## SNAPPER SNIPPETS

**STATE OF THE SNAPPERS:** The Snappers have won 8 of their last 12 games & have been .500 or better every day since their 15-2 win over Wisconsin on May 25. Last night's win put the Snappers 2 games over .500 for the first time since May 24, 2016 when they were 23-21. Last night's win was the 5th road trip opener the Snappers have won in 2017. Beloit pitching has fanned 10 or more in 4 of the last 5 games & are 2nd in the Midwest League in strikeouts. Hitters have knocked 12 2B's in the last 5 games & have the 2nd-most in the Midwest League with 99 this year.

**TAKE 5:** In Friday's series opener in Appleton, the Snappers scored 5 runs & hit 2 home runs. Beloit has now scored 5 runs or more in 26 games this season & are 23-3 when they hit that plateau. The Snappers are now 12-1 in games they hit more than one homer.

**MASH LIKE MIGGY:** Miguel Mercedes had a career night at the plate for Beloit on Friday. He recorded his first 4-hit game of his professional career & missed the cycle by a triple. Mercedes also hit his 11th homer of the season & is now tied with the Midwest League lead in the home run department with Cedar Rapids' Jaylin Davis.

**DIAZ DIALED IN:** Edwin Diaz has hit safely in his last 12 games & is the 4th Snappers hitter to have an on-base streak reach 20 games. Diaz has the longest active hitting streak in the Midwest League with the 2nd-longest on-base streak behind Brennon Lund of Burlington who has been aboard in his last 24 games. The 12-game hitting streak for the Snappers infielder is the longest of his Snappers tenure as well as the longest string by a Beloit batter in 2017.

**LUIS LEADING OFF:** The Snappers have turned to Luis Barrera to take over the leadoff spot in the lineup in the last 6 games. Over that time, he is 12-for-28 with 4 consecutive multi-hit games to total 16 games with more than one hit for Barrera, the 2nd-most on the team behind Nate Mondou with 18 multi-hit games. Barrera is hitting .346 over 12 total games from the leadoff spot in 2017 with 2 homers, both vs. the Timber Rattlers.

**TODAY'S PITCHERS:** Brandon Bailey & Matt Milburn will take the mound for the Snappers on Saturday. Bailey is coming off possibly his best outing as a pro after he struck out the first 7 batters he faced

**FACING THE TIMBER RATTTLERS:** The Snappers visit Appleton for the first time this season after taking 3 of 4 vs. the Timber Rattlers in southern Wisconsin at the end of May. Snappers manager Scott Steinmann managed the Timber Rattlers in 2005 & guided them to the Midwest League Championship series. Wisconsin currently carried Beloit native Cameron Roegner on their roster. The Timber Rattlers also have Brewers Top-30 prospects Gilbert Lara (#17), Monte Harrison (#22), Mario Feliciano (#23), & Demi Orimoloye (#24).
