TODAY: The Mudcats begin their final home stand of the season tonight with game one of a four game series versus the Down East Wood Ducks at Five County Stadium in Zebulon, NC. Tonight's game is the 20th of 23 total between the two teams this season. The Wood Ducks finished the season 8-1 versus Carolina at Grainger Stadium and currently lead the season series 11-8. The Mudcats are $7-3$ versus the Wood Ducks at home this season.

ICYMI: Frederick's Randolph Gassaway hit a three-run home run in the fourth while leading the Keys back from an early deficit and to a series clinching 6-4 victory versus the Mudcats at Nymeo Field on Sunday afternoon. Carolina ended up losing two of three in the series and finished 1-2 in the road trip.

THE REMAINDER: The Mudcats have 8 games remaining this season including four versus Down East at Five County Stadium and four games (two home, two away) versus Buies Creek.

WHERE THEY RANK: OF Cooper Hummel currently leads the Carolina League in OBP (.386) and is tied for 6th in base on balls (54)... RHP Luke Barker leads the Carolina League in saves (18) and games finished (35). Barker is also 2nd in games (43), 5th among CL relievers in lowest batting average (.214), 1st in fewest baserunners/9ip (9.00), 5th in highest strikeouts/9ip (9.00) and 4th in lowest BB/9ip ratio (2.02)... INF Dallas Carroll is currently 1st in the CL in games played (127), 2nd in at bats (484), tied for 4th in most walks (59) and 2nd in most double plays grounded into (16)... INF/OF Ryan Aguilar is tied for 1st in the CL in triples (9), tied for 3rd in most base on balls (60) and is 3rd in most strikeouts (128).

WALK IT OFF: Six (6) of Carolina's last seven (7) home wins have come in walk-off fashion ( $7 / 19,7 / 24,7 / 25,8 / 4,8 / 8,8 / 17$ ). Those six (6) walk-off wins have additionally occurred over Carolina's last 16 home games. Overall, Carolina has totaled 11 walk-off wins this season.

LATE LOSSES: Carolina has a CL high 16 losses when leading after 6 innings this season. They have also totaled a league worst 12 losses when leading after 7 innings. The Mudcats are the only CL team with more than 7 losses when leading after the 6th and more than 6 losses when leading after the 7 th inning.

TRENDING: INF/OF Ryan Aguilar is batting .296/.419/.563 with a 982 OPS over his last 21 games ( $21 \mathrm{H}, 11$ R, 6 2B, 2 3B, 3 HR, 10 RBI, 15 BB, 276 SO)... OF Demi Orimoloye has hit safely in six straight and is batting .320/.414/.680 (8-for-25, 1 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 7 RBI) with a 1.094 OPS during the streak... RHP Victor Diaz owns a 0.83 ERA over his last three games (all in relief) and 11.0 innings pitched ( $4 \mathrm{H}, 1 \mathrm{ER}, 2 \mathrm{BB}, 8 \mathrm{SO}$ ).

THREE PLUS: The Mudcats have averaged a Carolina League high 3:01 (h:mm) per nine-inning game this season.

HUMMEL'S HALF: Cooper Hummel currently owns a Carolina League best . 435 OBP in the second half. Hummel's second half (.297/.435/.483, . 917 OPS [2nd in CL since 6/21], 53 G ) has also catapulted him into the overall CL lead in on-base (.386 OBP) this season. Hummel is additionally hitting $.309 / .452 / .483$ with a .935 OPS ( 46 G, $46 \mathrm{H}, 26$ R, 17 2B, 3 HR, 20 RBI) and a CL best 17 doubles since replacing an injured Tucker Neuhaus in the fourth inning of a home game versus the Keys on 7/6. Hummel ended up going 1-for-2 with a 2 -run home run (eventual game winner in the seventh) in that same game and has not missed a start since.

DOWN WITH OBP: Cooper Hummel currently leads the Carolina League in on-base (.386) and is looking to become the first Mudcats player to finish a season as the league leader in on-base since Jeremy Hermida led the Southern League with a (franchise record) . 457 OBP in 2005. Former Mudcats to lead the Carolina or Southern League in OBP: Jeremy Hermida (.457, 2005), Josh Willingham (.449, 2004), Todd Sears (.434, 2000), Jason Kendall (.414, 1995).

HITS AND Ks: The Carolina offense has totaled 244 more strikeouts than hits ( $1,232 \mathrm{SO}, 988 \mathrm{H}$ ) so far this season. Carolina's difference in strikeouts over hits is currently the 6th largest in MiLB. Since 1991, only the 2017 and 2007 Mudcats have finished a season with more strikeouts than hits. Carolina totaled 164 more strikeouts than hits in 2017 (1,245 SO [franchise record], 1,081 H) and 70 more strikeouts than hits in $2007(1,219 \mathrm{SO}, 1,149 \mathrm{H})$.

RECORD SETTING: Carolina batters have combined to total a CL high 1,232 strikeouts this season and are on pace for 1,308 strikeouts this season. The Carolina offense struck out a CL and franchise record 1,245 times last season... The Mudcats hit into a franchise record six (6) double plays $8 / 10$ in Salem (Dallas Carroll: 5-4-3; Devin Hairston [3]: 6-4-3, 5-4-3, 5-4-3; Trever Morrison: $3 u-3-6$; Rob Henry 6-4-3)... The Mudcats pitchers set a franchise record for strikeouts in a nine inning game after totaling 19 strikeouts on $5 / 31$ in Lynchburg (Marcos Diplan: 10 SO, Chase Williams: 3 SO, Phil Bickford: 3 SO, Luke Barker: 3 SO).

. Averaged the 2nd fewest runs per game in the CL (3.86). Totaled the 2nd fewest runs (502) in the CL this season. Allowed the 6th fewest runs (556) in the CL this season. Totaled the worst K\% (offense) in the CL this season (25.7\%). Totaled a CL high 16 losses when leading after 6 innings. Totaled a CL high 12 losses when leading after 7 innings. Have totaled 11 walk-off wins this season.
Won a CL high 10 extra-innings games this season. Gone 24-24 (.500) vs. the CL Northern Division. Made 97 total roster transactions this season. Not made the playoffs since the 2008 season. Not made the playoffs during their Carolina League era. Been in Zebulon, NC since 1991 (28th season). Been in the Carolina League since 2012 (7th season).

## 2018 NOTES

LAST OUTING: Christian Taugner last pitched on August 22 at Jim Perry Stadium against the Astros and took the loss after allowing seven runs on seven hits over 2.2 innings pitched. The Mudcats gave him an early $5-1$ lead to work with after scoring five runs over the first two innings. Taugner went on to lose that lead in the third when and reliever Alec Kenilvort combined to allowed nine Buies Creek runs. Taugner faced eight of the 12 batters appearing for Buies Creek in the third and took the loss. In all, Taugner walked one, struck out three and allowed three home runs (including two HRs to J.J. Matijevic) his last time out.

AS A T-RAT: Christian Taugner was promoted to the Mudcats from the Low-A Wisconsin Timber Rattlers on $8 / 8$ and was 10th in the Midwest League in earned run average (3.49) before the move. He was additionally $2 n d$ in the Midwest League in innings (123.2), 1st in lowest BB\% (3.7\%), 2nd in K/BB (4.74) and 2nd in GB/FB (1.53) before joining Carolina.
