SNAPPER SNIPPETS

FACING THE EAST: Beloit will wrap up a stretch of 12 consecutive games against Eastern Division opponents when they face Fort Wayne this weekend. The Snappers are now 4-6 through the first 10 games of this stretch. Dayton & Bowling Green each took 2 of 3 against the Snappers at Pohlman Field while Beloit won their first road series of the season at Lake County to start their 6-game roadtrip. The Western Division is a combined 40-49 against the Eastern Division during the first half's swing of inter-division play after the East won 7 of 8 Midwest League games on Thursday.

UNCHARACTERISTIC NIGHT: Beloit's pitching staff had their roughest night of the season on Thursday. The TinCaps are the first team to score double-digits against the Snappers this season. The 8-run loss & 8 walks allowed tied season highs in each category.

SHELL SHOCKED: The TinCaps became just the 2nd team to hit more than 1 home run in a game against Beloit with a pair on Thursday. The last time the Snappers allowed 2 homers in a game was on April 8, the third game of the season. The Snappers allowed only 5 home runs through the first 24 games of the season, which were the fewest in Minor League Baseball at the time. Since then, Beloit pitchers have surrendered 7 homers over their last 8 games.

DOWN EARLY: Beloit's opponents have scored more runs in the first inning than any other inning this season. Through 32 games, the Snappers have allowed a first inning run in 15 games, but they are 8-7 when opponents put up a run in the first.

TWO IS BETTER THAN ONE: The Snappers 42 double plays are 2nd-most among all of Minor League Baseball teams behind the 44 twin killers tuned by the Midland RockHounds, the Athletics Double-A affiliate. Beloit has turned at least 1 double play in 17 of their last 21 games, but 0 in their last 2 contests.

TRIP TIDBITS: The current 6-game roadtrip is the longest the Snappers will be away from home during the first half. Due to an off-day on June 5, the Snappers will return to Beloit from Appleton before moving on to Burlington after their day off. The Snappers have not won back-to-back games on the road this season and have not won consecutive games since April 26-27, the last 2 of a 6-game winning streak.

HELPFUL TO GET A HANDFUL: The Snappers are 12-1 when scoring 5 runs or more after bringing home 9 runs on Wednesday. After allowing 10 runs Thursday, Beloit is just 4-9 when they give up 5 runs or more. The Snappers have played in 5 games where both teams scored 5 runs. Beloit is 4-1 in games the Snappers & their opponents each bring home 5 runs.

TODAY'S PITCHERS: Today's tandem will be **Matt Milburn & Dakota Chalmers**. Over Milburn's last 2 starts, he has tossed 4.0 IP apiece & has an ERA of 1.13. Chalmers carries an 8-inning scoreless streak. He has been splendid pitching as the piggy-backer this season. He has a 2.45 ERA with a 19-to-2 strikeout to walk ratio over 11 innings that was highlighted by a career-best 10 K's in 4 innings on April 17 at Kane County, all in relief. Chalmers' 5 wild pitches are team high & his 18 walks are 2nd-most in the Midwest League behind **Brady Aiken** of Lake County.

FACING THE TINCAPS: The Snappers will get their first look at Parkview Field since July 23-25, 2014 over the weekend. All time at Parkview Field, Beloit is 7-6 going back to when the ballpark opened its doors in 2009. Last season in Beloit, Fort Wayne & the Snappers met in July to see the first game get rained out. Fort Wayne won the opener & then Beloit swept the doubleheader to complete the series including a 2-1 win where **Brendan Butler** out-dueled Padres top prospect **Anderson Espinoza** in his Snappers debut. On their 2017 roster, the TinCaps carry 5 of the Padres top-30 prospects according to MLB.com. Those position players are **Fernando Tatis Jr.** (#6), **Jorge Ona** (#7), **Hudson Potts** (#12), & **Eguy Rosario** (#30) in addition to pitcher **Logan Allen** (#17).
