SNAPPER SNIPPETS

FREE BASEBALL: For the first time since July 31 & August 1, 2016, the Snappers have now played in consecutive extra-inning games. The last time the Snappers played 3 extra-inning games in a row was July 12-14, 2007 at West Michigan. This current series with Peoria is the 2nd series this season that Beloit has had multiple contest that needed more than 9 innings to decide a winner.

.500 DAYS OF SUMMER: Beloit's win on Friday got the team to .500 for the 8th time this season. The Snappers 20-20 start is the best start through the first 40 games of a season since 2013. The Snappers first team under the Athletics affiliation went 22-18 through the first 40 games while the 2016 Snappers were 19-21 during the same period. Beloit has not had a winning record since starting the season 2-1.

HELPFUL TO GET A HANDFUL: Beloit is 16-2 when they score 5 runs or more. The Snappers are 6-10 in games that they allow 5 runs or more & are 6-2 in contests that both teams reach 5 runs.

TWO BIRDS, ONE STONE: After Beloit turned 3 double plays again on Friday night, they have turned a total of 51 twin killers. That is the 2nd-most in all of Minor League Baseball trailing only the Midland RockHounds, the Athletics Double-A affiliate, with 53. Only the Texas Rangers have turned more double plays in affiliated professional baseball with 57. On the flip side, the Snappers have grounded into the most double plays in the Midwest League.

NOWLIN MAKES HISTORY: Kyle Nowlin's save on Friday night was the first save by a position player in Beloit Professional Baseball history. Nowlin saw the mound for the 2nd time this season & is the 2nd position player to make multiple pitching appearances this year. The Snappers have called on position players 5 times this season & have tossed 5 scoreless innings, which is the most innings thrown by Beloit position players in a season during their Athletics affiliation. **Ryan Matthews** made 3 outings for Beloit in 2014, which is the most by a single player during that time. Matthews also owns one of two winning decisions by a position player in team history that he earned during a 17-inning game at Wisconsin on June 10, 2014. Catcher **Randy Snyder** picked up a win in 1990 for the Beloit Brewers.

FACING THE CHIEFS: The Snappers head to Peoria for the first of 3 consecutive visits in their season series with the Chiefs. Earlier this season at Pohlman Field, Beloit won their first series of the season over Peoria including their most lopsided win of the year on April 15. The Chiefs roster currently carries 5 of the Cardinals Top-30 prospects according to MLB.com. Two pitchers **Jordan Hicks** (#18) & **Ronnie Williams** (#25) are listed with 3 outfielders **Dylan Carlson** (#16), **Nick Plummer** (#23), & **Bryce Denton** (#26).
