Another Friday rainout, another Saturday twin bill: Rain postponed Friday's game between the RubberDucks and Baysox. It was the third rainout for each club. The teams will make up the game with a doubleheader of seven-inning games Saturday. Akron was also rained out in Altoona last Friday and swept the Curve in their first doubleheader of the season on Saturday, before rain Sunday forced a doubleheader to be set for June 8 in Altoona. Bowie was swept in a doubleheader April 6 in Harrisburg and has another scheduled for July 22 in Richmond.

Thursday's Recap: Ducks rally late to down Baysox (Akron 7, Bowie 4): The Akron RubberDucks broke a 4-4 tie with three runs in the bottom of the eighth inning to earn a 7-4 win in the series opener with the Bowie Baysox in front of 3,223 at Canal Park Thursday night. Akron took a 4-1 lead on **Mitch Longo's** fifth-inning two-run triple, on which he scored via a Bowie error, but the Baysox tied it in the seventh inning. Four straight eighth-inning singles by center fielder **Connor Marabell**, designated hitter **Ka'ai Tom**, first baseman **Wilson Garcia**, and catcher **Li-Jen Chu**, led to three runs for Akron's 7-4 lead.

RubberDucks post strikeout high: Led by 10 strikeouts from starter **Matt Solter**, RubberDucks pitchers combined to strike out a season-high 15 batters Thursday night. Relievers **Ben Krauth** and **Argenis Angulo** each fanned one, before **James Karinchak** struck out the side in the ninth inning.

Unhittable Karinchakkkkkkkkkkkkk: Akron right-hander **James Karinchak** recorded his first 12 outs this season via strikeout in five appearances. He allowed two groundouts in the ninth inning Tuesday for the first balls put in play against him. He has allowed four baserunners via two walks, one catcher's interference, and a wild-pitch strikeout. He has thrown three total wild pitches. He has twice had six consecutive strikeouts and has 17 in six total innings this season. Karinchak is ranked as the Indians' No. 30 prospect by MLB.com.

Pantoja performing: RubberDucks infielder **Alexis Pantoja** had two hits Thursday to extend a five-game hitting streak. In the past five games, Pantoja is 10-for-18 with three doubles, a triple, one RBI, two walks and one strikeout. He has also reached base and scored a run in six consecutive games. Pantoja has started six games at second base, three at third base and two at shortstop.

Johnson delivering: Outfielder **Daniel Johnson** had back-to-back four-RBI games Saturday and Monday, added an RBI Tuesday and homered on Thursday to lead Akron with three home runs and 11 RBI this season. In his last four games, Johnson is 8-for-17 with three doubles, two home runs and 10 RBI. Last season, Johnson played 89 games with the Washington Nationals' Eastern League affiliate, Harrisburg. He was on the injured list June 6-July 23, due to a broken right hamate bone that required surgery. Part of the trade that sent Yan Gomes from Cleveland to Washington on Nov. 30, Johnson is ranked as the Indians' No. 14 (*Baseball America*)/No. 22 (MLB.com) prospect.

Ducks All Over the Pond: Of the 12 position players who began the season with Akron, nine have started games at multiple positions. Only catchers **Li-Jen Chu** and **Logan Ice**, and first baseman **Wilson Garcia** have played exclusively at one position.

RubberDucks return home: After a 3-3 road trip, Akron returns home for six home games in seven days (Easter Sunday is an Eastern League off day). The RubberDucks play three games each against Bowie and Binghamton, before visiting the same teams for four and three games, respectively, on their next road trip April 25-May 1. The RubberDucks opened the season with six straight home losses before a win in their April 10 homestand finale. Akron was 38-32 at Canal Park in the 2018 regular season and 78-62 overall.

