**Last Game:** Chattanooga Lookouts first baseman Jonathan Rodriguez hit a seventh-inning solo home run for the only scoring in the visitors' 1-0 win over the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp in front of 3,706 to witness the finale of the highest-attended series in the history of the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville Sunday afternoon. After Jacksonville (5-5) won the first three games, Chattanooga (5-5) took the final two of a series that brought 41,276 in total attendance, setting the record for a single series at the ballpark that opened in 2003. Through Sunday, Jacksonville leads Double-A baseball, and ranks fifth in domestic Minor League Baseball, in total attendance. Each starting pitcher got a no-decision. Jumbo Shrimp right-hander Chris Mazza tossed six scoreless innings, allowing two hits with no walks and six strikeouts. Lookouts right-hander Paul Clemens worked 5 1/3 innings, scattering five hits with one walk and four strikeouts. Jacksonville right-hander Tayron Guerrero (0-1) entered a scoreless tie to begin the seventh inning. After striking out designated hitter Dan Gamache, Guerrero allowed Rodriguez's go-ahead home run to left field. Rodriguez had homered against Guerrero on Thursday. The next two batters struck out, and right-hander Tyler Higgins followed Guerrero with scoreless eighth and ninth innings. Chattanooga right-hander Todd Van Steensel (1-0) pitched 1 2/3 innings, allowing one hit and striking out one batter. Left-hander Mason Melotakis worked two perfect innings for his first save.

## NEWS AND NOTES

**Record Attendance in Jacksonville:** With 41,276 in attendance over five days, Jacksonville fans made the inaugural Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp home series the highest-attended series in the 15-year history of the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Jacksonville's opening series attendance increased by 57 percent over last season, and has increased by 110 percent over the first two seasons of new ownership by Fast Forward Sports Group. After their game Sunday, the Jumbo Shrimp led all of the Southern League and Double-A baseball, while also ranking fifth in all of Minor League Baseball, in home attendance for the 2017 season. "This season's opening series has truly been something special," said Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp Owner Ken Babby. "We are totally humbled and honored by the response from Jacksonville and the fans and can't thank you enough for making this weekend one to remember." Wednesday's Opening Night sellout of 10,477 was the largest crowd at a Southern League game at the ballpark since July 3, 2012, and Jacksonville's largest opening crowd since a stadium record of 12,943 attended the ballpark's first-ever game on April 11, 2003. "We are elated by the community's response through the opening series," said General Manager Harold Crow. "We look forward to more affordable family fun with returning guests, while sharing the Jumbo Shrimp experience with first-time guests at each game at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville."

**Peters Looks to Continue Winning Ways:** Tonight's Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp starter Dillon Peters has won his first two starts of the season, and he hopes to continue that positive momentum into tonight's third start in 2017. Peters turned in five innings where he gave up only one run with no walks and seven strikeouts in his first start of the year on Opening Night on April 6 at Mississippi. He then won the inaugural Jumbo Shrimp game at the Baseball Grounds on Wednesday April 12 in front of 10,477 fans. Peters worked five and a third innings where he allowed a run on three hits with a walk and five strikeouts as the Shrimp cruised to a 7-1 victory.

**Garcia to Miami Marlins:** Left-handed relief pitcher Jarlin Garcia has been recalled to the major league Miami Marlins, announced on Friday. Garcia this season has made three relief outings for the Jumbo Shrimp, with no wins or losses and a 0.00 ERA in his three innings of work. This is the second big league call-up for Garcia, who was recalled by the Marlins on May 15 last season from Jacksonville. Garcia did not pitch for the Marlins in the big leagues last season despite being on their active roster for five days. Garcia made his big league debut Friday night, working a scoreless sixth inning of relief work against the New York Mets.

**Starting Pitchers Are Consistent:** Through the first 10 games of the season, each Jacksonville starting pitcher has pitched at least five innings, and the Jumbo Shrimp have not had to over-extend the bullpen in any nine inning game. Friday Omar Bencomo turned in six scoreless innings, and he hasn't allowed a run through his first 11 innings on the mound in 2017. Also thanks to early run support the first three game of the Lookouts series, all of Jacksonville's starting pitchers have earned the victory, and in each of the five Jumbo Shrimp victories, the starting pitcher has earned the win.

