP (3.38), 1st in BB/9 (1.46) and 2nd in K/BB (4.50).. Matt Smith is currently 3rd in the CL in ERA (3.29), 2nd in LOB\% (77.4\%) and 6th in WHIP (1.28).

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER... Aaron Ashby: 2-5, 3.63 ERA, 8 GS, 44.2 IP, 23 BB, 34 SO, 1.25 WHIP - Last game, 7/24 at DE: L, 5.1 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 2 BB, 5 SO, 97 pitches - WIS/CAR Combined: 5-9, 3.58 ERA, 19/18 G/GS, 105.2 IP, 51 BB, 115 SO - Rated as the No. 9 prospect in the Brewers system per MLBpipeline.com.

BACK STOP SPLITS: Payton Henry and Mario Feliciano have split catching duties this season with Henry starting 54 games behind the plate and Feliciano starting 51 games at catcher... The Carolina pitching staff is $30-24$ and has totaled a 3.51 ERA ( $3.0 \mathrm{BB} / 9,8.6 \mathrm{SO} / 9$ ) in games started by and caught by Henry... Carolina's pitchers are 24-27 with a 4.21 ERA (3.1 BB/9, 7.9 SO/9) in games caught by Feliciano.

SINCE THE BREAK: Matt Smith has pitched to a stellar 1.91 ERA over seven starts since the All-Star break and is currently 6th among qualified CL starters in second half ERA... Noah Zavolas is currently 2-2 with a 2.25 ERA over seven second half starts and is currently 8th among qualified CL starters in ERA in the second half


KINGS OF THE NORTH: The Mudcats are currently 35-22 versus Carolina League Northern Division teams this season. They have also gone 17-8 versus Northern Division teams since 6/11 (at FRE)... The Mudcats are, however, just 4-22 vs. Southern Division teams since 5/24 (vs. DE, 3.5 GB of first before 5/24) and had suffered nine straight losses in games versus Southern Division teams (6/16 vs. WS - 7/3 at MB ) before defeating the Pelicans $3-2$ on $7 / 19$ in Zebulon. They are also just 20-30 overall versus their own division this season.

TRENDING: Eddie Silva has hit safely in eight of his last 10 games and is batting $.333 / .324 / .606$ with a .930 OPS with two, two-run home runs over that span (11-for-33, 3 R, 1 3B, 2 HR, 7 RBI)... Rob Henry is batting just .157/.295/. 176 (8-for-51, 24 SO ) since returning from the IL on $7 / 6$. He is also just 1 -for- 20 over his last seven games (3 BB, 13 SO)... Devin Hairston is 1 -for- 36 over his last 12 games (.028/.054/.056); he had hit .483/.531/.724 with a 1.255 OPS (14-for-29, 2 2B, 1 3B, $1 \mathrm{HR}, 5 \mathrm{RBI}, 5 \mathrm{SO}$ ) over his previous nine games between $7 / 3 \& 7 / 13$.

YOU RANG: Brice Turang has hit safely in 10 of his last 12 games and is batting $.302 / .400 / .465$ with a .865 OPS during that same span (13-for-43, 4 R, 2 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR, 2 RBI, 7 BB, 4 SB). He was just 1-for-26 with 7 BB and 6 SO over his first seven games with Carolina before the streak... The Brewers promoted Turang to the Mudcats on 7/8 from Low-A Wisconsin where he slashed .287/.384/.376 with a .760 OPS, 21 SB and 31 RBI over 82 games with the Timber Rattlers. He was selected with the 21st overall pick in the 2018 Draft, and at just 19 years old, is currently the youngest player in the CL. He is currently rated as the No. 1 prospect in the Milwaukee farm system per MLB.

STINGY PEN: The Carolina bullpen has combined to go $1-2$ with a 2.45 ERA, 1.00 WHIP and . 203 average against since 7/21... Phil Bickford has pitched through four straight scoreless outings and has held opponents to a . 136 average over that same span... Michael Petersen has pitched to a 1.59 ERA, 13.1 SO/9 and . 173 average against over his last 18 appearances and 22.2 innings pitched. Petersen has also held left-handed batters to a .148 average this season.

ALL THE Ks: Carolina batters have combined to total a Carolina League high 1,081 strikeouts this season (6th most in MiLB). The Mudcats are on pace to set a league and franchise record for strikeouts for the third straight season... Carolina batters combined to total a CL and franchise record 1,311 strikeouts last season; breaking the previous CL and franchise record of 1,245 SO set by Carolina in 2017.

AN APRIL TO REMEMBER: Carolina's 16-10 record in April was the club's best since 2008 when the then-Southern League and Florida Marlins affiliated Mudcats opened the year with a record of 17-10. Just three years earlier, the 2005 Marlins affiliated Mudcats opened the season going 18-4 in April. The 2005 and 2008 Mudcats both went on to reach the Southern League playoffs in their respective seasons... Carolina's 25 home runs hit in April were a new franchise high for most home runs hit by a Mudcats team in April since the 2004 squad hit 24 homers in the first month of their season.