Ducks host Baysox: The RubberDucks and Baysox are playing the first of six scheduled series this season, with 10 games scheduled at Canal Park and 11 at Prince George's Stadium. Last season, Akron went 13-8 against Bowie, including 5-5 at Canal Park. Bowie finished fourth in the Western Division, at 67-71. Notable current RubberDucks last season against Bowie include:

Homers in bunches: The RubberDucks hit their first four home runs of the season on April 5 in a 7-6 home loss to Altoona, then went homerless for seven straight games, before hitting three in Altoona in Game 2 of Saturday's doubleheader. Both **Daniel Johnson** and **Tyler Krieger** hit home runs in each of those games. Johnson hit another Thursday night for his team-high third of the season. Akron has four solo home runs and four two-run homers in 2019 but did not hit one in either of two three-game series with Trenton.

Ducks' Double-A Debuts: The three RubberDucks position players who had no Double-A experience before this season have found early success with Akron this season.

- Infielder **Andruw Monasterio** leads the team with 17 hits in 13 games, playing error-free defense at second base, third base and shortstop. After going hitless on Opening Night, he has reached base safely in a team-best 12 straight games. He has started each of the last 10 games for Akron.
- First baseman **Wilson Garcia** has 10 hits, including four doubles (tied for the team high) and a home run with seven RBI (tied for second on the team) in 12 games.
- A Mayfield High School and Ohio University alumnus, outfielder **Mitch Longo**, homered on the first Double-A pitch he saw April 5. His two triples lead the team, his nine RBI and six walks each rank second, while his 13 hits and seven runs are each tied for second on the club.

LAST TIME OUT (Saturday, April 13, Game 1 of doubleheader at Altoona)

Plesac took the mound with a 2-0 lead in the bottom of the first inning. He worked around a pair of second-inning singles by inducing a double play. That began a stretch of retiring 12 batters in a row, and he faced three batters over the minimum before departing with two outs and a runner at second base in the seventh inning. With a 7-0 lead, right-hander Argenis Angulo recorded the final out of the 7-0 combined shutout.

LAST TIME OUT (Monday, April 15, at Trenton)

Tully pitched six innings for a second straight start to begin his season, and he threw 61 strikes to just 17 balls. He was given a 3-2 lead entering the bottom of the sixth inning but allowed a leadoff single to Ben Ruta and two-run home run by Chris Gittens, giving the Thunder a 4-3 lead. Tully finished the inning, but the bullpen allowed four more runs in an eventual 8-6 loss to Trenton.

Season Highlights

- Earned a Major League Spring Training win Feb. 27, when he pitched two scoreless innings with two strikeouts for the Indians against the Seattle Mariners.

- Finished the year 2nd in the Carolina League and 4th in the Indians system with a career-high 147 innings pitched.

2019 RUBBERDUCKS FIELD STAFF

#24 Rouglas Odor, Manager (First Season) – Odor, 51, is the 18th manager in club history. He follows Tony Mansolino, who was promoted to Triple-A Columbus after guiding Akron to a 78-62 record and finish as runner-up in the 2018 Eastern League Championship Series against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats. Last season, Odor managed the Class-A Advanced Lynchburg Hillcats to their fourth consecutive postseason. After posting the Carolina League's worst first-half record of 29-38, the Hillcats rebounded to go 42-28 in the second half, claiming the Northern Division title. They fell to Potomac in the semifinals, three games to two. Odor has a 361-363 (.499) career managing record in 11 seasons.

When Odor was the RubberDucks hitting coach in 2014, he became the first person to wear the uniforms of the Canton-Akron Indians, Akron Aeros, and Akron RubberDucks. He played 197 games for Canton-Akron during the 1991, 1993-94 seasons, and he was the hitting coach for the Aeros' 2012 Eastern League Championship squad.

The 2019 season is Odor's 32nd in the Cleveland organization as a player or coach (19th as a coach). The former shortstop was a 32nd-round draft pick by the Indians in 1988 and played in the minor leagues for the Indians from 1988-94 and for the Milwaukee Brewers organization in 1995. Last season was Odor's first as a manager since 2008. He managed San Felipe in the Venezuelan Summer League for two seasons in 1999-2000, the Burlington Indians for four seasons from 2001-04, the Mahoning Valley Scrappers for two seasons in 2005-06, and the Gulf Coast League Indians for two seasons in 2007-08. Since then, Odor has moved up the ranks as a hitting coach, starting with Class-A Kinston in 2009-10, Akron in 2011-12 and 2014, the High-A Carolina Mudcats in 2013, and Triple-A Columbus in 2015-17.

