SNAPPER SNIPPETS

STATE OF THE SNAPPERS: Beloit is coming off a wet series against the Whitecaps in which they split the 2 games played. Friday's game was wiped out due to heavy storms in the Stateline area. In their last contest, the Snappers became just the 2nd team to shut out the Whitecaps (Dayton, 2x) with a 2-0 win Thursday. Beloit has also won 6 of their last 9 games.

EASTERN SWING: The Snappers play their final 3 games against the Eastern Division with a weekend series against South Bend. The Snappers won all 4 road series in Eastern Division ballparks this season by outscoring their hosts 71-43. They have outscored their Eastern opponents 99-77 overall & have lost the series opener to all 3 Eastern Division opponents to visit Pohlman Field so far in 2017.

CLOSE GAMES: After both games completed Thursday against West Michigan were decided by 3 runs or less, the Snappers have now played a total of 62 games with finals of 3 runs or fewer & are 29-33 in those contests. The 2-0 win was just the 5th 2-run win for the Snappers this season & the 4th win of that nature in the second half. Additionally, Beloit has played 33 one-run games, the 2nd-most in the league behind Kane County's 35.

HELPFUL TO GET A HANDFUL: The Snappers are 31-7 this season when they score at least 5 runs in a game. Beloit is 10-7 in ballgames that both teams reach 5 runs. Over their previous 3 losses, the Snappers failed to reach the 5-run plateau.

NEW GUYS ON BASE: The newest additions to the Snappers roster, **Jesus Lopez** & **Josh Vidales**, have been on-base consistently since joining the team. Vidales has drawn 7 walks in 7 games, 2nd-most in the Midwest League over that time. Lopez has been aboard in all 6 of the games he has played & knocked in his 4th RBI with a suicide squeeze on Thursday.

PERSICO'S PRODUCTION: After losing his career-best 8-game hitting streak in game one, **Luke Persico** bounced back with 2 hits along with a double in the nightcap of Thursday's double dip. He now has 21 multi-hit games behind only **Trace Loehr** (23) on the active roster in performances with more than one hit. His 18th double was Persico's 24th extra-base hit, 2nd-most by a Snapper this year behind **Miguel Mercedes** (32).

PITCHER POWER: The Snappers pitching staff has been a huge boost to the team's success in the second half. Beloit's team ERA of 2.96 through 18 games in July is the best since they finished April with a 2.77 ERA. The Snappers have had 6 scoreless starts after **Kyle Twomey's** 3 scoreless frames before Wednesday's game was suspended & **Matt Milburn's** 5.2 unblemished frames on Thursday. Beloit also has 3 bullpen arms that have not allowed a run this month as **Heath Bowers** & **Sam Sheehan** joined **Yordys Alejo** after their scoreless relief yesterday. Those 3 pitchers have combined for 23 scoreless innings in 13 total outings this month. Over 32 total relief outings in July, the Beloit bullpen has recorded 22 total relief assignments without allowing a run.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: **Xavier Altamirano** is coming off a season-best 6-inning start at Great Lakes & earned his 5th win of the year. Altamirano has an ERA of 4.63 as a starter this year, but much of that is inflated by the 7 earned runs he surrendered in his last start at Pohlman Field on July 9. Altamirano has faced a Cubs affiliate twice in his career, both in the Arizona Rookie League in 2015 in which he gave up just one run over 5 innings in 2 appearances.

FACING THE CUBS: Beloit has not defeated the Cubs since their last visit to Pohlman Field in 2015 as the Snappers took only the series opener on August 11. The last time Beloit won a series against the Cubs was in 2014 at South Bend. South Bend has 4 of the Cubs top-30 prospects on their roster. That quartet included a pair of pitchers, **Jose Paulino** (#11) & **Bryan Hudson** (#24), along with 2 position players, **D.J. Wilson** (#6) & **Isaac Paredes** (#15).
