**Yesterday's Game:** The River Cats dropped their fifth consecutive game last night in a 10-1 loss against the El Paso Chihuahuas. Sacramento stayed in the game early after **RHP Jeff Samardzija**, making his second rehab start with the River Cats, struck out seven batters and walked none while allowing two runs over four innings of work. The game quickly unraveled in the fifth inning as the Chihuahuas put up five runs in a tough outing from **RHP Jose Valdez**. **INF Chase d'Aranud** was a bright spot in a rough game for Sacramento, racking up his 14th multi-hit game of the season, including the River Cats only RBI of the night when he smacked a single scoring **INF Josh Rutledge** in the fifth inning.

**Today's Starter:** **LHP Matt Gage** makes his eighth start of the season tonight after earning the win in his last appearance against Round Rock on June 15. Gage came out of the bullpen and threw 4.2 innings of shutout baseball. He allowed just two hits and struck out one batter in his outing, coming in for Samardzija after his first rehab appearance. The win was Gage's first since May 6 against Fresno before losing his next five consecutive starts. Gage's wins and losses have come in streaks as he won his first two starts and lost his next five. Gage looks to win his second consecutive start tonight.

**Streaking:** The River Cats have lost five consecutive games, the first time they have lost five straight since April of last season when they lost eight consecutive games from April 15-22. On the topic of streaks, **INF Ryder Jones** had his season-long hit streak come to and end after going 0-for-3 with two strikeouts last night. During that span, Jones batted 3.61 with a triple and two home runs.

**Cueto's Coming:** **RHP Johnny Cueto** is expected to begin his rehab assignment with Sacramento tomorrow, June 23. Cueto has been on the disabled list since late April with a sprained right elbow. Cueto will be making his third appearance at Raley Field, most recently a rehab start he made last season while rehabbing a right forearm injury.

**Black Stays at 100:** **RHP Ray Black** continues to light up the radar gun after hitting 100 MPH on six of his 15 total pitches thrown. Black threw a scoreless eighth inning and struck out two batters last night.

**This Day in River Cats History:** June 22, 2005: Behind two home runs by **OF Matt Watson**, the River Cats trounced the Tacoma Rainiers by the score of 14-3. Watson finished the game 2-for-4 with the two big flies, a walk, and five RBIs while leadoff hitter **INF Freddie Bynum** drove in three runs and finished the day 2-for-5 with a double and 2 runs scored. **INF Andrew Beattie** went 2-for-5 with a run scored and 3 RBIs as Sacramento's 1-5 hitters combined for 13 of the 14 runs driven in. **RHP Mike Saipe** picked up the win after 4 innings of scoreless relief.

## ADVANCED HITTING STATS GLOSSARY\*

### PA: Plate Appearances

Plate Appearances are the total number of times a hitter completes a turn batting.

### OPS: On-Base Plus Slugging

On-base Plus Slugging (OPS) is the sum of a player's on-base percentage (how often a player reaches base safely) and their slugging percentage (how many bases a player reaches per at bat).

### ISO: Isolated Power

Isolated Power (ISO) is a measure of a hitter's raw power. Or, to look at it another way, it measures how good a player is at hitting for extra bases. The simplest way to calculate ISO is to subtract a player's Batting Average from their Slugging Percentage, which leaves us with a measure of just a player's extra bases per at bat.

### BABIP: Batting Average on Balls In Play

Batting Average on Balls In Play (BABIP) measures how many of a batter's balls in play go for hits. Affected greatly by defense and luck, BABIP can dramatically affect a hitter's batting average. If a large number of a batter's balls in play go for hits, that can boost their batting average quite high. Similarly, if a large number of balls in play get caught, it can reduce a player's total offensive value.

### wRC+: Weighted Runs Created Plus

Weighted Runs Created Plus measures the total number of runs a player contributes to their team. The formula accounts for a player's ability to get on base, their total number of bases, and their baserunning. The Plus version of the stat is park and league adjusted.

### wOBA: Weighted On-Base Average

Weighted On-Base Average combines all the different aspects of hitting into one metric, weighting each of them in proportion to their actual run value. While batting average, on-base percentage, and slugging percentage fall short in accuracy and scope, wOBA measures and captures offensive value more accurately and comprehensively. (Due to no constant in minor league baseball, the wOBA statistic is approximate).

### K% & BB%: Strikeout Rate and Walk Rate

Strikeout rate (K%) and walk rate (BB%) measure how often a position player walks or strikes out per plate appearance. They're measured in percentage form, so it's easy to compare between players and years.

## ADVANCED PITCHING STATS GLOSSARY\*

### TBF: Total Batters Faced

Total Batters Faced measures the total number of plate appearances hitters have made against him.

### AVG: Batting Average

Batting average is the rate of hits per at bat, calculated as hits/at bats.

### BABIP: Batting Average on Balls In Play

Batting Average on Balls In Play (BABIP) measures how often a ball in play goes for a hit. Typically around 30% of all balls in play fall for hits, but there are several variables that can affect BABIP rates for individual players, such as defense, luck, and talent level. Hitters have more control over their BABIP than pitchers do.

### LOB%: Left On Base Percentage

Left on Base Percentage (LOB%) measures the percentage of base runners that a pitcher strands on base over the course of a season. This stat does not use the left on base numbers reported in box scores, but instead is calculated using a pitcher's actual hits, walks, and runs allowed results.

### FIP: Fielding Independent Pitching

Fielding Independent Pitching (FIP) measures what a player's ERA should have looked like over a given time period, assuming that performance on balls in play and timing were league average. (Due to no constant in minor league baseball, the FIP statistic is approximate).

### K% & BB%: Strikeout Rate and Walk Rate

Strikeout rate (K%) and walk rate (BB%) measure how often a pitcher walks or strikes out a player per plate appearance. They're measured in percentage form, so it's easy to compare between players and years.

### xFIP: Expected Fielding Independent Pitching