**Shrimp Have Prospects:** On the Opening Day roster, the Jumbo Shrimp have seven players that are considered among the Top 30 Marlins prospects for this season according to both Baseball America and MLB.com. Top 30 Marlins Prospects include: third baseman Brian Anderson (No. 3 MLB, No. 4 BA), left-handed pitcher Jarlin Garcia (No. 4 MLB, No. 6 BA), left-handed pitcher Dillon Peters (No. 5 MLB, No. 5 BA), left fielder Austin Dean (No. 13 MLB, No. 8 BA), right-handed pitcher Tayron Guerrero (No. 19 MLB, No. 16 BA), outfielder John Norwood (No. 27 MLB, No. 29 BA), and infielder Yefri Perez (No. 30 both MLB & BA). Additionally, Baseball America regards Anderson as being the "Best Hitter for Average, Best Strike-Zone Discipline, Best Defensive Infielder, Best Infield Arm," in the organization, while Garcia has the "Best Changeup," Perez is the "Fastest Baserunner," and Peters has the "Best Control."

**CAREER:** 17-10, 2.64 ERA (54 ER/184.0 IP) in 37 G and 37 GS.

**LAST START:** Peters won the inaugural Jumbo Shrimp game at the Baseball Grounds on Wednesday April 12 in front of 10,477 fans. Peters worked five and a third innings where he allowed a run on three hits with a walk and five strikeouts as the Shrimp cruised to a 7-1 victory.

**M-BRAVES WIN:** Peters won his Opening Night start on Thursday April 6 against the Mississippi Braves at Trustmark Park. Peters set down the first nine batters of the game in order, and eventually pitched five innings where he allowed just a run on five hits with no walks and five strikeouts as the Jumbo Shrimp won their first ever game 7-2.

**2016 VS. CHATTANOOGA:** Peters shined in his Double-A debut as he earned the win against the Chattanooga Lookouts at AT&T Field on Tuesday August 9, 2016. Peters turned in six and two-third scoreless innings where he allowed five hits with three walks and five strikeouts as the Suns won the rubber match of the series 3-0.

**2017 MARLINS SPRING TRAINING:** Dillon Peters was a non-roster invitee to Miami Marlins spring training in 2017. Peters made four appearances and one start, going 0-0 with a 2.00 ERA, striking out four batters in his nine innings of work. In his start on March 9 against the Washington Nationals and their regular lineup, Peters walked the leadoff batter (Trea Turner) before setting down the next nine batters (Adam Eaton, Bryce Harper, Anthony Rendon, Jayson Werth, Ryan Zimmerman, Jose Lobaton, Grant Green, Stephen Drew, then Turner to end his day.

**DON MATTINGLY ON PETERS:** "I think we see a guy that is confident," Marlins manager Don Mattingly said about Peters in spring training. "He's on the attack out there. He doesn't look like a guy that is afraid at all. I heard about him all last year. Our guys in development really like him. In camp, they're proven to be right. He's a guy that's aggressive. He has good stuff."

**PROSPECT:** Peters is listed by Baseball America as the Marlins No. 5 prospect for the 2017 season and MLB.com has him as Miami's No. 5 for this year. Additionally, Peters is regarded as having the "Best Control" of any Marlins farmhand. Peters is regarded as the second-best left-handed pitching prospect in the Marlins organization behind No. 1 prospect Braxton Garrett, whom was drafted just last season and has not pitched professionally.

**2016 WITH JACKSONVILLE:** Peters finished the 2016 season with Jacksonville where he went 3-0 with a 1.99 ERA in four starts. Peters earned wins in his first three Suns starts, with victories against Chattanooga, Mississippi, and Tennessee. Peters struck out 16 batters in his 22 and two-thirds innings of work with Jacksonville.

**2016 WITH JUPITER:** Peters with the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads was 11-6 with a 2.46 ERA in 20 starts. In the Florida State League, Peters was sixth in ERA (2.46), and tied for second in wins (11). Following the season, Peters was named a 2016 Florida State League Postseason All-Star.

Selected by the Miami Marlins in the 10<sup>th</sup> round of the 2014 draft out of the University of Texas.

**2015 Highlights:** Peters went 1-1 with a 0.68 ERA in four starts for the GCL Marlins. He also went 0-3 with a 4.83 ERA in seven starts with rookie level Batavia.

**Personal:** Was selected by the Marlins after he already had missed time with an elbow injury and had to undergo Tommy John surgery following the 2014 Big XII Tournament. Agreed to a \$175,000 signing bonus with Marlins. Was 7-3 with a 2.31 ERA in final season with Texas Longhorns. Tossed seven innings in a combined no-hitter against Kansas State on May 16, 2014. Was Indiana All-State in 2009 and 2010, and was the 2010 Indiana Super Team Player of the Year. His grandfather pitched semipro ball, and his father Mark pitched in college and coached Peters in travel ball. Was originally drafted by the Cleveland Indians in the 20<sup>th</sup> round in 2011 before he signed with Texas.