The Maracaibo, Venezuela, native resides in Winter Haven, Florida, with his wife, Milagros. He has three sons and is the uncle of Texas Rangers infielder Rougned Odor.

#27 Tony Arnold, Pitching Coach (10th Season, not consecutive) — Arnold, 59, rejoins the RubberDucks for his fifth time in Akron after spending last season with Lynchburg. In 2018, the Hillcats pitching staff finished fifth in the Carolina League with a 3.76 ERA, ranked second with 1,190 strikeouts and the 12 team shutouts ranked fourth. Arnold last was with the RubberDucks in 2016-17, helping lead the 2016 team to an Eastern League championship. He previously served in the same capacity in Akron from 1996-99, 2008, and 2011-12. Arnold's 2012 Akron Aeros staff crafted a franchise-record 3.03 ERA and went on to claim the EL championship. In 2016, Arnold became the second man to wear the uniforms of the Canton-Akron Indians, Akron Aeros and Akron RubberDucks, joining Rouglas Odor in that exclusive group.

In 2015, Arnold began as the pitching coach at Lynchburg and finished at Triple-A Columbus, helping the Clippers to the International League title. A former All-American at the University of Texas, Arnold pitched in the major leagues with the Baltimore Orioles in 1986 and 1987.

#2 Justin Toole, Hitting Coach (First Season) — Toole, 32, spent the 2018 season as Lynchburg's hitting coach. This is fourth season coaching in the Indians' organization, serving as the hitting coach for Mahoning Valley in 2016, Lake County in 2017, and Lynchburg. Toole was signed as a minor league free agent by the Indians in 2009 and spent parts of seven seasons with Cleveland from 2009-15. He spent parts of 2010, 2012-15 with Akron, hitting .259 in 180 games, including .275 in 77 games under Odor's hitting-coach tutelage in 2014. The Council Bluffs, Iowa, native played at the University of Iowa and has authored a children's book called "9 in 9," chronicling the lessons he learned while playing all nine positions in a game for the Carolina Mudcats on Aug. 25, 2012. **Twitter: @Tooleyj24, Instagram: @tooleyj24**

#28 Juan De La Cruz, Bench Coach (First Season) — De La Cruz, 25, is in his second season coaching with the Indians after serving as the hitting coach for the rookie-level Arizona League Indians in 2018. Primarily a catcher in his playing days, De La Cruz was signed as a free agent by the Indians in 2009 and spent eight seasons in the system, reaching as high as Akron in 2017, when he played 12 games as a catcher and first baseman. He was a .216 career hitter in 281 games.

Bobby Ruiz, Athletic Trainer (First Season) — Ruiz spent the past four seasons (2015-18) with Lynchburg. This is his ninth with the Indians..

Paul Synenkyj, Strength and Conditioning Coach (Third Season) — Synenkyj is the lone returning field staff member from 2018. He is in his ninth season in the Indians organization. He holds degrees in physical education from Cleveland State and the University of Akron.

We Are the RubberDucks

On October 29, 2013, team owner **Ken Babby** stood before a capacity audience at the Akron Civic Theater and announced that the team would be known henceforth as the **Akron RubberDucks**. In addition to being symbolic of the fun, family-friendly brand of entertainment offered by minor league baseball, the name also honors Akron's long history as the "**Rubber Capital of the World.**" Brandiose Marketing of San Diego, California designed the team logo, colors, and various marks and insignias. Please note that for print coverage, *RubberDucks* is spelled as one word with a capital "D." In broadcast coverage, referring to the team as "*the 'Ducks*" is an acceptable variation of the team's nickname.
