BRINGIN' HOME THE "W": A pair of home runs and another dominating bullpen performance Tuesday night sent Corpus Christi to a series victory over San Antonio, a 5-3 decision in the finale at Whataburger Field. Trailing 3-2 in the fifth, 2B Jack Mayfield bounced a one-out single thru the left side against RHP Bryce Morrow. Following a groundout, SS Alex Bregman lifted a two-run shot onto the left-field berm, putting the Hooks ahead 4-3. CF Derek Fisher opened the eighth by belting an 0-2 pitch from LHP Brandon Alger off centerfield wall. Fisher raced around the bases for an inside-the-park home run and a 5-3 Corpus Christi edge.

RHP Francis Martes earned the victory, holding the Missions to three runs on six hits and two walks in five-plus innings. Nick Torres' two-out, two-run poke in the third was a key swing against him. LHP Chris Cotton permitted just two baserunners (walk, single) over 2 1/3 frames of relief. RHP Brendan McCurry worked around a double and a free pass in the eighth, and authored a perfect ninth en route to picking up his fourth save.

GUDUAN TO GRIZZLIES: The Astros promoted LHP Reymin Guduan to Triple-A Fresno and assigned RHP Angel Heredia to Corpus Christi from High-A Lancaster. Guduan went 1-0 with a 0.69 ERA and 2 saves in 9 outings for the Hooks this year. The flame-throwing lefty struck out 19 against 3 walks in 13.0 IP. The only blemish was a solo homer by Midland's Matt Chapman on April 28. Guduan retired 25 of 27 men leading up to his PCL promotion.

Heredia has made 10 appearances for the JetHawks, going 0-3 with a 6.57 ERA and 1 save in 3 chances. The 23 year-old owns 17 strikeouts and 11 walks in 12 1/3 frames this season, holding the competition to a .265 average and 2 home runs. Heredia went 4-3 with a 2.56 ERA in 27 assignments for Quad Cities last season. His campaign began at the end of May with the River Bandits and finished the year by leading the club in saves, converting 13 of 15 opportunities. This total also ranked 2nd in the Astros system. Heredia averaged 9.7 strikeouts per 9 innings, striking out 47 against 21 walks in 45 2/3 innings. He pitched scoreless ball in 11 of his first 12 appearances, going 3-1 and 4-for-4 in save chances while limiting Midwest League hitters to a .107 average during this stretch. Heredia hails from Sabana Grande de Palenque in the Dominican Republic. He was signed by Houston as a non-drafted free agent in April 2012 at the age of 18.

YESTERDAY'S NEWS: IF Jack Mayfield earned a promotion to Triple-A Fresno while C Trent Woodward and IF Chan-Jong Moon were assigned to the Hooks from short-season Tri-City. 1B Conrad Gregor was also placed on the inactive list. Mayfield was hitting .222 with 3 doubles, 4 home runs and 12 RBIs in 24 games for Corpus Christi. The Del Rio native did not appear for the Grizzlies in their 7-6 win over Tacoma yesterday afternoon.

I WAS RUNNING: In the 8th inning Tuesday night, OF Derek Fisher delivered the first inside-the-park-home run in the 12-history of Whataburger Field. Fisher joins Tommy Manzella (5/18/08 at MID), Drew Locke (8/16/12 at ARK) and Leo Heras (4/29/15 at MID) as Hooks who have circled the bases the old-fashioned way. Fisher is 5-for-10 with 3 runs, 1 double, 2 homers and 3 RBIs in his last 3 games.

SLAMMING THE DOOR: The Hooks, who have won 7 of their last 10 games, are receiving lights-out performances from the bullpen. In the last 5 games, Corpus Christi relievers have allowed just 2 earned runs. During this stretch, the pen has struck out 25 batters against 13 hits and 5 walks in 19.0 innings.

OSO BLANCO ATTACK: C Evan Gattis is 4-for-15 (.267) with a double, home run and 2 RBIs in 4 games during this current stint with the Hooks. He has also gone 1-for-2 in the caught-stealing department in 16 innings behind the plate. The Astros optioned Gattis to Corpus Christi on Saturday to get reps as a catcher. Gattis, who did not catch last year, worked 93 games as catcher in 2014, and in 42 games in 2013, his rookie season. The 29-year-old slugger is batting .203 with 4 doubles, 1 home run and 7 RBIs in 20 games for Houston. Gattis opened the year on a rehab assignment with Corpus Christi, hitting .400 with 1 double, 2 home runs and 4 RBIs in 4 contests. He was placed on the 15-day Disabled List April 1 (backdated to March 25) due to sports hernia surgery.

Gattis hit .246 with 20 doubles, 11 triples, 27 home runs and 88 RBIs in 153 games for the Astros last year. In his first season with the club, the Forney, TX, native led Houston in homers and RBIs. Gattis set single-season career highs in most offensive categories, including runs (66), hits (139) and multi-hit games (40). He became the 9th player since 2000 to reach the 20-homer plateau in each of his first 3 big league campaigns. Gattis was acquired by Houston from Atlanta prior to 2015 Spring Training in the deal which sent RHP Mike Foltynewicz, RHP Andrew Thurman and IF Rio Ruiz to the Braves.