FIRST QUARTER: The Mudcats went 21-14 over their first 35 games, or first quarter, of the 2019 season. That 21-14 (.600) matches the 1994 Mudcats for the fourth best first 35 -game record in team history. The 1995 and 2005 Mudcats own the franchise's best first 35 -game team record in franchise history after both clubs started their respective seasons at 24-11.

FOR THREE: Tristen Lutz's first inning triple on $5 / 3$ in Wilmington was the first for the Mudcats during the 2019 season. Lutz's triple came in club's 29th game of the season making the Mudcats the last affiliated Minor League Baseball team to record a triple in 2019 (29th game).

WALK-OFF BIG FLIES: Mario Feliciano's walk-off home run to defeat Lynchburg on $5 / 20$ was his second walk-off of the season and third overall walk-off homer of the year for the Mudcats. Feliciano also hit a walk-off, three-run blast on $5 / 11$ to defeat the Myrtle Beach Pelicans. Dallas Carroll, meanwhile, hit the first walk-off homer of this season (one month earlier) on 4/11 versus Wilmington. Carroll's walk-off earlier this year was Carolina's first since Keston Hiura hit a walk-off homer on $5 / 25 / 18$ versus Myrtle Beach. Before Hiura's walk- off big fly last year, the last walk-off home run in Mudcats history came in 2013 when Bryson Myles delivered a game-winning blast to beat the Winston-Salem Dash in the 14th inning at Five County Stadium on 7/18/13... Mario Feliciano is also the only player in recorded Mudcats history to total multiple walk-off home runs in the same season.

STREAKING: Ryan Aguilar reached base safely in a team and Carolina League best 26 straight games from $4 / 14$ through $5 / 13$. The streak came to an end when he entered an extra-innings game on $5 / 14$ in Lynchburg as a defensive replacement in the tenth and later struck out in his only at bat of the game in the eleventh. Aguilar hit .278/.420/.356 with a .775 OPS during the streak ( 25 -for-90, 18 R , 4 2B, 1 HR, 8 RBI, $19 \mathrm{BB}, 3 \mathrm{HBP}, 28 \mathrm{SO}$ ).

TO THE SHOW: 2018 Mudcat Keston Hiura was called up to the big leagues by the Brewers on $5 / 14$ and went 2 -for- 3 with a walk in his MLB debut that same day. Hiura started the 2018 season with the Mudcats and hit .320/.382/.529 with a . 911 OPS over 54 games before a 6/1/18 promotion to Double-A... After being called up, Hiura joined RHP Corbin Burnes and RHP Freddy Peralta as the three former Mudcats to debut with the Brewers since Carolina became Milwaukee's High-A affiliate in 2017... Hiura was the second former Mudcats player to receive a MLB promotion this season as 2016 Mudcat INF Dylan Moore made his MLB debut with Seattle on 3/28/19 in Japan versus Oakland. Additionally, 2017 Mudcats RHP Jordan Yamamoto made his MLB debut on $6 / 12$ vs. STL for the Miami Marlins.

BIG LEAGUE CAMP: Devin Hairston played in 13 MLB Spring Training games for the Brewers in 2019 (2-for-8, 3 R, 2B, 3 RBI, 2 BB, 6 SO). Hairston also traveled with Milwaukee to Montreal for an exhibition game versus Toronto on $3 / 25$ and scored a run... Tristen Lutz played in 17 MLB Spring Training games (1-for-18, 4 R, 3 BB, 10 SO )... Rodrigo Benoit appeared in five MLB Spring Training games (5 G, 3.2 IP, 8 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 1 HR, 4 SO)... Matt Hardy appeared in one MLB Spring Training game and earned a victory on $3 / 24 \mathrm{vs}$. ARI ( $1-0,0.2 \mathrm{IP}, 1 \mathrm{BB}$ )... Additional MLB Spring Training appearances: Mario Feliciano (2 G, 0-for-4, R, RBI, BB, SO), Payton Henry ( 11 G, 1-for-12, R, 2B, RBI, BB, 3 SO), Ryan Aguilar (1 G, 1 PA, 1 HBP), Julio Garcia (1 G, 0-for-1), Zach Clark (1 G, 0-for-2, 2 SO), Rob Henry (2 G, 0 -for-1, SO), Joantgel Segovia (1 G, 1-for-1, R).

PLAYOFF DROUGHT: The Mudcats failed to reach the playoffs again in 2018, stretching their current playoff drought to seven (7) consecutive Carolina League seasons. Carolina has additionally failed to reach the playoffs in 10 consecutive seasons overall between their time in the Carolina League (2012-Present) and Southern League (1991-2011). The Mudcats last reached the playoffs in 2008 when they lost to the Mississippi Braves in the Southern League Championship Series... Current post-season droughts in MiLB (full-season teams): Buffalo (AAA)/Delmarva (A-): 13 seasons, New Orleans (AAA): 11 seasons, lowa (AAA): 10 seasons, Hartford (AA): 9 seasons, Louisville (AAA): 8 seasons
