Last Game: Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp second baseman David Vidal had four hits, but Biloxi Shuckers catcher Jacob Nottingham hit a ninth-inning, two-out RBI single to lift the visitors to a 4-3 win and five-game series sweep preceding NAPA AutoCare Family Fireworks before 6,904 at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville Friday night. The Shuckers (19-16) took a lead against Jumbo Shrimp right-hander Omar Bencomo with one out in the second inning. Right fielder Clint Coulter singled, second baseman Javier Betancourt hit an RBI double, and pitcher Aaron Wilkerson hit an RBI single for a 2-0 Biloxi lead. In the third inning, third baseman Angel Ortega and first baseman Dustin DeMuth hit consecutive doubles to extend the lead to 3-0. Bencomo completed six innings with nine hits, no walks and five strikeouts. Vidal started rallies twice against Shuckers right-hander Aaron Wilkerson to help Jacksonville (13-22) tie the game. Vidal hit a fourth-inning leadoff double and scored on right fielder John Norwood's RBI single. In the sixth inning, Vidal hit a leadoff single, Norwood singled, and left fielder Cal Towey walked to load the bases. Right-hander Forrest Snow entered and allowed first baseman Taylor Ard's RBI single to center field. Left fielder Jeremias Pineda later drew a one-out, bases-loaded RBI walk to tie the game, 3-3, before third baseman Rehiner Cordova grounded into an inning-ending double play. In the bottom of the seventh inning, shortstop Alex Yarbrough drew a one-out walk, and Vidal and Norwood singled. Yarbrough tried to score from second base on Norwood's hit, but center fielder Johnny Davis threw to Nottingham to retire Yarbrough. Jumbo Shrimp manager Randy Ready argued with home plate umpire Brandon Butler after the call and was ejected. Left-hander Nick Ramirez finished the inning with a strikeout. In the ninth inning, Jumbo Shrimp left-hander Greg Nappo allowed a leadoff single by shortstop Mauricio Dubon, Vidal's one-out error moved Dubon to third base, and Nottingham's two-out single scored him. Shuckers right-hander Bubba Derby (2-0) worked two perfect innings to finish the game.

NEWS AND NOTES

Hello BayBears: After a bus ride through the night from Florida to Alabama, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp are now facing the Mobile BayBears from Saturday through Wednesday at Hank Aaron Stadium. The Jumbo Shrimp and BayBears recently met at the Baseball Grounds, with Jacksonville winning the series 4-1. The BayBears took the first game 8-3 before Jacksonville rallied off four straight victories to close out the series. Jacksonville's final two wins were in walk-off fashion, with John Norwood hitting a walk-off homer in the bottom of the eleventh inning on April 30, and then Brian Anderson hitting a walk-off RBI double on May 1 to complete the series.

Friday's Roster Moves: Before the Jumbo Shrimp faced the Biloxi Shuckers on Friday night, the Miami Marlins made a pair of significant roster moves that affected the Jacksonville roster. Utility player Yefri Perez, who was on the Marlins' 40-man roster, was designated for assignment. Perez was hitting .131 with no home runs, seven runs batted in, and five stolen bases for the Jumbo Shrimp in 29 games played in 2017. The Marlins now have 10 days to trade, release, or put Perez on waivers where he can be claimed by another organization. In a corresponding move, utility player Rehiner (pronounced Ray-ner) Cordova has been transferred from extended spring training to Jacksonville. Cordova hasn't played in a game so far in 2017, and last year he spent the entire season at High-A Jupiter where he hit .165 with 11 RBI in 56 games for the Jupiter Hammerheads. Cordova, 23, is a native of Maracay, Venezuela, and was signed by the Marlins as an international free agent in 2010.

LAST START: Gonzalez suffered his second straight loss as he fell to the Biloxi Shuckers on Monday May 8 at the Baseball Grounds. Gonzalez worked six innings where he allowed three runs (two earned) on seven hits with a walk and four strikeouts as Jacksonville lost 7-5.

