BACK IN MAINE: The Portland Sea Dogs finished the regular season by playing 11 of the final 16 games at Hadlock Field...Tonight, the 'Dogs and Reading Fightin Phils (Phillies affiliate) open up a three-game series in Maine...Reading holds a 5.5 game lead over the Sea Dogs for the top spot in the division...The standings online do not reflect Reading winning the head-to-head this half...Following this series, the Trenton Thunder invade Hadlock on Thursday.

NETZER PROVIDED THE POWER: 2B **Brett Netzer** accounted for Portland's lone run, leading off the fourth inning with a solo homer (#7) in a 10-1 loss on Sunday in New Hampshire...The 'Dogs dropped two of three to the 'Cats over the weekend and went 2-5 on the trip...New Hampshire received 3 RBI from SS **Kevin Smith** and C **Riley Adams**...RHP **Thomas Hatch** (1-3) worked six innings on three hits and one run to earn his first win in the Blue Jays system.

DEALIN' DANNY: LHP **Daniel McGrath** has won four straight starts for the first time in his career, and allowed just three earned runs in his last 72.0 IP (0.38)...The lefty is 6-0, 0.72 ERA (6 ER/74.2 IP) in 13 starts this season...McGrath now qualifies as the Eastern League leader in ERA (1.35).

LET'S GET IT STARTED: Portland's starters have posted a 2.95 ERA (99 ER/302.0 IP) in their last 49 starts...For the season, the 'Dogs' starters have compiled a 3.55 ERA (262 ER/665.0 IP).

FIVE BY TWO: CF **Jarren Duran** and Netzer scored all five runs for Portland in the New Hampshire series...Portland had just six hits in the final 22 innings against the Fisher Cats...INF **Jeremy Rivera** went 2-for-4 and reached base safely three times in the last two games.

BASE-HIT BRETT: Netzer is hitting .303 (20-for-66) with four homers and 10 RBI over his last 19 games.

AGAINST THE OPPONENT: Portland has dropped 14 of 18 games to the Fightin Phils this season, including five of seven at Hadlock Field...Reading leads the All-Time Season Series at 15-10-0.
