PITCHING MATCH-UP

LH Cam Vieaux (1-0, 1.35) vs. RH Blake Taylor (0-4, 4.22)

Vieaux: Earned first Power win in 5.0 IP on 5/7 vs. LEX allowing 1 ER, 3 BB, 4 K (9-3 WVP)

Taylor: Took ND in 6.0 IP @ LWD 5/14 allowing 2 ER, 1 BB, striking out five (5-3 BlueClaws)

LEADING OFF: The Power dropped game one of the four-game set last night in ten innings 3-2. Trailing 1-0 after the first, West Virginia finally responded late in the eighth. RBI singles from Hunter Owen and Albert Baur saw the Power take a 2-1 lead with six outs to go. West Virginia could not seal the victory after allowing Columbia to tie the game in the ninth and walk off on a wild pitch in the tenth. The walk off loss was the first one the Power have seen this season and are now 2-7 at Spirit Communications Park in two years.

SO FRESH, SO CLEAN: Spirit Communications Park opened for the 2016 season and is in just its second year of existence. The Power went 2-6 in this ballpark in 2016, playing their first ever game here on June 9, an 11-2 loss.

GIMME GIMME MORE: This season, the Power are 15-3 when scoring five or more runs in a game, good for a .833 winning percentage. West Virginia is 3-18 when scoring less than five runs.

ROOM WITH A VIEAUX: Cam Vieaux is slated to be activated off the disabled list to make tonight's start with a corresponding move to be determined. The left-hander is the South Atlantic League ERA leader with a 1.35 mark. Vieaux has slowly made his case as the best starter in the Power rotation this season. He has yet to allow more than a single earned run in an outing this year. The last time he surrendered more than one run was back on August 12, 2016 as a member of the West Virginia Black Bears (five earned against the Brooklyn Cyclones). In 20 career starts, Vieaux has allowed three earned runs or less in 19 of them and two earned runs or less 16 times.

ACE BATTLE: Columbia starter Merandy Gonzalez and Fireflies teammate Jordan Humphreys (Monday night starter) are battling for the title of 'Columbia Ace'. The teammates have essentially matched records, 5-1 and 6-1 respectively, and ERAs, 1.59 and 1.81 respectively.

IT'S THAT TIME: This series will be the only time West Virginia will face the 2007 Heisman winner Tim Tebow. The baseball newcomer has been much better at home, batting .277 in his friendly confines compared to .146 away from home. Tebow went hitless (0-10) in his last series against Lakewood and is hitless thus far 0-3. He has not homered since April 9, his third game of the season. Tebow has struck out in eight consecutive games dating back to May 6 and in 22 of 31 professional games.

THE LONG ROAD CONTINUES: Starting yesterday, West Virginia plays 14 of their next 18 games on the road. The Power started a seven-game swing to Columbia and Augusta on Thursday, return home for four on May 25 and then travel to Charleston and Rome beginning on Memorial Day. West Virginia is 9-5 on the road this season after last night's extra innings loss.

POWER POINTS: **Albert Baur** went 7-15 with a pair of doubles and a homer this past series against the RiverDogs. He went 1-5 with an RBI in Thursday's opener... **Brent Gibbs** homered in his first Power at bat in Sunday's win. It was his first career long ball in his 20th career game. He picked up two hits and a run in the Charleston finale on Tuesday... **Adrian Valerio** garnered his first Power hit with a double on Monday. He scored the game-tying run on Thursday night after walking in the eighth...

AROUND THE ORGANIZATION: Pittsburgh defeated Washington 10-4. Adam Frazier drove in four on a 3-5 day... Indianapolis defeated Columbus 4-2 on the road. Austin Meadows went 1-5 with a home run... Altoona surrendered a lead and lost 8-5 to Binghamton. Edwin Espinal and Jordan Luplow both hit homers in the loss... Bradenton held off Daytona on the road 5-3. Ke'Bryan Hayes had a multi-hit affair (2-3) and also drove in a run. Logan Ratledge doubled and scored in the win.

PROMO WATCH: The Power return to Appalachian Power Park on May 25 for Thirsty Thursday. Friday the 26th is Military Appreciation Night and WQBE Rabbit Bobblehead night. Saturday, May 27, is Redneck Night with a Country Swag Hat giveaway. Adairs Run will perform a post-game concert.
