LAST TIME OUT: **Dermis Garcia** hit a go-ahead 2-run homer in the 7th and Tampa added five more runs in the 9th to take the opener in Port Charlotte, 9-4. ...Tampa tallied a season-high 12 hits, including multi-hit games by **Pablo Olivares** (2-for-4, HBP, R), **Oswaldo Cabrera** (2-for-4, HBP, 2R), **Isiah Gilliam** (2-for-4, 2B, BB, 2RBI, 2R) and Garcia (3-for-5, HR, 2RBI, 3R). ...**Steven Sensley** (1-for-5, HR, 3RBI, R) punctuated the win with a 3-run homer in the 9th. ...**RHP Frank German** held the Stone Crabs to 1ER in 5.0IP (3H, 4BB, 5K, 2WP, 80P/44S) in a no-decision. ...**RHP Janson Junk** (W, 1-0)(BS, 1) got the win in relief (3.0IP, 3H, 2ER, 5BB, 2K). ...**RHP Braden Bristo** (1.0IP, 1H, 1ER, 0BB, 2K, HR) pitched the 9th.

DERMIS' DINGERS: Last night, **Dermis Garcia** homered in his third-straight game, and the fifth time in his last six games. Last Tuesday against Bradenton at George M. Steinbrenner Field, **Dermis Garcia** logged his fourth-career multi-HR game. The 21-year-old added a 2-run blast in Clearwater on Friday before using his legs to race around the bases for an inside-the-parker on Saturday at Spectrum Field. Garcia enters the day as the leader in the Florida State League in HRs (6), RBI (20), SLG (.642), XBH (10) and TB (43).

GO, DIEGO, GO! After starting the season on an 0-for-28 skid, **Diego Castillo** as since batted .314 (11-for-35) with 1HR and 4 doubles since April 11th. Entering today, Castillo is on an eight-game hitting streak, batting .345 (10-for-29) in that span.

PITCHING PROSPECTS: The Tarpons open the season with three Top-30 New York Yankees prospects in the starting rotation: **RHP Deivi Garcia** (No. 4 MLB/No. 6 BA), **RHP Clarke Schmidt** (No. 5 MLB/No. 12 BA) and **RHP Glenn Otto** (No. 26 MLB/--BA).

NEW SKIPPER IN TOWN: Aaron Holbert begins his fourth season in the Yankees organization and his first as a coach after spending the last three seasons as a professional scout. Prior to joining the Yankees, Holbert was Manager of Double-A Mississippi (Braves) from 2012-15. In that span, the Southern California native led the club to two postseason appearances, including a record of 83-56 that paced the Southern League in 2014.

Prior to Mississippi, Holbert managed Single-A Advanced Kinston (Indians) in 2010 and 2011. Kinston made the playoffs in both seasons and Holbert was named Carolina League Manager of the Year in 2011. Holbert began coaching in the Reds organization in 2006 before landing his first managerial position with Single-A Lake County (Indians) in 2008. The club went 146-131 over two seasons, including a postseason appearance in 2009.

Originally drafted 18th overall by the St. Louis Cardinals out of high school in 1990, Holbert reached the major leagues with St. Louis (1996) and Cincinnati (2005) over a 16-year playing career, including stints with St. Louis, Seattle, Tampa Bay, Boston, Florida, Toronto, Pittsburgh and Cincinnati.

MIGLIACCIO/MAHONEY JOIN COACHING STAFF: Hitting Coach Joe Migliaccio (Mig-lee-AH-chee-oh) begins his first season in the Yankees organization. The 28-year-old served in the same role at the University of Iowa in 2018 following coaching stints at Murray State (2017-18), Missouri (2016-17), Southeast Missouri State (2015-16) and Siena College (2014-15). As a graduate assistant at Missouri, Migliaccio helped guide the Tigers to their best record (36-23) since 2008.

Prior to coaching, Migliaccio was an infielder at Florida International (2009-10), Parkland College (2010-12) and Oral Roberts (2012-14). The West Melbourne, Florida native graduated cum laude from Oral Roberts in 2014 with a degree in recreation administration with a minor in humanities. He earned his master's degree in education from Missouri in 2018.

Defensive Coach Kevin Mahoney enters his fifth season in the Yankees organization and his first with Tampa after serving in the same role in 2018 with the GCL Yankees East. Mahoney was the hitting coach for short-season Single-A Staten Island in 2017 and Rookie-level Pulaski in 2016 after making his coaching debut in the GCL in 2015. Originally selected by the Yankees in the 23rd round of the 2009 First-Year Player Draft, Mahoney batted .252 with 183R, 34HR and 160RBI in 381 games across five minor league seasons.

ACQUIRED: Selected by the Yankees in the first round (16th overall) in 2017.

SCHOOL: University of South Carolina @ClarkeSchmidt

ARSENAL: 2-Seam Fastball, 4-Seam Fastball, Slider, Curveball, Changeup.

LAST TIME OUT: After holding Bradenton to one unearned run through the first four innings, Schmidt allowed a 3-run HR in the 5th to cue the end of his start on 4/16.



2019: Began the season by holding the Flying Tigers hitless in 5.0 scoreless innings in a no-decision at Lakeland on Opening Day...logged a four-strikeout inning in the 4th at Lakeland on 4/4...Opened the season rated No. 5 among Yankees prospects by *MLB Pipeline* and No. 12 by *Baseball America*.

2018: Began his season on a rehab assignment in the Gulf Coast League on June 22nd...Between the GCL and short-season Single-A Staten Island, went 0-3 with a 3.09 ERA (23.1IP, 16H, 9R/8ER, 1HR, 2HB, 6BB, 30K) in eight games (seven starts)...held opposing batters to a .195 BA (16-for-82).

2017: Did not pitch while recovering from "Tommy John" surgery on his right elbow.

Personal: In three seasons at South Carolina (2015-17) produced a 15-9 record and 3.21 ERA (229.2IP, 218H, 102R/82ER, 65BB, 254K, 17HR) in 45 appearances (36 starts)...as a junior in 2017, went 4-2 and ranked second in the nation with a 1.34 ERA (60.1IP, 41H, 15R/9ER, 18BB, 70K, 3HR) in nine starts, posting a 10.44 K/9.0IP ratio and .194 (41-for-211) opponent's BA...was named to USA Baseball's Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List in both 2016 and 2017...was named to the 2017 NCBWA Pre-Season All-American First Team...was *Baseball America's* No. 31 overall prospect (and No. 17 pitcher) in the 2017 draft...was tabbed by *Baseball America* as having the Best Control in the SEC...graduated from Allatoona H.S. (Ga.), where he was the Region 5AAAAA 2014 Pitcher of the Year as a senior...older brother, Clate, is a right-handed pitcher in the Tigers organization...Grew up in Acworth, Georgia.
