**Last Game:** The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (0-1, 30-41) fell to the Jackson Generals (1-0, 38-33) by a 5-2 score in the first game of the five-game series at The Ballpark at Jackson on Thursday night. Jackson starter Brad Keller (4-5) earned the victory, turning in six scoreless innings where he scattered five hits with a walk and three strikeouts. Jacksonville starter Joe Gunkel (1-4) took the loss, allowing four runs on eight hits with two walks and five strikeouts. Jackson reliever Gabriel Moya earned his tenth save of the season by working a scoreless ninth inning. The Generals took the lead with a three-run bottom of the third. Kevin Cron and Victor Reyes both had RBI singles to grow the lead to 2-0, before a double steal saw Dawel Lugo steal home as Reyes stole second to put the lead at 3-0. Jackson added to the lead in the fourth inning. Evan Marzilli started the frame with a triple, and with two outs Colin Walsh brought him home on an RBI single to grow the lead to 4-0. After being blanked by Keller for the first six innings, the Jumbo Shrimp struck against the Generals bullpen in the seventh inning. Lefty Jackson reliever Gabe Spier allowed hits to the first two Jacksonville batters, including Alex Yarbrough who hit an RBI single to score Alex Glenn to put the score at 4-1. Later in the inning Austin Nola delivered an RBI single to cut Jackson's lead to 4-2. Generals reliever Jared Miller forced Brian Anderson to ground out to third base to end the inning, stranding Yefri Perez and Nola in scoring position to end the inning. The tarp was then put on the field in the middle of the seventh, and after an hour-long delay the Shrimp and Generals resumed play at 9:10 p.m. local time. Jackson added its final run in the bottom of the eighth, with Stewart Ijames hitting a solo homer to right off Jacksonville reliever Esmerling De La Rosa to put the score at 5-2, which would be the final. Moya did allow a double to Chris Diaz in the ninth but got the final outs to preserve the three-run Generals win. Diaz, Nola, and Glenn all had multi-hit games for the Jumbo Shrimp.

## NEWS AND NOTES

**Kickham Looks to Continue June Success:** Tonight's Jacksonville starting pitcher Mike Kickham has enjoyed a strong month of June. In his three starts, Kickham is 3-0 with a 0.47 ERA, allowing only one run over his past 19 innings of work. Kickham's last 12 innings entering tonight have been scoreless. Kickham overall this season is 4-3 with a 2.26 ERA in his 12 starts, and was named a Southern League Midseason All-Star. Kickham's 2.26 ERA is the fourth best in the Southern League, he has the second lowest WHIP in the league at 0.92, fifth lowest batting average against at .216, lowest walk per nine inning ratio at 1.15, and the second fewest baserunners per nine innings at 8.66. His last time against the Jackson Generals was dominant on May 27, when he matched a career high with 12 strikeouts, and at one point struck out six Generals in a row, two shy of matching a Southern League record.

**Jumbo Hits:** Jacksonville catcher Austin Nola carries a seven game hitting streak into tonight's game. Over his streak, Nola is hitting .458 (11-for-24) with eight runs batted in, three doubles, and four walks drawn. Nola has enjoyed a resurgence in June, hitting .378 in this month with 10 RBI, that's compared to a .158 average in April, and .281 in May. Last night John Norwood hit his 10<sup>th</sup> homer of the season, and had his first three RBI game of the season. Jacksonville last night recorded 14 hits, tying a season-high for hits in a game, and all but one of the starting eight position players had at least one hit in the game, even Jacksonville's starting pitcher Trevor Richards singled in his first pro at-bat.

**Four Shrimp South Division All-Stars:** The Southern League announced that four Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp have been named to the league's South Division All-Star roster for the 2017 Southern League All-Star Game. Pitchers Mike Kickham and Matt Tomshaw, along with infielder Brian Anderson, and outfielder John Norwood represented Jacksonville as South Division All-Stars in Pensacola on Tuesday, despite the game not being played due to rain.

# TONIGHT'S JUMBO SHRIMP STARTING PITCHER

**LAST START:** Kickham worked his second straight scoreless start in a winning effort against Pensacola in Game Two of a Doubleheader on Friday June 16 at the Baseball Grounds. Kickham worked five scoreless innings allowing just four hits with a walk and two strikeouts. Jacksonville won 1-0, thanks to a Brian Anderson RBI triple.

