ERA IN WINS/LOSSES: Vermont pitchers have a 2.18 ERA (15 ER-62 IP) in Lake Monsters 6 wins, but a 6.38 ERA (34 ER-48 IP) in 6 losses ... Vermont offense 49 runs in 7 wins and just 13 runs in 6 losses.