SMOKIES LOSS: Gonzalez suffered his first loss on Wednesday May 3 against the Tennessee Smokies at Smokies Stadium. Gonzalez worked six innings where he allowed two runs on four hits with a walk and three strikeouts. Gonzalez was hurt by solo homers by the Smokies, as Ian Rice hit a solo homer in the second and then Jacob Hannemann broke a 1-1 tie in the bottom of the sixth to make it a 2-1 score, which would be the final.

BAYBEARS START: Gonzalez had a no decision in his start on Thursday April 27 against the Mobile BayBears at the Baseball Grounds. Gonzalez worked six innings where he allowed three runs (two earned) on five hits with three walks and a strikeout. He left with the game tied 3-3, only to see the BayBears score five runs in the top of the eighth to win 8-3.

BARONS START: Gonzalez had a no decision in his last start on Saturday April 22 at Birmingham. He worked five and two-third innings where he allowed a pair of runs on five hits with no walks and five strikeouts. He left with the score 2-2, and Jacksonville would lose the game 8-2 after the Barons scored six runs with two outs in the bottom of the eighth inning.

2017 with NEW ORLEANS: Gonzalez began the season in the starting rotation for Triple-A New Orleans. Gonzalez there was 0-2 with a 9.35 ERA, allowing nine earned runs in his eight and two-thirds innings of work. Gonzalez lost his first two starts to Memphis on April 7 and at Iowa on April 12, with his I-Cubs start being his toughest outing. In that game he worked three and a third innings allowing 10 runs (9 earned) on 10 hits with two walks and two strikeouts. Gonzalez then turned in a scoreless relief outing on April 16 at Omaha, working just a third of an inning.

BIG LEAGUE TIME with PHILLIES: Gonzalez pitched in parts of the last two seasons in the majors with the Philadelphia Phillies. In 2015 he made seven starts, going 3-3 with a 7.92 ERA. In 2016 he worked exclusively out of the bullpen, going 1-2 with a 5.60 ERA. As a major league pitcher, Gonzalez is 4-5 with a 6.68 ERA in 34 appearances and seven starts.

#29 SEVERINO GONZALEZ RHP | 6-2, 155 lbs | Born: September 28, 1992 in Santiago de Veragua, Panama Age: 24

Acquired by the Marlins in a trade from the Philadelphia Phillies on Jan. 24, 2017 for a player to be named later.

2016 Highlights: Combined a 3-3 record and a 4.09 ERA in 48 appearances between Double-A Reading, Triple-A Lehigh Valley, and Philadelphia. With Double-A Reading he was 2-0 with a 1.69 ERA in six relief outings. With Triple-A Lehigh Valley, he was 0-1 with a 3.31 ERA in 15 appearances and one start. With the Phillies he worked exclusively out of the bullpen, going 1-2 with a 5.60 ERA in 27 appearances.

2015 Highlights: With Triple-A Lehigh Valley he was 2-7 with a 5.11 ERA in 16 starts in 2015. With the Phillies in the majors he was 3-3 with a 7.92 ERA in seven starts, making his MLB debut on April 28 at St. Louis. On that day, combined with Carlos Ruiz to form first Panamanian-born battery to start a game in Major League history. At 22 years and 212 days, was youngest Phillies starter to make debut since Scott Mathieson in 2007 (22 years, 110 days).

2014 Highlights: Led Phillies Minor League system in starts (27) and innings pitched (158.2) in 2014 with Double-A Reading. Tied for Eastern League lead in starts, ranked second in inning and fourth in strikeouts (115).

2013 Highlights: Recipient of Paul Owens Award as best pitcher in Phillies Minor League system in 2013, posting combined 7-5 record and 2.00 ERA (103.2/23) in 25 appearances (14 starts) between Single-A Clearwater, Single-A Lakewood and Reading. Named Phillies Minor League Pitcher of the Week for July 1-7 after going 2-0 with 3.18 ERA. Appeared for La Guaira in Venezuelan Winter League following season.

2012 Highlights: In second season with Venezuelan Summer League Phillies in 2012, led VSL in ERA (1.65), strikeouts (86) and complete games (2), while tying for lead in starts (14). Also ranked tied for third in wins (7).

2011 Highlights: Began professional career with VSL Phillies after signing with Phillies in 2011, going 1-1 with 2.11 ERA (42.2/10) in 17 appearances.