**BISCUITS START:** Kickham was dominant in a complete game shutout against the Montgomery Biscuits in Game Two of Jacksonville's doubleheader against them on Thursday June 8 at the Baseball Grounds. Kickham went all seven innings in scoreless fashion, scattering four hits with no walks and three strikeouts as the Jumbo Shrimp won 1-0 thanks to a first inning solo homer by Brian Anderson.

**FIRST GENERALS START:** Kickham shined in his no decision against the Jackson Generals at the Baseball Grounds on Saturday May 27. Kickham worked six and two-thirds scoreless innings where he scattered three hits with a walk and he matched a career-high with 12 strikeouts. Kickham at one point struck out six Generals in a row, two shy of the Southern League record. Jackson would win the game 4-2, however Kickham was named Southern League pitcher of the Week for his strong start.

**2017 SOUTHERN LEAGUE ALL-STAR:** Kickham was named to the Southern League South Division All-Star roster. Kickham is an All-Star along with fellow left-handed pitcher Matt Tomshaw, and third baseman Brian Anderson, and outfielder John Norwood.

**BIG LEAGUE TIME:** Kickham pitched in the major leagues with the San Francisco Giants in 2013 and 2014. He made his big league debut on May 28, 2013 in Oakland against the Athletics, where he allowed four runs on four hits in his two and a third innings of work, taking the loss in the game. He had more call-ups to the big leagues in June, July, August, and then finished September in a Giants uniform. All together, in 2013 he was 0-3 with a 10.16 ERA in his 12 appearances and three starts. In 2014 he was a September call-up to the Giants, and had no wins or losses and a 22.50 ERA in two relief appearances for a club that went on to win the World Series. In parts of two big league seasons, Kickham is 0-3 with a 10.98 ERA in 14 games and three starts.

**#34 MIKE KICKHAM RHP | 6-4, 220 lbs | Born: St. Louis, Mo. Age: 28**

Signed by the Marlins as a minor league free agent in the offseason (date not given).

**2016 Highlights:** Kickham's time in affiliated baseball last season was spent with the Double-A Richmond Flying Squirrels in the Eastern League. There he went 0-1 with a 6.75 ERA in six relief appearances before he was released by the Giants on May 20, 2016. Kickham spent time in independent baseball last year with the Kansas City T-Bones in the American Association. There he went 3-5 with a 2.83 ERA in 14 starts to close out the season.

**2015 Highlights:** Kickham split the 2015 season between the Seattle Mariners and Texas Rangers organizations, pitching exclusively in the Triple-A Pacific Coast League. He started the year with Triple-A Tacoma, where he was 0-2 with a 7.29 ERA in five starts before he was designated for assignment by the Mariners on May 4. He then was claimed off waivers by the Texas Rangers a day later, and then pitched for Triple-A Round Rock where he was 1-0 with a 6.00 ERA in seven relief appearances before he was released on June 11.

**2014 Highlights:** Kickham spent most of 2014 with Triple-A Fresno where he was 8-8 with a 4.43 ERA in 27 starts in the Pacific Coast League. In 2014 he was a September call-up to the Giants, and had no wins or losses and a 22.50 ERA in two relief appearances for a club that went on to win the World Series

**2013 Highlights:** Kickham split the 2013 season between Triple-A Fresno and the major leagues with the Giants. With Fresno he was 7-7 with a 4.31 ERA in 20 starts. He made his big league debut on May 28, 2013 in Oakland against the Athletics, where he allowed four runs on four hits in his two and a third innings of work, taking the loss in the game. He had more call-ups to the big leagues in June, July, August, and then finished September in a Giants uniform. All together, in 2013 he was 0-3 with a 10.16 ERA in his 12 appearances and three starts.

**2012 Highlights:** Kickham spent all of 2012 in Double-A with the Richmond Flying Squirrels in the Eastern League. There he was 11-10 with a 3.05 ERA in 28 appearances and 27 starts.

**2011 Highlights:** Kickham spent all of 2011 with the Single-A Augusta Greenjackets in the South Atlantic League. There he was 5-10 with a 4.11 ERA in 21 starts.

**2010 Highlights:** After he was drafted by the Giants, he made three relief appearances with the AZL Giants where he had no wins or losses and an 11.57 ERA.

**Personal:** Originally selected by the Giants in the sixth round of the 2010 draft out of Missouri State. Kickham played for Missouri State in 2010. He struck out 103 batters in 96.0 innings and won MSU's Dave Dickensheet Outstanding Pitcher Award.
