Tonight's Game... The San Jose Giants continue their homestand this evening with the second game of a three-game series against the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes (Dodgers affiliate). Rancho Cucamonga won the series opener yesterday by a 6-3 score. Domenic Mazza (3-1, 2.22 ERA) is slated to make the start on the mound for the Giants tonight.

The Giants... San Jose enters tonight's contest having lost four games in a row and seven out of their last eight. Following last night's loss, the Giants (45-58) fell a season-high 13 games below .500 overall. San Jose has won just one series in the second half (3-1 vs. Visalia, July 13-16)

Home Cooking... Last night began a stretch for the Giants playing 12 out of 15 games at home. San Jose is 23-26 at Municipal Stadium this season (22-32 on the road). The Giants own a 3.67 team ERA at home compared to 4.93 on the road. 21 of San Jose's final 37 games this year will be at home.

The Long Ball... San Jose leads all North Division clubs and ranks third in the California League with 87 home runs this season. The Giants have hit 36 home runs in 33 second half games. San Jose's 27 homers in July are second in the California League (Rancho Cucamonga 34). Conversely, the Giants have allowed 30 home runs this month – second-most in the league (Lancaster 33).

Struggling Against The South... The Giants are 2-14 against South Division opponents in the second half (2-11 vs. Rancho Cucamonga, 0-3 vs. Lake Elsinore) compared to a 9-8 mark versus the North. From July 18-August 19, San Jose will play 24 out of 30 games against South Division clubs.

Brusa Bash... Gio Brusa leads the Giants with 16 home runs this season. Only two out of his 16 homers have come at home. Brusa homered twice in last Sunday's game at Lake Elsinore – his second multi-homer game of the season. Brusa tied a San Jose Giants single-game record when he hit three home runs on June 10 at Modesto. Brusa has now hit 33 home runs with San Jose over the last two seasons. He is three home runs away from cracking the San Jose Giants career top 5 list (Travis Ishikawa and Angel Villalona tied for fourth with 36 HR each).

Bullpen Woes... Giants relievers allowed all six runs in last night's 6-3 loss to Rancho Cucamonga. San Jose suffered their league-leading 20th blown base of the season yesterday (12th blown save since June 1). Over the last seven games, the Giants bullpen owns an 8.31 ERA (28 ER/30.1 IP). San Jose leads the league with 12 losses when leading after six innings and seven losses when ahead after seven innings.

League Leaderboard... Several Giants hitters rank among the California League leaders. Jalen Miller is second in the league in hits (109), third in doubles (28), sixth in runs scored (56) and ninth in RBI's (54). Gio Brusa is fifth in the league in home runs (16), tied for seventh in RBI's (55) and sixth in slugging (.498). Wander Franco is tied for fourth in doubles (27) and sixth in hits (103) while Johneshwy Fargas is tied for first in stolen bases (32).

Tough Month... The Giants are a league-worst 6-17 in July (3-7 at home, 3-10 on the road). San Jose is last in the league in team batting average (.229) and team ERA (6.25) this month. The Giants have had a starting pitcher complete six innings just once in 23 games this month (Domenic Mazza, July 9 at Stockton).

Versus The Quakes... The Giants are only 2-11 against Rancho Cucamonga this season, including an 0-6 mark at Municipal Stadium. Against Rancho Cucamonga pitching, San Jose is batting just .199, averaging 3.7 runs per game and have struck out 143 times (11.0 per game). Giants pitchers have surrendered 22 home runs over 13 games to the Quakes (6.29 ERA).

Surrendered two runs in the bottom of the second before finishing his outing with three straight scoreless innings ... Giants won the game 4-2.
- * Has won his last two starts ... Also collected a win on July 14 against Visalia (5 2/3 IP, 10 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 2 SO) ... Made his first start of the season on July 9 at Stockton (six scoreless innings) ... Made back-to-back relief appearances on June 29 and July 4 before moving into the starting rotation.
- * Joined San Jose on June 29 after a rehab stint in the Arizona Rookie League ... Made two relief appearances with the AZL Giants Orange (6 IP, 0 ER) ... Did not make his season debut until June 19 (back).
- * Spent the majority of the 2017 season with Augusta (A) ... Was 7-9 with a 3.01 ERA in 19 starts for the GreenJackets... Earned midseason South Atlantic League All-Star honors ... Struck out 97 and walked 20 over 119 2/3 innings ... Allowed two earned runs or fewer in 14 out of 19 starts ... Walked two or fewer batters in 18 out of 19 starts.
- * Threw the first nine-inning perfect game in South Atlantic League history on April 25, 2017 at Lexington ... Struck out nine batters ... Threw 85 pitches (60 strikes).
