STUCK IN THE MIDDLE: Northwest Arkansas scored nine times from the fifth through the sixth Saturday night as the Naturals salvaged the series finale with an 11-6 win before 7,075 fans at Whataburger Field. Yoanys Quiala, who allowed two runs through his first four innings, ran into trouble in the fifth. The right-hander allowed a single and walk with one out and was replaced by Erasmo Pinales. Pinales did not record an out, allowing two hits, walking three batters, and striking another. The Naturals led 7-2 after five. Northwest Arkansas tacked on four more tallies in the sixth, including Jecksson Flores' bases-clearing double to make it 11-2.

Luis Villegas got the scoring started in the third with a solo homer to right field. The Hooks responded immediately in the bottom half with run-scoring hits from Alex De Goti and Nick Tanielu, both coming against Naturals starter Emilio Ogando. Corpus Christi led 2-1 after three innings before Northwest Arkansas tied things on Donnie Dewees' RBI single in the top of the fourth. Bright spots for CC included three hits, an RBI, and a run scored from Tanielu. Randy Cesar chipped in with a pair of doubles and three RBIs.

SERIES BUSINESS: With the Hooks taking 2 of 3 against the Naturals at Whataburger Field, Corpus Christi has won 2 of the first 3 series to start 2018. The Hooks begin a 3-game series with Arkansas this afternoon. The Travs swept Corpus Christi in a 3-game set at Dickey-Stephens Park during the season-opening road trip. Corpus Christi went 7-5 opposite Arkansas last year, including a 4-2 mark here in the Sparkling City.

HAIL RANDY!: IF Randy Cesar notched a pair of doubles and accounted for 4 of Corpus Christi's 6 runs Saturday night. Cesar is 5-for-8 with 2 runs scored, 2 doubles, and 3 RBIs over the last 2 games. After beginning the year 0-for-9, the 23-year-old out of Santo Domingo, DR, has hit safely in 5 consecutive games entering play today.

EXTRA EFFORT: IF Nick Tanielu turned in a 3-hit performance last night. Of Tanielu's 7 hits this season, 3 are doubles. The Washington State product has notched RBIs in 4 of 6 assignments to begin the year.

ON THE OFFENSIVE: The Hooks went 5-for-12 with men in scoring position last night, making the most of 9 hits and 6 NW Arkansas walks. Corpus Christi enters play today with a .295 batting average with men in scoring position. The Hooks have the best overall batting average (.274) and the most runs scored (53) in the Texas League through the first 9 games of the season.
