Giants Continue Series In Stockton... The San Jose Giants play the third game of a four-game series against the Stockton Ports this evening at Banner Island Ballpark. The teams have split the first two games of the series with San Jose earning a 5-4 victory on Monday before a 15-5 Stockton win yesterday. Tonight is the 21st meeting of the season between the Giants and Ports. San Jose is 9-11 versus Stockton this year, including a 4-5 mark at Banner Island Ballpark. After this series, the teams will next meet August 10-12 in Stockton.

Last Night... The 15 runs and five home runs allowed by the Giants yesterday were both season-high totals.

Lost 9 Of 10... The Giants enter tonight's contest having lost nine out of their last 10 games. During the 10-game stretch, San Jose is batting .207 as a team, averaging 3.7 runs per game and has struck out 111 times (11.1 per game). The Giants pitching staff owns a 7.29 ERA, has walked 51 batters in 87 2/3 innings and has allowed 16 home runs (.308 opponents AVG). San Jose has been outscored by an 81-37 margin (-44 run differential) during the 10-game stretch having allowed 14 runs twice and 15 runs once. The Giants lost a season-high eight straight games from July 1-8 – their longest losing streak since dropping eight straight from July 1-8.

Inside The Record... The Giants are off to a 6-14 start in the second half. San Jose is 1-8 versus Rancho Cucamonga this half and 5-6 against all other opponents. The Giants won their 30th game of the season on June 1 (30-25), but have gone just 10-25 (.286) since. San Jose is also just 3-14 in their last 17 home games after starting the season with a 17-10 record at Municipal Stadium.

Power Surge... After going deep two more times last night, the Giants have now hit 22 home runs in 20 second half games. San Jose's 73 home runs this season lead all North Division clubs and rank third in the California League. The Giants' 13 homers in July are second in the league (Rancho Cucamonga 17).

League Leaderboard... Several Giants hitters rank among the California League leaders. Jalen Miller is fourth in doubles (24), tied for fourth in hits (96) and tied for fifth in runs scored (50). Gio Brusa is tied for fourth in the league in home runs (13), eighth in RBI's (48) and sixth in slugging (.490). Wander Franco is third in doubles (25) while Johneshwy Fargas is tied for second in stolen bases (26).

Late Comebacks... Monday's come-from-behind win was San Jose's sixth victory this season when trailing after seven innings – tied with Visalia for the league lead.

Lack Of Series Wins... The Giants haven't won a series since taking two of three games at Modesto from June 8-10. San Jose's last series win at home came from May 28-31 against Visalia (won three of four).

Dobson Returns... Dillon Dobson was added to the Giants roster from Richmond (AA) last Friday. Dobson spent the entire 2017 season in San Jose and ranked second on the team in RBI's (68), third in home runs (15) and fifth in doubles (21). Dobson was batting .185 in 130 at-bats with Richmond this year (5 HR, 12 RBI's). He's 4-for-14 (.286 AVG) with one double and two RBI's in three games for San Jose this season.

Close Calls... The Giants have played a league-leading 30 one-run games this season (13-17 record).

Major League All-Stars... Two former San Jose Giants – Brandon Crawford and Buster Posey – were named Major League All-Stars last weekend. Crawford will start at shortstop for the National League while Posey was selected as a reserve (but will not play due to a hip injury). Crawford was chosen to his second All-Star game while Posey's sixth selection matches the most by any former San Jose Giant (Joe Nathan).

Tossed five scoreless innings with one hit allowed and seven strikeouts in Augusta ... Made his season debut on May 10 after opening the year at Extended Spring Training.
